PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of September, this battalion continued in direct support of 3d Marines on Operation Kingfisher, answering calls for fire from 3d Battalion, 3rd Marines and 1st Battalion, 9th Marines. Additionally, Division and Force reconnaissance patrols were supported and reinforcing fires delivered upon request of 12th Marines throughout the period covered by this summary. Crew-served and individual weapons of personnel on perimeter security were fired every day.

On 1 September, A/1/40 fired on NVA in the open. Surveillance: 2 KIA (P)

On 2 September, C/1/12 and I/3/12 fired precision registration. A/1/40 fired for FO school conducted by 3/3 liaison section. Received 2-5 rounds incoming of undetermined caliber with no resultant casualties or damage. Counter-battery fires delivered with unknown results.

On 3 September, C/1/12 fired on active rocket position. Surveillance: 1 secondary explosion. Assumed OPCON of one additional gun of I/3/12, previously under OPCON of 26th Marines. ASR of 20, 10, and 10 rounds per day for 105, 155, and 4.2, respectively, was established by 12th Marines due to ammunition losses which resulted from artillery attack on Dong Ha ASP.

On 4 September, 1/12 implemented centralized technical fire direction. Gun direction computer, M-18 (FADAC) placed in operation.

On 5 September, ASR of 50 and 20 rounds per day for 105 and 155, respectively, was established by 12th Marines.

On 6 September, 1/12 assumed OPCON of C/1/40 from 1/40 and chopped OPCON of A/1/40 to 1/40.

On 7 September, C/1/12 conducted familiarization firing of individual and crew-served weapons. Missions fired in support of ambushed convoy on route 9, south of Rockpile. Surveillance: 10 KIA (C), 50 KIA (P), 2 mortar and 1 AW destroyed (C). Camp Carroll received approximately 10 rounds of incoming of undetermined caliber with no resultant casualties or damage in 1/12. Counter-battery fires delivered with unknown results.

On 8 September, M/4/12 conducted familiarization firing of individual and crew-served weapons. Concluded two-week survey school for 1/12 survey section. C/1/40 fired high burst registration. Camp Carroll received approximately 10 rounds of undetermined caliber. No casualties or damage in 1/12.

On 9 September, Camp Carroll received approximately 12 rounds of incoming of undetermined caliber. No casualties or damage in 1/12. Fired on rocket/artillery position reported by radar. Surveillance: 2 secondary explosions.

On 10 September, C/1/12 authorized to operate decentralized FDC. Camp Carroll received approximately 30 rounds of incoming of undetermined caliber. M/4/12 fired reinforcing fires for 12th Marines. Surveillance: 2 secondary explosions.

On 11 September, ASR of 70 and 30 rounds per day for 105 and 155, respectively, was established by 12th Marines.

On 12 September, HQ/1/12 conducted familiarization firing of individual weapons. Assumed OPCON of K/4/12 from 12th Marines.

On 13 September, C/1/12 and I/3/12 registered by precision registration. Chopped OPCON of W/3/12 to 2/12. C/1/12 conducted familiarization firing of individual and crew-served weapons. Fired practice mission in support of I/3/12 Fo school.

On 16 September, counter-mortar fire delivered in support of 3/3. No surveillance.

On 19 and 20 September, HQ/1/12 conducted familiarization firing of individual weapons.

On 21 September, CMR generator transferred to Con Thien on order of 12th Marines. CMR out of action.

On 24 September, Camp Carroll received incoming rockets of undetermined caliber and number. Sustained minor damage to tentage and 2 vehicles. No personnel casualties. Counter-battery fires delivered with unknown results.

On 27 September, K/4/12 fired mission for 3rd Marines. Surveillance: 4 NVA KIA (P), 1 sampan destroyed, secondary explosion.

On 29 September, I/3/12 fired mission for recon patrol. Surveillance: 1 NVA KIA (C). Chopped OPCON C/1/40 to 1/40 and assumed OPCON B/1/40 from 1/40. C/1/12, I/3/12, K/4/12 registered by precision registration.

On 30 September, B/1/40 registered by precision registration.

