COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE

On 1 January 1967, Lieutenant Colonel R. L. CHRISTIAN, JR., two officers and thirty-three enlisted personnel from this organization were TAD to the Special Landing Force, Seventh Fleet to participate in Operation DECKHOUSE V in the Republic of South Vietnam. Lieutenant Colonel CHRISTIAN acted as the artillery officer on the staff of CTG 79.5 and as the commanding Officer of the Provisional Artillery Group which was established ashore. The remainder of the personnel provided fire direction assistance to the Provisional Artillery Group head-quarters and the LVTH-6 platoon which was incorporated into the Provisional Artillery Group.

On 14 January 1967 Battery F arrived on Okinawa from the Republic of South Vietnam for the purpose of refurbishing equipment and conducting individual and unit training for personnel. Battery G and Mortar Battery completed their refurbishing of equipment and cycle of training for personnel and returned to the operational control of BUT 1/4. While attached to this organization, Mortar Battery conducted a field firing exercise and Battery G calibrated their six 105mm Howitzers.

Lieutenant Colonel Robert L. CHRISTIAN, JR. returned from participation in DECKHOUSE V on 19 January 1967; whereas, the remainder of the personnel from this organization who participated in the operation returned on 23 January 1967.

The Battalion Survey Section dispatched a survey team composed of two officers and nine enlisted to the Zambales Training Area, Republic of the Philippines, for the purpose of establishing permanent survey control points within the training area.
