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PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

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During January, this battalion provided direct support artillery fires to 3d Marines on Operation Lancaster and to 4th Marines on Operation Lancaster II. Division and Force reconnaissance patrols were also supported and reinforcing fires delivered upon request of 12th Marines.

On 1 January, K/4/12 fired reinforcing mission for 12th Marines during the New Year cease fire period. Mission was cleared by 12th Marines.

On 2 January, A/1/12, C/1/12, and K/4/12 registered.

On 3 January, Mort/1/12 and A/1/40 registered.

On 4 January, the battalion provided fires in support of a sweep and destroy mission between Thon Son Lam and Ca Lu.

On 6 and 10 January, Mort/1/12 registered.

On 12 January, fired on column of NVA located by AO with unknown results. AO adjusted mission on bunkers. Surveillance: One bunker destroyed.

On 13 January, fired mission in support of ambushed convoy enroute from Thon Son Lam to Ca Lu.

On 15 January, A/1/12, C/1/12, and K/4/12 registered. Controlled and fired TOT with 1/13 on NVA regiment. No surveillance. K/4/12 fired mission for AO on 50 NVA. AO unable to provide surveillance.

On 16 January, K/4/12 fired on 30 NVA located by AO. Surveillance: Six NVA KIA. Fired in support of recon team in contact with NVA unit. Recon team extracted. A/1/12 conducted familiarization firing of individual weapons.

On 18 January, C/1/12 fired mission for recon team. Surveillance: Heard screams. A/4/12 registered with time fuze.

On 19 January, A/1/12 conducted familiarization firing of individual weapons.

On 20 January, Operation Lancaster and direct support of 3d Marines terminated. Now providing direct artillery support to 4th Marines. A/1/12 and K/4/12 completed direct fire training. Received 35 incoming rockets and artillery. Determined to be 122/140MM rockets and 75MM artillery. Fired counter-battery fires.

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On 21 January, 1/12 now participating in Operation Lancaster II, received approximately 15 rounds of 75MM artillery incoming. Fired counterbattery fires.

On 22 January, received one round of incoming of undetermined type and caliber. Mort/1/12 registered.

On 23 January, A/1/12, C/1/12, and K/4/12 registered. Eight secondary explosions during K/4/12 registration. Believed to be detonation of dud bombs in vicinity of registration point.

On 24 January, received approximately 15 rounds of incoming rockets and artillery. Fired counterbattery fires. Supported ambushed convoy enroute from Dong Ha to Camp Carroll.

On 25 January, received 23 rounds of incoming artillery believed to be 75MM. Fired counterbattery fires. C/1/12 fired mission on three NVA. Surveillance: One NVA KIA.

On 26 January, A/1/12 fired mission on recoilless rifle and 12 NVA. Surveillance: Two NVA KIA and one secondary explosion. C/1/12 fired mission on 10 NVA, 2 recoilless rifles, and active mortars. Surveillance: Three NVA KIA, one secondary explosion, and mortars silenced.

On 27 January, A/1/12 and C/1/12 fired mission in support of 3/4 resulting in 26 NVA KIA and six secondary explosions. K/4/12 fired mission on bunkers for A0. Surveillance: Five bunkers destroyed.

On 28 January, received four rounds of 75MM artillery incoming. Fired counterbattery fires.

On 29 January, fired in support of convoy from Camp Carroll to Thon Son Lam. Convoy proceeded without incident. Mort/1/12 registered.

On 30 January, received two rounds of incoming of unknown type and caliber. Fired counterbattery fires. Fired in support of convoy enroute from Dong Ha to Camp Carroll. Convoy arrived Camp Carroll without incident.

On 31 January, fired in support of convoy enroute from Camp Carroll to Dong Ha.