5. INTELLIGENCE

a. During the month of September, the attention of the S-2 section continued to be directed toward target acquisition and target lists. A project has been initiated whereby a target list is submitted daily to the S-3 section. These intelligence targets are fired as a part of the increased fire program.

b. Daily intelligence briefings were presented to the battalion staff. Information for the daily briefings was compiled from situation reports, intelligence reports, and reports from other S-2 sections throughout this area.

c. Each day the counter-mortar/rocket/artillery data is re-evaluated and recommended changes are presented to the S-3 for consideration.

6. TRAINING

a. The two-week survey school which commenced on 24 August was concluded on 8 September. Personnel of the Battalion Survey Section attended this organizational school and will also attend the regimental survey school, scheduled to convene on 4 October, for a period of approximately ten days.

b. Training on the Gun Direction Computer (FADAC) has progressed to the point that on 4 September, FADAC became operational in this battalion.

c. Formal school quotas were requested for second quarter, FY-68.

d. Training in general military subjects, familiarization firing of individual and crew-served weapons, and all occupational fields is conducted on a continuous basis commensurate with operational commitments.

7. COMMUNICATIONS

a. During the month of September, AN/PRC-83, USMC # 316629 was misappropriated and damaged near the 3d Marines fam fire range.

b. The administrative switchboard was relocated when the walls of the old bunker collapsed due to the mid-month rains. The new underground bunker was completed on 28 September.

c. The message center processed 28 outgoing messages and 697 incoming messages.

d. A new battery charger (PP-4567) was received and placed into service during this period.

e. Two vehicles of the Communications Section sustained minor damage as the result of being struck by the fragmentation of one incoming round.

8. LOGISTICS

a. The availability of Class IV items remains unchanged. Bunkers are not available. Bunker materials are not available. Substitute bunker materials can only be utilized for overhead cover for narrow trenches. Ammunition, fire direction centers, executive officer pits, and the battalion aid station are without adequate protection.

b. The below mentioned items are considered critical or can become critical in the near future:

(1) Compass, Magnetic. These are essential for artillery operations. This battalion is short sixteen M-2 compasses and forty-seven lensatic compasses.

(2) Lamp, Incandescent. These bulbs are essential for night artillery support. Christmas tree lights are being used as a substitute. Christmas tree lights must certainly be sent from home at the request of the troops.

(3) Body Armor, Medium. There is no problem getting small and large armor. However, it is unsatisfactory for Marines to wear a small unzipped or a large with the armor plates buckling so as to form a "bullet trap."

(4) Green Underclothing. This battalion has received six-hundred small undershirts and two-hundred seventy small underdrawers during the past eleven months. These were received when this battalion had over nine hundred men to supply with this quantity. Marines should not have to write home for underclothing and socks. Yet this is exactly what our supply system is forcing the troops to do.

(5) Tire Tubes: 1100X20 and 900X20. This battalion has had a priority 12 requisition outstanding since July 1965; a priority 05 outstanding since July 1966; a priority 12 since December 1966; and two priorities 02 since April 1967. We have had no receipts during the month of September.

(6) Socks, Cushion Sole. This battalion has received four hundred fifty pairs of cushion sole socks in the last eleven months. Each of some nine hundred fifty men have probably worn out one pair of socks every two months. Socks are much more important than underclothing for the welfare of the men.

(7) Sand Bags. Even though sand bags were available this month, they are listed as in short supply as an early warning for a possible problem area. This battalion has built sand bag walls around twenty-three living tents since May 1967. The deterioration of the cloth sand bags has been so extensive that all twenty-three walls collapsed during September 1967. The plastic sand bags appear to be superior to cloth bags. Plastic bags on the top walls have worn on the top surface; plastic bags below the top are still in good condition.

(8) C. P. Tents. These are required for tactical black-out of battery fire direction centers and executive pits. These are the key command points of a firing battery, and it is essential that both have adequate blackout.

(9) Aiming Circle, M1/M2. Two separate aiming circles are required to lay and safety check a battery. Loss of one aiming circle limits a battery's capability for occupying two separate positions.

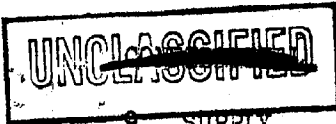
(10) Typhus Vaccine. This is required to maintain required immunizations for this battalion. This is the third month this vaccine has been critical in this battalion. There are men in this battalion who are one, two, and three months overdue for this shot.

