PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of August, this battalion continued in direct support of 3rd Marines, answering calls for fire from 3d Battalion, 3d Marines and 1st Battalion, 9th Marines. Additionally, Division and Force reconnaissance patrols were supported throughout the period covered by this Summary.

On 2 August, a Rough Rider convoy from Dong Ha to Khe Sanh and return was supported without incident. OPCON of 4 guns of 1/3/12 was chopped to 1/13, guns displaced to Khe Sanh. M/4/12 and C/1/12 fired mission resulting in 4 VC KIA (P).

On 3 August, a second Rough Rider convoy was supported over same route as previous day, also without incident.

On 4 August, 2 guns from B/1/40 were displaced from Ca Lu to original position at Thon Son. Lam.

On 5 August, chopped OPCON of B/1/40 and assumed OPCON of A/1/40 at Thon Son Lam.

On 6 August, restriction was imposed on expenditure of 4.2 mortar ammo due to short supply at this time. M/4/12 fired mission resulting in 6 NVA KIA (P).

On 7 and 8 August, A/1/40 fired missions which resulted in 3 NVA KIA (P) and secondary explosions from suspected VC position.

On 11 August, M/4/12 fired mission which damaged 1 and destroyed 3 VC bunkers.

On 12 August, M/4/12 engaged confirmed VC movement which resulted in 8-10 KIA (P) and secondary explosions. All radio call signs were changed this date.

On 15 August, M/4/12 fired on VC position resulting in 6 KIA (C).

On 16 August, FO School was conducted for 1/9.

On 17 August, C/1/12 fired on NVA troops resulting in 2 KIA (P) and 8 WIA (C).

On 18 August, M/4/12 and C/1/12 fired on 2 NVA battalions resulting in 18 KIA (C), 15 KIA (P), and undetermined number of WIA.

On 19 August, CG, 3dMarDiv visited 1/12 positions. M/4/12 truck overturned on ammo run, not result of enemy action. Accident caused 4 NBC (1 dead and 3 slightly injured).

On 20 August, M/4/12 and C1/12 fired on NVA company with suspected rockets. Target coverage was excellent, many fires were started, no surveillance of enemy casualties.

ENCLOSURE (1)

On 21-22 August, 1/12 provided fires in support of action which commenced with an ambush of daily supply convoy to Ca Lu. This action uncovered a large enemy force which ultimately suffered 109 KIA (C) and 305 KIA (P). The following additional missions were fired during this period: A/1/40 fired missions resulting in 15 KIA (P) and 5 WIA (C). M/4/12 missions resulted in 2 KIA (P) and 3 KIA (C). C/1/12 fired missions which resulted in 1 secondary explosion, 5 KIA (C), 8 KIA (P), 1 WIA (C). Also, 1/12 fired on VC mortar positions with no surveillance other than rounds on target.

On 23 August, A/1/40 fired on large body of NVA resulting in 26 KIA (C) and 24 KIA (P).

On 25 August, 1/12 assumed OPCON of 2 guns from C/1/40. Guns were positioned with A/1/40 at Thon Son Lam. M/4/12 fired missions on mortar position and enemy movement which resulted in 3 secondary explosions and 1 WIA (C).

On 27 August, C/1/12 fired missions in support of ARVN unit receiving mortar fire, 3-5 secondary explosions were observed. A/1/40 fired on confirmed VC movement resulting in many secondary explosions.

On 28 August, OPCON of 2 guns from C/1/40 chopped to 1/40. 1/12 delivered a large volume of fire on estimated 500 NVA troops resulting in undetermined number of small secondary explosions and 8-10 large secondary explosions. An old grave with 4 bodies was uncovered along with numerous bunkers and spider traps.

On 29 August, 1/12 fired on active rocket positions resulting in several secondary explosions.

On 30 August, A/1/40 fired on VC position resulting in 3 KIA (C).

On 31 August, Camp Carroll received 35-40 incoming rockets determined to be 102mm. No troop casualties or equipment damage in 1/12. Assumed OPCON of 1 additional gun from 1/3/12.

On 1 September, 1/12 fired on large body of NVA resulting in 26 KIA (C) and 24 KIA (P).

On 2 September, 1/12 assumed OPCON of 2 guns from C/1/40. Guns were positioned with A/1/40 at Thon Son Lam. M/4/12 fired missions on mortar position and enemy movement which resulted in 3 secondary explosions and 1 WIA (C).

On 3 September, 1/12 provided fires in support of ARVN unit receiving mortar fire, 3-5 secondary explosions were observed. A/1/40 fired on confirmed VC movement resulting in many secondary explosions.

On 4 September, OPCON of 2 guns from C/1/40 chopped to 1/40. 1/12 delivered a large volume of fire on estimated 500 NVA troops resulting in undetermined number of small secondary explosions and 8-10 large secondary explosions. An old grave with 4 bodies was uncovered along with numerous bunkers and spider traps.

f. Personnel Procedures.

(1) Seven requests for extension of overseas tours with 30 days special leave have been submitted and were subsequently approved.

(2) Three emergency leaves to CONUS were granted. Two emergency leaves in connection with PCS orders, and one special 15 day leave.

