#### PART II

#### Narrative Summary

During this reporting period emphasis was placed on the continued development and improvement of battery positions. GMS and MOS training was carried out while the 2nd En, 13th Marines gave close and continuous fire support to units of the 1st Marine Division and the Army of the Republic of Vietnam.

During the early morning hours on 4 March, the battalion CP and Battery "D", 2nd Battalion, 13th Marines received an unknown number of 122mm rockets. The battalion fired a total of 2572 rounds of counter rocket fire. No personnel casualties resulted from the attack although one personnel hut was destroyed.

The Gun Direction Computer, M-18 (FADAC) was introduced to the 2nd Bn, 13th Marines on 11 March. Training of operators by the FADAC Assistance Team was begun immediately and the computer was installed in the battalion fire direction center on 25 March, ready to be employed. Use of this computer improves accuracy, speed, and the ability to better mass the fires of the battalion.

On 18 March issue of M-16 rifles was completed. Training had begun prior to this date and was completed by 18 March. All hands received safety instruction and zeroed their rifles for battlesights.

On 21 March, Battery"E" received 3 rounds of mortar fire, but continued firing a mission.

Mortar Battery(-), 2nd Bn, 13th Marines was chopped to OPCON of 1st FAG on 29 March. Four M-30 mortars and the personnel necessary to man them were displaced. The remainder of the battery remains in position at the 27th Marines CP.

The Battalion suffered four casualties during this reporting period, as a result of enemy action.
