

PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Command of the First Battalion, 13th Marines remained with the 11th Marines during the period 1-19 March. Operational control of Battery B was re-assumed from Second Battalion, 11th Marines on 1 March. Operational control of Mortar Battery, First Battalion, 11th Marines was passed to First Battalion, 11th Marines on 6 March. The Battalion mission remained as direct support of the 26th Marines during the period 1-6 March. During the period 7-9 March the mission was general support/reinforcing First Battalion, 11th Marines. The period 10-19 March was a stand down period in preparation for the Battalion's return to CONUS on 19 March.

Support was provided to the 26th Marines throughout their AO during the period 1-6 March. In addition to fires provided for units in contact; grid saturations, prep fires, counter rocket fires, rice denials, support of CAP's, base camp saturations, and intelligence targets were also in the Battalion's scheme of support. The number of enemy kills totaled 6 for the period 1-6 March 1970.

On 6 March, Headquarters Battery, Battery A, Battery C, and Mortar Battery were relieved on position by units of First Battalion, 11th Marines and displaced to Hill 34. Battery B and Battery C were emplaced tactically with the mission of general support/reinforcing First Battalion, 11th Marines during the period 7-9 March. During the period 10-19 March the Battalion prepared to embark for CONUS on 19 March.

On 18 March the Battalion participated in the 1st Marine Division (REIN) FMF farewell ceremony for RLT-26 at the Danang Airbase. On 19 March the Battalion embarked aboard aircraft for CONUS. At this time command was passed from Commanding General, 1st Marine Division to Commanding General, 5th Marine Expeditionary Brigade.

- 06 March Operational control of Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines passed to 1st Battalion, 11th Marines.
- 10 March Relieved of mission as general support/reinforcing 1st Battalion, 11th Marines. All Battalion units now in stand down condition.
- 18 March Participated in farewell ceremony for RLT-26 at Danang Airbase.
- 19 March Command embarked by aircraft for deployment to CONUS.
- 19 March Command passed from Commanding General, 1st Marine Division to Commanding General, 5th Marine Expeditionary Brigade.