5. INTELLIGENCE

a. During the latter part of the month, Camp Carroll was subjected to a significant increase in rocket and artillery attacks. Rockets were identified as 122MM and 140MM. The artillery was identified as 75MM and represents the first evidence of such caliber being employed against Camp Carroll. Since this weapon is of relatively short range, the counterbattery fires of this battalion were re-oriented to compensate for the employment of this weapon. The 75MM incoming appears to be fired from one gun whose specific location has not yet been identified. Information is being collected from all possible sources in an attempt to locate this weapon.

b. Continuous liaison is maintained with the S-2, 4th Marines resulting in the exchange of intelligence and ideas.

6. TRAINING

a. Training in general military subjects, familiarization firing of individual weapons, and on-the-job training in all occupational fields was conducted during January.

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c. In addition to the training listed above; 33 enlisted attended the monthly troop indoctrination conducted by the battalion staff for newly joined personnel; 98 corporals and sergeants attended the monthly battalion NCO school; 181 officers and enlisted attended a Personal Response school conducted by the Division Personal Response Contact Team; 11 enlisted attended an observer school conducted for the personnel manning the Camp Carroll observation posts.

7. COMMUNICATIONS

a. In preparation for the possible activation of the alternate battalion command post and fire direction center, a double loop circuit was laid between the firing batteries.

b. A radio monitoring station has been established in the Communications Office to ensure compliance with established radio voice procedure and to maintain communications security.

c. The Electronics Repair Section processed 123 items of communications equipment, 111 of which were evacuated for third echelon maintenance.

d. The message center processed 632 incoming and 81 outgoing messages.

e. Stringent electricity control measures have been imposed to preclude generator overload.

8. LOGISTICS

a. MCB-10 has completed all construction projects scheduled for this battalion.

b. The 11th Engineer Battalion provided wood for the interior construction of the messhall and the 3rd Engineer Battalion provided a 3000 gallon water tank for the messhall water supply. With the installation of the oil burner stoves, plumbing, and the erection of the water tank, the messhall will be operational.

9. Supply

a. The cancellation of back orders by MR1, MC1, and MC2 were reconciled during January. All outstanding back orders with a Julian date of 7260 or earlier were cancelled. Cancelled TB items have been reviewed and re-ordered as necessary. All batteries are currently reviewing cancelled back orders and re-ordering as required. This program is very beneficial, in that, it clarifies outstanding back orders prior to Julian date 7260.

10. MEDICAL

a. Aid stations of this battalion treated 413 patients during January. During this period there were four KIA, 1 DOW, and 43 WIA of which 10 required MEDEVAC. A total of 70 immunizations were administered and four cases of venereal disease (gonorrhea) were treated.

b. Three first aid lectures were presented within the battalion and five MEDCAPS were conducted during which 375 indigenous personnel were treated.

11. ORDNANCE No significant problems or incidents effecting ordnance support were experienced during January. The Ordnance Section was able to adequately support the ordnance requirements of the battalion.

12. MOTOR TRANSPORT

a. Three vehicles were evacuated, repaired, and returned from third and fourth echelon maintenance at Dong Ha.

b. Driver training instruction was conducted and 27 government vehicle operator's permits were issued. Additionally, safe driving lectures were presented twice each week. No vehicle accidents involving vehicles of this battalion have occurred for the past two months.

c. A new office for the dispatcher has been constructed. This will also serve as an office for the Motor Transport Officer and Chief.

13. CIVIC ACTION

a. Operation Red Wagon continued into January with the presentation of eight red wagons to deserving children in the refugee village of Hung Phu I.

b. The public meeting building in Hung Phu I was dedicated on 6 January 1968. Local government officials and members of this battalion attended dedication ceremonies.

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c. The Self-Help Program continued with the hiring of refugees of Hung Phu II to fill sand bags. Salad oil was used as reimbursement for this labor.

d. Members of this command were invited to attend a luncheon sponsored by the village officials and elders of Hung Phu II. The purpose of the luncheon was to usher in the New Year and solidify relationships between the refugees and this command.

14. PERSONAL RESPONSE

a. Two members of this battalion attended the Division Personal Response School.

b. Five Marines accompanied corpsmen on MEDCAPS for the purpose of observing and learning of the problems of the local refugee populace.
