PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During January the Second Battalion, 12th Marines fired a total of 2188 observed missions, 1665 unobserved missions, and 2803 H&I missions in support of the 9th Marines. Ammunition expenditures were 54,420 rounds of 105mm, 15,892 rounds of 107mm and 10,085 rounds of 155mm.

Enemy casualties inflicted during January were 76 KIA and 68 WIA. In addition there were 63 secondary explosions and 14 bunkers destroyed.

On 15 January 1968, 2nd Battalion, 12th Marines assumed OPCON of B-1-13 after they had displaced from Phu Bai to Dong Ha. On 21 January 1968, B-1-13 was chopped OPCON to 13th Marines and was helilifted to Khe Sanh. On 21 January 1968, M-4-12 was chopped OPCON to 4th Battalion, 12th Marines. On 27 January 1968, 2nd Battalion, 12th Marines assumed OPCON of H-3-12 and W-3-12 from BLT 2/4. W-3-12 was helilifted to A-3 and H-3-12 to Dong Ha.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Combat Missions Assigned. Direct support of 9th Marines
2. Significant Operations Conducted. Operations Kentucky, Highrise and Napoleon
3. Casualties Inflicted on the Enemy. 76 KIA and 68 WIA
4. Casualties Sustained. 1 KIA, 4 WIA and 1 MI.
5. Logistics. Complete logistic support was provided for the five organic batteries. Six additional OPCON batteries received Class V resupply and ordnance repair. Approximately 85,000 rounds of artillery ammunition were transported by convoy or helicopter. Second echelon repair parts in the ordnance and motor transport areas remained in short supply. A new motor pool area was constructed to include a truck park and wash ramp. Approximately 20 tropical huts in the Headquarters Battery area were completed. A combined battery mess facility was established for Echo and Fox batteries at C-2.
6. Civic Action. The 2nd Battalion, 12th Marines primary civic action project, the two room school house in Thiet Hamlet, neared completion in January. The battalion participated in the Vietnamese celebration of Tet by distributing candy, toys, and Tet envelopes in Cam Hieu Village. A total of 113 Vietnamese were treated at Medcaps.
7. Personnel. The battalion was 84% T/O strength at the end of the reporting period. Shortages exist in the following MOS's 0122, 0239, 0441, 0811, 0848, 1341 and 1345. Thirty-eight Marines participated in the R&R program during January.

8. Intelligence. Enemy activity has increased appreciably during the month of January. A major ground contact was made by 3/4 northeast of Con Thien and 3/3 had two smaller contacts northwest of Gio Linh. Convoy ambushes, road mining, and sniper incidents have increased along Routes 9 and 561 in an attempt to disrupt our resupply activities. Con Thien has taken sporadic incoming during January, increasing in volume during the last half of the month. Because of all increased activity it appears that during the month of February we can expect more contact with the enemy.

Instructions on crater analysis were distributed to firing batteries and forward observer teams in order to increase accuracy in returning fire.

9. Communications. Considerable difficulty was experienced with computer hot lines to the firing batteries due to the unreliability of radio relay. Four fire direction nets were in operation as back up for the computer lines. Staff visits with liaison and observer personnel in the field have resulted in better communications on the conduct of fire nets.

10. Training. During January this battalion utilized three division contact teams. The PMO Contact Team briefed the battalion officers and noncommissioned officers on marijuana problems. All battery armorers were trained in capabilities, operation, and maintenance of the starlight scope. The Personal Response Contact Team instructed 22 officers and staff noncommissioned officers and 154 enlisted men. Formal schools attended by members of this battalion included: NCO School, kPS School, Projectionists School, and officer and enlisted Embarkation School.