(11) Office Supplies. This battalion received bond and manifold paper this month. One case of mimeograph paper has been received since 1 July. Orders for October rotation will require two cases of mimeograph paper.

(12) Laundry. The lack of laundry facilities from the FLC Laundry Platoon continues to be a problem in the Dong Ha area. There are facilities for organizational property, but nothing for the individual Marine. During the coming monsoon season a facility for drying clothes for the troops is an absolute must. With ten men per tent, it is virtually impossible for everyone to dry clothes by hanging them in the tent.

9. SUPPLY

a. Status cards are now being received on all requisitions. These cards provide information on the status of priority requisitions. Supply operations have improved during this period as evidenced by the large number of completed requisitions during September.

b. September requisitions are as follows:

c. Command post tents, tire tubes, mimeograph paper, and ordnance items, such as bore brushes for 105MM howitzer and M-2 compasses are in critically short supply.

d. The quarterly operating budget has been increased from \$50,000 to \$125,000. This increase was the result of assuming ADCON of additional units. To date, total obligations are \$112,545.17. Obligations for this period totalled \$42,508.95 leaving a remaining balance of \$12,454.83.

10. MEDICAL

a. A total of 274 personnel received treatment at the aid stations of this battalion. Additionally, 372 immunizations were given. Two cases of malaria were reported by C/1/13 and one hospitalman was hospitalized with a diagnosis of purulent sinusitis. There were 2 hostile wounded, 1 non-hostile death, 1 hostile death, and 4 non-hostile wounded.

b. Four sanitation inspections were conducted with no major discrepancies noted. The overall health of the battalion is considered to be excellent.

c. Seven MEDCAPS were conducted at the villages of Hang Phu I and II during which time 1,091 indigent civilians were treated.

11. ORDNANCE

a. During this period, the Ordnance section devised a means for drying fogged optical instruments. The device has proven to be very effective and was submitted as a "Lessons Learned."

b. The shortage of spare parts for 105MM and 155MM howitzers continues to be a serious problem. All priority requisitions have been traced and a message was sent to the Division Ordnance Officer requesting assistance in this matter. For example, a 105MM howitzer has been deadlined for one month for lack of an operating handle costing \$11.60.

12. MOTOR TRANSPORT

a. Vehicles of this command travelled 18,448 miles during September. The following vehicle maintenance was completed:

b. One M-35 was extremely damaged; one M-422A1 was destroyed; one M-37 and one M-422A1 were slightly damaged as the result of enemy action.

c. Driver instruction was completed and 10 licenses were issued.

d. A major problem is the shortage of M-35 trucks due to the displacement of seven such vehicles to Khe Sanh.

e. Tire tubes (900X16), batteries for M-422A1 vehicles, points, lids for water trailers, and NAVMC Forms 10627 and 10245-SD are all in critically short supply.

13. CIVIC ACTION

a. The Civic Action Program continued to be successful during the month of September. On 11 September, the well project at the village of Hung Phu II was officially completed. Plans were formulated to continue the building program in the villages of Hung Phu I and Hung Phu II. The Civil Affairs Officer attended the monthly Village Council meeting when plans were adopted to construct a community meeting hall. A requisition for the necessary materials has been forwarded to the Division Civil Affairs Officer. Ten woodworking sets, fifteen mortar working sets, and two hundred ammunition boxes have already been acquired for this construction project. Work will begin on the building upon receipt of the necessary supplies from the I Corps Civil Affairs Supply Officer.

b. The most successful project of the Civil Affairs Program continues to be the twice-weekly MEDCAP. A total of 1,091 adults and children were treated during the month of September. There has been a marked reduction in the number of stomach disorders in the villages. This decline can be attributed to the completion of the new well.

c. English classes continue to be an important part of the Civic Action Program. Marine volunteers teach English classes in Hung Phu I and Hung Phu II once each week. During September a total of 140 people attended English classes in the two villages.

14. PERSONAL RESPONSES

a. September was a month of great progress for the Personal Responses Program. Visits were made by the Marines of Camp Carroll to the villages of Hung Phu I and Hung Phu II as observers with the twice-weekly MEDCAP's. Each of the Marines selected as an observer returned with a better understanding of Vietnamese culture.

c. Clothing, donated by members of U. S. military families was distributed to the village of Hung Phu I by the Personal Response Officer as part of the People to People Program.
