On 1 August, I 3/12 fired in support of 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines, expending 24 Firecracker on NVA squad on hill top, resulting in excellent coverage, 1 NVA KIA.

On 2 August, chopped OPCON of G, H, I, and W 3/12, T 1/11 as of 020900H. Assumed OPCON of A, B, C 1/12 and T 3/12 as of 020900H. 1/12 Command Group displaced to Camp Carroll as of 021400H.

On 3 August, A 1/12 displaced to Camp Carroll. T 3/12 displaced to Camp Carroll by air. 155 howitzer fell from helicopter as a result of broken sling and subsequently destroyed.

On 4 August, T 3/12 displaced from Camp Carroll. Chopped OPCON of T 3/12 as of 040730H. B 1/12 while firing a night defensive fire, fired off target which resulted in one priority medevac. B 1/12 received 18 rounds of incoming with no casualties or damage.

On 5 August, C 1/12 fired a mission approximately 1510H which resulted in two friendly WIA's from five long rounds.

On 7 August, B 1/12 fired in support of a Recon Team, 3 NVA's in tree line, which resulted in 1 NVA KIA and 2 probables. M 4/12, 5th 155 gun battery and 1st 8" howitzer battery fired a mission on company of NVA which resulted in 3 NVA KIA's.

On 8 August, C 1/12 displaced to Cam Lo as of 081330H. C 1/12 arrived at Cam Lo and reported ready to fire as of 081615H.

On 12 August, C 1/12 displaced from Cam Lo to Camp Carroll and reported ready to fire as of 121230H.

On 16 August, C 1/12 fired in support of 1/3 on active mortars. 40 Firecracker were expended which resulted in mortar silenced. K 4/12 fired in support of 2/3 on NVA's in open. 3 Firecracker were expended which resulted in rounds on target, good coverage. A 1/12 fired an unobserved mission for 3rd Marines, expending 54 Firecracker.

On 17 August, B 1/12 displaced to Camp Carroll access road and reported ready to fire as of 171730H.

On 18 August, C 1/12 fired in support of 2/3, blocking fires resulting in 3 NVA KIA's.

On 20 August, B 1/12 displaced from Camp Carroll access road to the Rock Pile as of 200945H. B 1/12 reported ready to fire as of 201110H.

On 25 August, A 1/12 displaced from Camp Carroll to hill 37 in Cam Lo area and reported ready to fire as of 251345H. A 1/12 displaced from Cam Lo area to C-2 and reported ready to fire as of 252030H. Camp Carroll received 2 rounds of incoming of unknown type and origin.

On 26 August, Camp Carroll received approximately 30 rounds of 130 mm incoming. The battalion had no casualties or damage. B 1/12 at the Rock Pile received 3 rounds of incoming and sustained 2 WIA's and one howitzer damaged.

On 27 August, Camp Carroll received approximately 6 rounds of 130 mm incoming. The battalion had no casualties or damage.

On 28 August, A 1/12 displaced from C-2 to Camp Carroll and reported ready to fire as of 281125H. Assumed OPCON of W 1/12. W 1/12 arrived in position at Mai Loc and reported ready to fire as of 282125H.

On 29 August, A 1/12 fired a mission called by a reconnaissance team on movement, lights, and NVA which resulted in 4 NVA KIA's and one 50 Cal. M.G. destroyed.

On 30 August, B 1/12 at the Rock Pile received unknown number of incoming 122 mm rockets. B 1/12 sustained direct hits on gun #1 and the FDC bunker resulting in 7 WIA and one howitzer destroyed.

On 31 August, assumed OPCON of B 1/13 from 12th Marines as of 311600H. B 1/13 occupied position near Dong Ha and reported ready to fire as of 311900H. A and C 1/12 fired in support of 2/3 on NVA in the open which resulted in 7 KIA's.

6. COMMAND RELATIONS. Satisfactory

7. EQUIPMENT.

a. During August, battalion vehicles transported 673 passengers and 342 tons of cargo over a distance of 5691 miles.

b. Driver instruction classes were conducted. 15 Marines received drivers licenses.

c. The non-chrome M-16 rifles were turned into FLSG-B. All men in this battalion now have chrome plated chambers in their M-16's.

b. Net gain of 9 officers, 67 Marine enlisted and 2 Navy enlisted.

12. INTELLIGENCE

a. On 25, 26, and 27 August, Camp Carroll was subjected to enemy artillery fire on three successive nights from 130mm guns. Counter battery fire was initiated and appeared to be effective.

b. Daily intelligence and weather briefings were conducted for the battery commanders and the battalion staff.

c. An intelligence briefing was also given to all newly arrived personnel in the battalion during the month.

d. Instruction was conducted in crater analysis for personnel of the battalion to improve counter battery fire capability.
