On 1 July, H/3/12 displaced to LZ Cates as of 010800H July 68.

On 2 July, chopped OPCON of K/4/12 as of 021000H July 68.

On 4 July, Camp Carroll received 7 rounds of 75mm incoming. The battalion suffered no damage or casualties. B/1/40 fired in support of 1st Battalion, 9th Marines on an enemy movement resulting in 3 NVA KIA. D/2/12 fired two unobserved missions called in by Task Force Hotel on a known enemy position, expending 12 Firecracker.

On 6 July, Camp Carroll received an unknown amount of incoming. The battalion suffered no damage or casualties. Chopped OPCON of E/2/12 as of 061200H July 68. Assumed OPCON of Command Group "A" of Headquarters 1/11, A/1/11, T/1/11, G/3/12 and I/3/12 as of 061800H July 68.

On 7 July, chopped OPCON of D/2/12 as of 070820H July 68. LZ Hawk received 18 rounds of 60mm and 4 recoilless rifle rounds. A/1/11 fired in support of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines on an active mortar position. Two Firecracker were expended resulting in mortars silenced. A/1/11 fired in support of 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines on an active mortar position. Six Firecracker were expended resulting in mortars silenced. On 8 July, assumed OPCON of K/4/12 as of 081100H July 68. Chopped OPCON of Headquarters Command Group "A" as of 081400H July 68. A/1/11 fired a mission in support of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines on an active .50 caliber machine gun. 4 Firecracker were expended resulting in machine gun silenced. A/1/11 fired a mission in support of 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines on 2 NVA in the open. 16 Firecracker were expended resulting in 2 probable NVA KIA. G/3/12 fired a mission in support of 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines on 9 NVA in the open. 3 Firecracker were expended resulting in excellent coverage of target. G/3/12 fired a mission on enemy movement. 6 Firecracker were expended resulting in excellent coverage. A/1/11 fired a mission in support of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines on an active mortar. 17 Firecracker were expended resulting in excellent coverage, mortar destroyed. A/1/11 fired a mission in support of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines on an active mortar. 6 Firecracker were expended resulting in mortar silenced. A/1/11 fired a mission in support of 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines on active mortars. 6 Firecracker were expended resulting in mortars silenced. I/3/12 fired a mission in support of 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines on active mortars. 6 Firecracker were expended resulting in mortars silenced. On 9 July, I/3/12 fired a mission in support of 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines on a known infiltration route. 7 Firecracker were expended resulting in excellent coverage. A/1/11 fired a mission in support of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines on a suspected enemy movement resulting in excellent coverage.

On 10 July, B/6/33 chopped reinforcing role of 1st Battalion, 12th Marines as of 101300H July 68. B/1/40 chopped reinforcing role of 1st Battalion, 12th Marines as of 101600H July 68. Chopped OPCON of K/4/12 as of 101600H July 68. A/1/11 fired in support of 1st Battalion, 1st Marines on an enemy movement. 38 Firecracker were expended resulting in excellent coverage, 2 probable NVA KIA. On 15 July, I/3/12 fired a mission in support of 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines on enemy in the open, resulting in 1 NVA KIA. C/1/12 fired a mission in support of 1st Battalion, 3rd Marines on an enemy movement resulting in 5 NVA KIA, 3 NVA WIA and 1 probable. I/3/12 fired a mission in support of 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines on 4 NVA in the open. 20 Firecracker were expended resulting in excellent coverage, 4 probable KIA.

On 16 July, G/3/12 fired a mission in support of 1st Battalion, 4th Marines on enemy in the open. 24 Firecracker were expended resulting in good coverage, 2 probable KIA. I/3/12 fired in support of 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines on 4 NVA in the open. 4 Firecracker were expended resulting in 4 probable KIA. I/3/12 fired a mission in support of 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines on 2 NVA in the open expending 4 Firecracker resulting in good coverage of target.

On 21 July, T/1/11 fired a mission for an air observer on 10-15 NVA in the open. 32 Firecracker were expended resulting in 6 NVA KIA, excellent coverage.

On 22 July, G/3/12 fired a mission in support of 1st Battalion, 4th Marines on enemy in the open. 8 Firecracker were expended resulting in good coverage, 2 probable KIA.

15. AIR SUPPORT. Priority resupply by helicopter as required.

16. ACTIVATIONS/DEACTIVATIONS/REDESIGNATIONS. None

17. PERSONAL SERVICES.

a. Mail was received on a routine basis.

b. Rest and Recuperation leave was granted to 57 individuals.

c. There were 12 MARS calls made during the month.

d. Regularly scheduled church services were held in both Catholic and Protestant faiths, in addition to memorial services for those Marines killed in action.

18. MEDICAL. During July, the aid stations of this battalion treated 98 Marines. There was one friendly KIA. Four persons were bitten by rats and treated with Rabies Vaccine. A total of 216 immunizations were given.

19. TRAINING.

a. Training in general military subjects, familization firing of the individual weapons and on the job training in all occupational fields was conducted.
