

#### NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of September, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines continued in direct support of the 26th Marines. Command less epon was with the Commanding General, 9th MAB while operational control remained with the 11th Marines.

The month of September saw a large turnever of critical personnel within the Battalion. LtCol. D. H. Strain relieved LtCol. D. F. Gragen as
Commanding Officer on 5 September. On 6 September Maj. J. C. Atkins relieved Maj. J. M. Updyke as the S-3. Subsequently on the 22nd of September
Maj. F. C. English was shifted to the S-3 position when Maj. C. H. Giuba
became the Battalion Executive Officer. Maj. Atkins went to the 26th
Marines FSCC as the Artillery Lisison Officer.

Several changes of units operationally controlled by the 1st Battalion, 13th Marines were effected. On 21 September Battery \*\*In\*, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines and Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines relieved Battery \*\*Bn\*, and Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines in place. Battery \*\*Bn\*, and Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines reembarked as part of SLF Brave.

Artillery support provided by the 1st Battalian, 13th Marines during September included support of operations in the 26th Marines Area of Operations; counter rocket fire in support of the 11th Marines counter rocket program; defensive fires and fires on targets of apportunity for the Northern Sector Defense Command; and numerous other fires for demonstrations and schools. While the Battalian is credited with only one confirmed kill during the month, intelligence reports indicate that many other kills occurred, but are unconfirmed. Twenty-Saxth Marines spot reports also indicate numerous unconfirmed kills, blood trails, and drag marks resulting from 1st Battalian, 13th Marines artillery fire. On 10 September 1969, an A. O. reported 20 probable NVA KIA by Battery was, during a mission fired on the night of 9-10 September 1969.