5. INTELLIGENCE

a. During the month of August daily briefings were presented to the battalion staff. Enemy activities and suspected enemy actions were discussed and evaluated.

b. A target list was compiled for the S-3 to aid in the intensified H&I program.

c. The counter-mortar and counter-rocket fire plan was re-evaluated. Assistance was provided the S-3 in formulating a new counter-mortar and counter-rocket fire plan. The new fire plan was decided upon after a thorough study of new and old mortar and rocket data.

d. A new briefing map has been phased into the S-2 office. This is a situation map and each week a summary of the activities of the past week is presented by illustration to the battalion staff.

6. TRAINING

a. A survey school of two weeks duration convened during the last week of August. Personnel of the Operations section are attending this school. Upon completion of this school, a detailed survey plan will be implemented for this battalion.

b. The FADAC contact team visited this battalion and conducted a one week school on operation and maintenance of the Gun Direction Computer, M18 and accessory equipment. Four instructors were trained during this period and were subsequently utilized to conduct one week of instruction on this equipment for fire direction personnel in each of the firing batteries. It is anticipated that FADAC will be operational in this battalion on or about 4 September 1967.

c. One officer and two NCO's completed the III MAF Embarkation school and two NCO's attended the III MAF NCO School.

d. Instruction on firstaid/buddy aid, military courtesy and discipline, and venereal disease were included in the training program during August. On-the-job training in all occupational fields is continuous.

7. COMMUNICATIONS

a. The Battalion Wire Section laid wire to the new position of C/L12 and installed new overhead lines across all major access roads.

b. The Battalion Radio Section installed a PP388/RT524 in the communications office. This will facilitate monitoring operational nets for procedural discrepancies. Additionally, it provides an indoor covered circuit capability.

c. A daily time check with the Bureau of Standards (WV/MVE) was established; triple concentric wire was laid around the antenna farm; and a new Communications SOP was published.

8. LOGISTICS

a. The displacement of C/L12 to a new position and the assumption of ADCON of M/L12 presented a logistical problem during this period. The complete construction of gun positions and fortifications were necessitated by the displacement of C/L12 and ADCON of M/L12 had added two major end items to be supported; namely, the M-54 truck and M-109, 155mm Howitzer(SP).

b. Electrical power continues to be provided by a PU-239 generator supplied and maintained by the 11th Engineer Battalion. Water is supplied by the Camp Carroll water point. Ice was provided daily and ice cream was provided twice by the ration issue point. The laundry facility at FLSU 100 can accommodate organizational clothing but not individual clothing.

c. Preparation for the monsoon season is continuous. Requirements have been determined and requisitions submitted.

d. The Battalion Wire Section laid wire to the new position of C/L12 and installed new overhead lines across all major access roads.

ENCLOSURE (1)

9. SUPPLY

a. A significant amount of time was utilized in preparation for the Division Supply Inspection on 25 August which rated this battalion "satisfactory with discrepancies". Accounts were reconciled with batteries/sections to determine overages/shortages and to verify outstanding documents. A warehouse inventory was conducted and discovered excesses were turned in to FLSU 1.

10. MEDICAL

a. A total of 412 Marines received treatment at the aid stations of this battalion. One case of malaria was diagnosed during August. A total of 810 immunizations were given and 4 sanitation inspections were conducted with no major discrepancies noted. There were no food or water-borne illnesses.

b. Six MEDCAPS were conducted at Hung Phu I and II during which 1,077 indigent civilians were treated.

11. **ORDNANCE.** The Ordnance Section was able to adequately support the OPCON/ADCON units of this battalion. One major problem area was noted during this period; that is, the shortage of spare parts, especially for the M-109 155mm Howitzer (SP). This matter has been brought to the attention of higher headquarters and all necessary corrective action within the scope of the Ordnance capability of this battalion has been initiated.

12. MOTOR TRANSPORT

a. Vehicles of this battalion logged a total of 23,352 miles. First and second echelon repairs totaled 42. Quarterly PM was performed on 10-M35's, 14-M422's, 7-M416 trailers, and 3-M101 trailers. Annual PM was completed on 3-M35's, 4-M422's, 1-MRC83, and 2-M416 trailers.

b. Tire tubes (900X16 and 1100X20), tire patches, and NAVMC Form 10627-SD are in critically short supply and are on order.

c. Military licenses were issued to 12 Marines following drivers instruction and road testing in accordance with established procedures.

d. One M35A2C truck was almost entirely destroyed as the result of being struck by an incoming rocket while on an ammunition run at Dong Ha. There were no resultant injuries.

13. CIVIC ACTION

a. The Civic Action Program is continually expanding in this area. Local Vietnamese are attending English language classes and MEDCAPS in increasing numbers. The well project in the village of Hung Phu II was completed with the exception of being purified. Lumber was given to the villages of Hung Phu I and II for the construction of ballot boxes in preparation for the National elections in September.

b. A total of 274 children and adults attended English language classes and 1,026 children and adults were treated during August MEDCAPS. Stomach aches, coughs, and skin infections continue to be the most common ailments.

14. PERSONAL RESPONSE

a. The Personal Response Officer and the Battalion Sergeant Major attended an I Corps Area Personal Response Conference.

b. An accelerated Personal Response Program has been initiated. A minimum of 4 Marines accompanied the MEDCAP team each week in order to observe the team and to observe village conditions first hand. Through these visits, Marines can come to a better understanding of the Vietnamese people. These Marines are selected from volunteers among the batteries located at Camp Carroll.
