SECRETCOMMANDER'S NARRATIVE

On 2 March 1967, Major A. F. THOMPSON, JR. returned from on-the-job training with the Special Landing Force, TG 79.5. While TAD, Major THOMPSON participated in the planning and execution of Operation "DECKHOUSE SIX".

On 2 March 1967, Captain G. B. FILE and seven (7) enlisted returned from TAD with the Special Landing Force, TG 79.5. This group augmented the personnel of the SLF Fire Support Coordination Center during Operation "DECKHOUSE SIX".

From 2-8 March 1967, LtCol R. L. CHRISTIAN, JR. observed Battery K, 4th Battalion, 13th Marines conducting a Field Firing Exercise at Camp Fuji-McNair, Japan. While at Camp Fuji-McNair, Battery K conducted extensive field firing during day and night conditions and as a result of this concentrated training, achieved a C-1 category of training readiness.

On 13 March 1967, Battery B, 1st Battalion, 12th Marines and Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines arrived at this Battalion for the purpose of Refurbishing Equipment, Replacement of Personnel, and Further Training.

On 13 March 1967, all Officers, Staff Non-Commissioned Officers, and assigned NBC Non-Commissioned Officers of the Battalion attended a two (2) hour briefing on Chemical/Biological Operations presented by a U.S. Army briefing team in the Camp Hansen Base Theater.

On 13 March 1967, Major CHANG, Chao-Chi and Major LI, Wen-Kun, Chinese Marine Corps, completed a two (2) week on-the-job training program in Artillery Staff Procedures conducted by this Battalion. During the training, they were briefed by and observed the duties of all Staff and Special Staff Officers of the Battalion. They also received an orientation tour of the 3rd Force Service Regiment and Provisional Service Battalion, 9th Marine Amphibious Brigade to observe Maintenance Functions and Procedures.

On 13 March 1967, Captain YANG, Hsing-Kuo, Chinese Marine Corps arrived for two (2) weeks of training in the Techniques of Fire Support Coordination. This training emphasized the role of Artillery, Air, and Naval Gunfire Support in Amphibious Operations and the Control and Coordination Techniques Employed to Exploit their Capabilities.

On 19 March 1967, First Lieutenant CHUNG, Ha-Tien, Vietnamese Marine Corps, arrived for two (2) weeks of on-the-job training in Artillery Staff Procedures.
