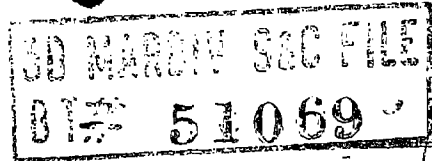

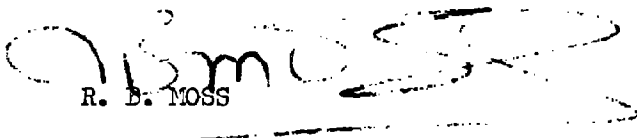

~~UNCLASSIFIED~~PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

On 1 January, transferred OPCON of Tango Battery to 2/11 effective 011000H.

On 5 January, K 4/13 fired in support of 2/5 on a known enemy position at grid 170457, resulting in one bunker and twelve hootches destroyed.

On 7 January, A 1/12 and 2nd Provisional 155 Howitzer Battery fired a mission in support of 2/5 on enemy movement in a village at grid 164431, resulting in one bunker destroyed and one KIA.

On 13 January, LY 4/11 fired in support of 1/3 on a known enemy position at grid 103416, resulting in one bunker destroyed.

On 15 January, the Commanding Officer, 1st Battalion, 12th Marines was killed when the helicopter in which he was a passenger was shot down by enemy ground fire 14 miles west/southwest of An Hoa Combat Base. C 1/12 fired a mission for an LO on a squad in the open at grid 786342, resulting in 4 KIA's and 1 probable KIA.

On 17 January, LtCol R.B. MOSS resumed command of 1st Battalion, 12th Marines.

On 19 January, one searchlight returned to An Hoa from FSB Outlass.

On 20 January, C 1/12 commenced move from FSB Spear to FSB Maxwell and reported ready to fire at 201600H. Assumed OPCON of D 2/11 as of 201500H.

On 21 January, K 5/5 suffered 5 KIA and 19 MIA from friendly artillery rounds, while firing a mission with A 1/12. C 1/12 completed the move from FSB Spear to FSB Maxwell. D 2/11 commenced airlift to FSB Dart and reported two tubes ready to fire at 211830H.

On 22 January, two searchlights from FSB Mike and one from FSB Spear returned to An Hoa.

On 23 January, D 2/11 completed lift to FSB Dart.

On 26 January, one searchlight was lifted to FSB Maxwell and one to FSB Dagger.

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On 29 January, F 3/11 commenced move from FSB Dagger to Hill 327 and reported ready to fire at 291315H.

On 31 January, F 1/12 lifted two tubes from FSB Pike to FSB Tomhawk. F 2/11, firing in support of 2/5 on a sniper at grid 114382, received secondary explosions.

2. SIGNIFICANT OPERATIONS CONDUCTED. Participated in Operation Taylor Common.

3. CASUALTIES INFLICTED ON THE ENEMY. One hundred thirty-one (131) enemy were reported killed by air and artillery. Twenty-four (24) of these were directly attributed to artillery. Numerous bodies were recovered from graves and contained shrapnel. It can not be determined if these were killed by air or artillery.

7. EQUIPMENT.

a. Six personnel received driver licenses from driver instruction classes.

8. LOGISTICS

a. During the month of January, primary logistical effort was directed toward the resupply of firing batteries occupying fire support bases. By the end of the month, seven batteries were being resupplied entirely by helicopter from the An Hoa LSI. 3,297,162 pounds were helilifted for 1/12 organic and OPCON units.

9. CIVIC ACTION

a. Three MEDCAPS were conducted by 1/12 personnel during the month in KYMIEN-THU village. Approximately 60 people were treated, and soap was given to each villager.

b. An 11-year-old boy, TRAN PHUOC MINH was found in need of eye surgery on the 29th. Arrangements are being made to have the surgery performed.

a. During the month, five personnel received Battalion Commander's Office Hours for violation of Articles 113, 92; 134; 92; 134; and 91.

b. A total of 28 Marines were promoted; one to Staff Sergeant, five to Corporal, and twenty-two to Lance Corporal.

c. Two requests for extension of overseas tour with special leave were approved.

d. During the month, three Bronze Star, three Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry, three Purple Heart, two Navy Achievement, and one Navy Commendation medals were awarded to 1st Battalion, 12th Marines personnel.

1. Coordinating Instructions.

(2) Batteries ensure that vacated fire support bases are left in proper state, i.e., all gear and ammo removed, all bunker tops removed, and all trash burned. (Maintain firing capability until ordered to CSMO - about two hours prior to planned lift out time.)

(3) Battery commanders insure that slings and nets are maintained on position for helilift. Advise S-4, 1/12 of shortages.

(4) Battery commanders will advise CO 1/12 when fire support bases are sufficiently prepared to accept tubes.

(5) ~~Subject to terrain~~ considerations, LZ's on fire support bases having two batteries will be located between the two batteries.

(6) Thrust points effective 250600H Jan 69. All other Thrust points cancelled same DTG.

1. Admin and LogisticsReduced

a. Ammunition levels for presently occupied fire bases will be determined by this Headquarters and announced to each battery.

b. During period 24 hours prior to displacement ammunition broken out of boxes will not exceed 30 rounds per gun. A minimum number of rounds will be removed from tubers.

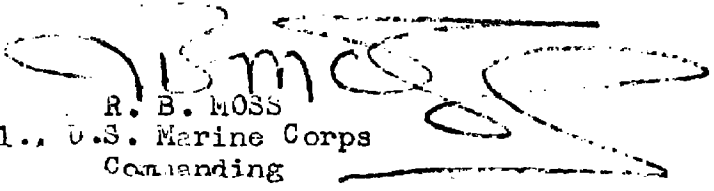

INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
