#### COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE

On 2 March 1967, Major A. F. THOMPSON, JR. returned from on-the-job training with the Special Landing Force, TG 79.5. While TAD, Major THOMPSON participated in the planning and execution of Operation "DECKHOUSE SIX".


