(a) Battery F, 2d Battalion, 12th Marines remains detached OPCON to 3d Battalion, 9th Marines for extended operations in the AN HOI area.

(b) Battery E, 2d Battalion, 12th Marines was detached OPCON and ADCCON to 3d Battalion, 12th Marines on 11 August 1966.

(c) Mortar Battery, 2d Battalion, 12th Marines remains detached.

(d) Battery B, 1st Battalion, 12th Marines was OPCON to 2d Battalion, 12th Marines from 111800 August to 140600 August 1966.

b. Sequential listing of significant events especially as they relate to:

(1) Personnel. The battalion was at 73% T/O strength at the end of the reporting period. Shortages that hinder the mission of the battalion exist in MOS 0848, OF 28, OF 33 and OF 35. There was one battle casualty and three non-battle casualties, all of which were med-evacuated. A total of 36 Marines participated in the R&R program.

(2) Administration. Administrative control of Battery E, 2d Battalion, 12th Marines was passed to Headquarters, 3d Battalion, 12th Marines at 0500 on 11 August 1966.

(3) Intelligence. During the month of August the battalion has conducted daily patrols. A patrol on 2 August threw an M-26 grenade into a cave and a secondary explosion was set off resulting in one Marine WIA. On the 8th of August a truck from Battery E, 2d Battalion, 12th Marines struck a VC mine at grid coordinates AT 988646 resulting in one VN KIA and 16 WIA. On 24 August received information of one Viet Cong company within the same grid square at grid coordinates AT 995655. A patrol from Battery B, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines discovered a tin can tied with communications wire to the top of a #10 can, aiming at gun #2, grid coordinates of aiming device AT 979642. Patrol also found a piece of cardboard paper with the following written in Vietnamese, "Do not enter this area from any direction." In the same general area of grid coordinates AT 978645, the patrol found a sign on a stick with the following written in Vietnamese, "Do not touch, this will kill Americans." An engineer squad discovered two M-2 grenades tied to the bottom of the stick, designed to detonate when the stick were disturbed. They blew them in place. On 30 August a patrol from Battery B, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines found numerous signs written in Vietnamese. They were unable to translate the signs so the patrol did not remove the signs.

(4) Training. Training continues to be initiated in conjunction with operational commitments. Small unit patrols provide an excellent means to gain proficiency in current tactical trends. A two day communications school was held at the 2d Battalion CP during the month of August for all newly arrived communicators assigned to the 2d Battalion. A 4 day driver's school was conducted resulting in 20 newly licensed drivers.

(5) Operations. Operation MACON continued throughout the month of August. Battery F, 2d Battalion, 12th Marines supported this operation from their original firing position (AT 875473). Extracts from the S-3 Journal, enclosure 2, indicate significant missions fired during the operation. 2,215 rounds were expended in support of Operation MACON and enemy casualties reported were 42 KIA (conf), 9 KIA (poss), and 3 WIA. On August 17th Operation SWANEE commenced. One platoon from Battery L, 4th Battalion, 12th Marines displaced to (AT 965618). Battery D, 2d Battalion, 12th Marines (AT 965618) maintained its original firing position in support of the operation. Artillery support during the operation continued through 211015 August. Extracts from the S-3 Journal, enclosure 2, indicate significant missions fired during the operation. 319 105mm rounds were expended in support of Operation SWANEE with no casualties reported. On 11 August OPCON and ADCON of Battery E, 2d Battalion, 12th Marines was relinquished to 3d Battalion, 12th Marines. Battery B, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines was OPCON to 2d Battalion, 12th Marines from 111800 August to 140600 August 1966. The battalion fired a total of 216 observed missions, 24 unobserved missions, and 1,059 H&I missions in support of the 9th Marines during August, expending 8,542 rounds of 105mm ammunition and 58 rounds of 155mm ammunition. Enemy casualties other than those inflicted during operations were 12 KIA (conf), 8 KIA (poss), and 8 WIA.


(6) Command and Control. The command post location and mission of the 2d Battalion, 12th Marines remains the same.

(7) Communications/Electronics. The battalion communications section received 64 PRC-25s, 14 GRC-125 (nine are complete), 34 GRA-39s, 10 MK-456s, 4 VRM-1s, 2 MRC-110s and 8 MRC 109s.

(8) Logistics. The logistics posture for the command remains satisfactory. The over-all deadline rate is 27% though the deadline rate for M-35 trucks is considerably higher, (50%) due to the lack of 2d and 3d echelon parts. The main problem in maintenance is the lack of trained mechanics and repair parts shortages. Communications maintenance continues to be completed in a reasonable time.

(9) Civic Action. On 14 August construction of the LE DONG School, grid coordinates (AT 998661) was begun, construction was completed 15 August. The school is sixteen by twenty feet, plywood decking and half sides, half side screen wire, and roofing of tin. The furniture was built prior to construction of the school in the Battalion CP, the furniture consists of five desks, eight feet long, and four desks, six feet long. The teacher's desk was purchased in DA NANG. On 16 August the school was officially opened with LtCol J. R. GILLMAN JR., Commanding Officer, 2d Battalion, 12th Marines, giving a speech in Vietnamese to the children, teacher, and people of LE SON. Refreshments were served to all present. A Vietnamese national flag was purchased and was raised in front of the school on 16 August and has not been lowered to date. Donations for the teacher's salary are collected monthly from the officers and men of this battalion. At the time of the opening, 88 school kits were placed on the desks, one for each student. Vietnamese school books for grades 3, 4, and 5 were acquired in DA NANG for the teacher's use. More are needed. On 10 August an enlisted Marine from this command escorted a Vietnamese boy who had lost his leg from the knee down as a result of Marine action 8 months ago, to Saigon to be fitted with an artificial limb. A collection from the officers and men in the battalion was taken and 23,600 piastres were donated. The Vietnamese boy is expected to return in approximately 3 weeks. During the month of August 218 Vietnamese civilians were treated from the villages of HA DONG (AT 995645) and LE SON (1) (AT 980660). During the month 1,760 pounds of food, 1,125 pounds of clothing, 377 bars of soap, and 300 pounds of miscellaneous items were distributed to the villagers of LE SON (1) and HA DONG.

The chaplain conducted 20 Divine Services and one memorial service during the month of August. He counselled nine Marines and gave two lectures on moral guidance to Marines within the command. The chaplain made 32 visits to units within the command, contacting 742 military and civilians. He made 175 hospital calls, wrote an article and sent pictures for use in Rockford, and attended 4 conferences at III MAF and Division.
