NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. OVERALL OVERVIEW OF ACTIVITIES. During this period, the emphasis has been on firing voluminous pre-emptive fires to disrupt the enemy and deny him the ability to mass forces.
2. COMMAND RELATIONS. Satisfactory
3. MISSION ASSIGNED. Direct support of 3d Marine Regiment.
4. INTELLIGENCE. Classes in crater analysis and shell identification were held.
5. OPERATIONS. Participated in Operation Idaho Canyon, Arlington Canyon, and High Rise. See paragraph 14 for missions and expenditures.
6. RESULTS OF OPERATIONS
 - a. Casualties inflicted on the enemy: 48 KIA; 2 probable; 2 WIA
 - b. Casualties sustained: 1 KIA; 1 WIA; 0 MIA
 - c. Equipment, ordnance and supplies captured, destroyed or damaged:

71 bunkers destroyed, 17 bunkers damaged, 1 bunker complex destroyed, 52 secondary explosions, 5 rocket sites destroyed, 1 rocket site damaged, 3 rocket tubes destroyed, 1 mortar site destroyed, 2 active mortar positions suppressed, 8 fighting holes destroyed, 6 50 cal machine gun pits destroyed, 1 automatic weapons pit destroyed, 20 meters of trench destroyed, 1 large cave destroyed.
7. LOGISTICS
 - a. Primary means of resupply during this reporting period was by organic motor transport.
 - b. During August, 255 tons of Class V were supplied by helicopter with 790 tons of Class V being supplied by truck.
8. COMMUNICATIONS-ELECTRONICS
 - a. The message center processed 436 messages during the month: 424 incoming and 12 outgoing.

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b. The Battalion processed 144 pieces of equipment. 37 pieces were repaired in the battalion and 37 pieces were sent to FLSG-B for higher echelon maintenance. 11 pieces were returned from FLSG-B.

9. EQUIPMENT

a. During the month of August, vehicles of the battalion transported 6,290 passengers and 790 tons of cargo over a distance of 27,708 miles.

10. CIVIC ACTION

a. During the month, 5 MEDCAPS were held in Mai Hon. Approximately 420 persons were treated for minor ailments.

11. PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

a. During the month three Marines were awarded Special Courts-Martials for violation of Article 134. Six Marines received Battalion Office Hours for violation of Articles 86, 134, 91, and 92.

b. 36 Marines were promoted: ten to Lance Corporal and 26 to Corporal.

c. Seven requests for extension of overseas tour with special leave were approved.

d. During the month, two Navy Commendation Medals, eight Purple Heart Medals, and five Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry were awarded to battalion personnel.

On 2 August, 2nd Prov fired in support of 3/3 on known bunkers at grid 049627, resulting in 2 bunkers destroyed. A 1/12 fired for W 1/12's executive officer rocket suppressive fires at grid 03226685, resulting in 1 secondary explosion. C 1/12 fired for C 1/12's executive officer on an active rocket position at grid 065687, resulting in 1 secondary explosion, rocket site destroyed, 2 bunkers destroyed, and 1 automatic weapons pit destroyed. 2nd Prov fired for an aerial observer on a rocket site at grid 154768, resulting in 4 rocket sites destroyed and 1 damaged.

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
