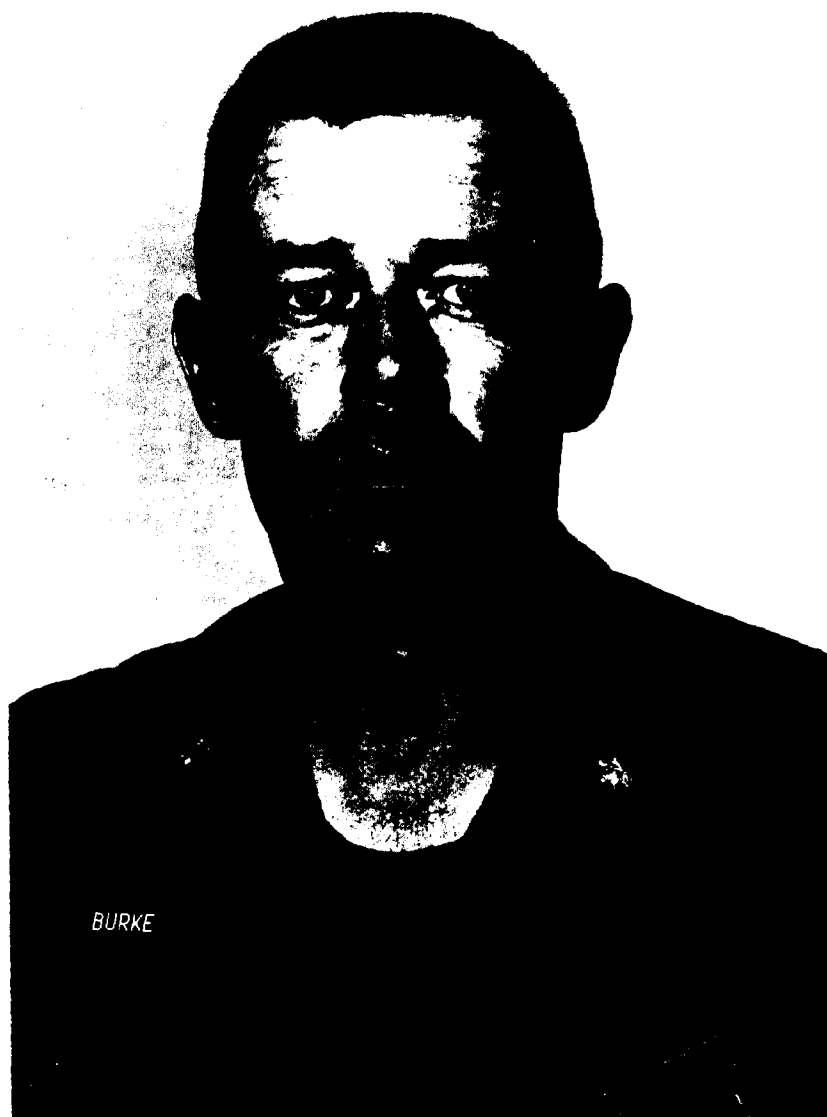

PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of March the Battalion remained in General Support of the 1st Marine Division. The Battalion supported no named operations during the month.

The Battalion retained Operational and Administrative Control of Battery K, 4th Battalion, 13th Marines until 19 March when control of the Battery was passed to the 1st Battalion, 13th Marines for redeployment to COMUS and further de-activation. While under the operational control of the 4th Battalion, 11th Marines, Battery K expended a total of 72,332 rounds.

Battery M remained in General Support, Reinforcing 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines. The Battery continued to answer calls for fire directly from reconnaissance units and observation posts operating in the southern portion of the SAOR.

Battery K's mission remained Reinforcing, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines, throughout the period.

Battery L remained in General Support throughout the month. On 7 March, Battery L moved to the Northern Artillery Cantonment and occupied the position previously occupied by Battery K, 4th Battalion, 13th Marines. Battery K stood down from combat on 7 March and moved to Hill 34 to prepare for redeployment.

During the month of March units of the Battalion fired a total of 1405 missions expending 23,209 rounds in support of the following units:

g. Intelligence.

(1) During the month of March the S-2 made six liaison trips to Regimental S-2 and four liaison trips to Division S-2. Counter rocket observation posts Tiger, Hawk, Laugh, Lou, and Crowsnest were visited during the month for the purpose of training and inspection.

(2) A total of 3650 \$VJ was expended for ordnance turned in through the Volunteer Informant Program.

h. Organization and Operations.

(1) The Battalion remained in General Support of the 1st Marine Division throughout the month.

(3) On 7 March Battery L moved to the Northern Artillery Cantonment and occupied the position formally occupied by Battery K, 4th Battalion, 13th Marines.

(4) On 7 March Battery K, 4th Battalion, 13th Marines, stood down from combat and moved to Hill 34 to prepare for redeployment and de-activation.

(5) On 19 March, Operational Control of Battery K, 4th Battalion, 13th Marines was passed to the 1st Battalion, 13th Marines for redeployment to COMUS.

(6) During the period 19 to 23 March, the 4th Battalion provided a forward observer team which occupied an OP on Hill 327 during an expected high threat period. The team had no enemy sightings during the period.

(7) On 30 March the OP on Hill 327 was again occupied by a forward observer team from the 4th Battalion. The team will remain in position until the present expected high threat period has passed.

i. Training.

(1) Normal GHS and MOS training was conducted as operational commitments allowed.

(2) The Operations Section conducted a one week FADAC operators course during the month, training four operators from this and other artillery units.

j. Logistics, Equipment and Supply.

(1) During this period the deadline rate for M109 Howitzers remained at a satisfactory level due to the outstanding performance of maintenance crews. However, due to the total number of rounds fired from each weapon, we are contemplating a much greater turnover of major M109 components.

(2) Ten motor transport vehicles are presently deadlined for a rate of 11 percent. Of these ten, four are deadlined at 3rd echelon facilities.

(3) Requisitions submitted since this Battalion has been in the Republic of Vietnam total 51,636. Of this number 32,302 have been filled.

(4) Battery "H", 4th Battalion, 13th Marines stood down from combat on 7 March for redeployment and de-activation. Their P/E assets and excesses were distributed throughout the Division to fill shortages in other units. The transfer of equipment was completed by 19 March when ADCON/OPCON was passed to the 1st Battalion, 13th Marines.
