## PART II

Narrative Summary

The 2nd Battalion, 13th Marines continued to provide artillery support to units in the Danang area and Operation Allenbrook during this reporting period. Of particular significance was the training of ARVN cannoners from a newly organized ARVN artillery battalion. On 10 June the first class of thirty personnel was started. Training lasts for seven days, at which time thirty new personnel arrive and the class of the previous week goes on to further training. Thus far three classes have completed the training.

On 12 June a battalion FDC school was begun. Four men from each firing battery were trained both in the classroom and on-the-job training in the battalion FDC.

On 14 June and 24 June a four-day Forward Observer school was conducted by 2/13 for 2/27 and 3/27 squad and patrol leaders.

In order to better accomplish the battalion's mission, three firing batteries, Batteries "D", "E", and Mortar Battery, were displaced to their present positions on 22 June. All three batteries were displaced and ready to fire in a total elapsed time of 3 hours, 15 minutes.

During the reporting period a Command Materiel Management Inspection was conducted by inspection teams from the 11th Marines and 1st Marine Division with satisfactory results.

Report Required: Comments on ARVN Training Program

1. Purpose. To establish a program of instruction for ARVN cannoneer trainees.
2. Background. 2nd Bn, 13th Marines has been directed to provide on-the-job training for approximately 200 ARVN soldiers. Trainees will report in groups of about 30 soldiers beginning 10 June 1968. Duration of the course will be 7 days and will continue until 22 July 1968.
3. Action. 1stLt GIERES is designated OIC and SSgt PAYNE is designated NCOIC of the detail. P/2/13 will provide 3 howitzers with prime movers and section. Instructors will be assigned by the OIC and NCOIC and a list turned into the S-3 on 9 June 1968.
4. Coordinating Instructions
  - a. Training will be conducted in accordance with enclosure (1).
  - b. OIC and NCOIC will obtain tents, heads, cots and other required material from Headquarters Battery Commander.
  - c. The ARVN trainees will be fed in the Battalion messhall.
  - d. Each ARVN trainees group will be commanded by an ARVN Lieutenant, assisted by two ARVN NCO's. The ARVN Lieutenant will be prepared to render assistance in training and may act as an interpreter when required. The ARVN NCO's are qualified cannoneers who will be prepared to act as assistant instructors as requested. In addition, at least one full time interpreter will accompany each group.




