PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During March the 26th Marines stood down from combat operations in preparation for redeployment and deactivation. Only during the first six days of March were the 26th Marines committed to combat operations; In that period enemy activity remained at the same level as in February.

On 1 March the 26th Marines assumed operational control of the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines, who took responsibility for the Central Zone of the 26th Marines TAOR. The 3rd Battalion, 26th Marines stood down from combat operations on the same day. On 1 March the 1st Battalion conducted a joint operation in company (rein) strength with Regional Forces. The operation ended the same day with negative results.

General VIEN, Chairman, JGS, RVN, presented the Cross of Gallantry with Palm, to the 26th Marines on 5 March. In the same ceremony one Marine received the Cross of Gallantry with Palm and six Marines with Gold Star. The presentations were attended by many distinguished visitors, including Lieutenant General LAM, CG, I Corps and Lieutenant General NICKERSON, CG, III MAF.

On 6 March the 26th Marines conducted its last combat operation. At 1335 1st Marines assumed the responsibility for the remainder of the 26th Marines TAOR, and the 26th Marines stood down from combat operations.

The period 7-17 March saw the 26th Marines engaged in the preparation and execution of redeployment and deactivation. On 18 March a farewell ceremony was held honoring the 26th Marines just prior to the Regimental Colors enplaning for CONUS. Many dignitaries attended including Lieutenant General LAM, Lieutenant General MCCUTCHEON, Lieutenant General ZAIS, Major General WHEELER, Major General THRASH, Major General BOWMAN, Brigadier General PADALINO, Brigadier General SPANJER and Brigadier General LEE. In addition to the parade, 11 members of RLT 26 received Vietnamese decorations from Lieutenant General LAM.

On 19 March 350 personnel, including the Commanding Officer 26th Marines, departed RVN by two MAC aircraft at 0900. The only stops enroute to El Toro were at Kadena AFB, Okinawa, and Oakland, California.

Arrival at El Toro was at 1000, 19 March 1970 where a welcoming ceremony was conducted honoring RLT 26. The Commandant of the Marine Corps, CG, FMFPac, CG, MCAS, El Toro and CG 5thMEB were in attendance. RLT 26 personnel arrived at Camp Pendleton at 1430 19 March 1970 and set up headquarters at Las Pulgas.

1. Missions/Operationsa. Command Relations

- (1) Command of the 26th Marines remained with the Commanding General, 1st Marine Division (Rein) for the period 1-19 March 1970.
- (2) Command of Headquarters Company, 1st, 2nd and 3rd Battalions, 26th Marines remained with the Commanding Officer, 26th Marines for the period 1-19 March 1970.

b. Combat Missions Assigned

- (1) 1-6 March Conduct offensive operations within assigned TAOR to locate and destroy enemy forces, bases and logistic installations; deploy forces throughout assigned TAOR to provide security for vital areas and installations; conduct offensive and reconnaissance operations within the Division RZ on order; support the RD program within the TAOR; conduct operations in support of the RVN Pacification and Reconstruction Program to upgrade designated hamlets; conduct offensive operations exterior to the TAOR when directed locate and interdict routes of infiltration into the TAOR with emphasis on routes of approach to probable rocket and mortar launch positions; provide security for engineer projects on National Route 1 and other critical roads within the TAOR; be prepared to provide a rifle company (-) (Rein) for employment in the Danang area in connection with evacuation of noncombatants; perform inspections of high priority bridges within the TAOR; deny the enemy use of waterways within the TAOR; employ radio frequency and line sensors in support of tactical operations and in defense of the Danang Vital Area; provide support to NSDC for ground defense and damage control measures; conduct psychological operations within the TAOR in support of GVN and US/FUJAF objectives; conduct operations within TAOR for protection of civilians and rice during rice harvest periods; prepare plans for special operations within the 1st Marine Division TAOR to include employment of one or more battalions for employment anywhere in RVN on 12 hours notice with the capability of committing the remainder of the Regiment within an additional 12 hours; and field a primary and secondary command group as required.

c. Command and Control

{1} During the period 1-6 March, the Regimental Command Post was located at Camp Perdue {AT 947755} Quang Nam, Republic of Vietnam. Communications were established between the C.P. and the battalions by radio and land line. Liaison visits were made as necessary between subordinate and adjacent units. There was no loss of control during the month.

{2} During the period 7-19 March, the Regimental Command Post was located at 1st Shore Party Cantonment {AT 962747}, Quang Nam, Republic of Vietnam.

d. Organic Operations

During the reporting period, the 26th Marines conducted 14 listening and observation posts, 51 patrols, 65 ambushes, 1 operation in company strength and 1 operation in battalion {-} strength.

2. INTELLIGENCE

a. General Enemy Situation.

No comparative analysis can be made between the month of February and first 6 days of March. There was neither a increase nor any substantial decrease in enemy activity. The expected attacks by fire during the period of turnover of the TAOR from the 26th Marines to the 1st Marines never materialized. There were no significant events within the TAOR during the operating period in March. The total NVA/VC killed was six as opposed to a total of 88 during February. Movement continued to be detected along the Tuy Loan Corridor. The IOD observed five VC/NVA moving last on 3 March at AT874705. After the subsequent fire mission the enemy was observed crawling. IOD claimed one NVA KIA. Shortly afterwards C/1/26 observed seven enemy with packs and rifles at AT927719. A subsequent sweep of the area by two squads produced negative results. No new evidence of resupply or reinforcement was noted. Two agent reports in early March alluded again to a possible reinforcement of the 3d Battalion AO to reinforce or replace the badly depleted forces of the Northern Wing.

- (2) Balanced Pressure System (BPS) and Unattended Seismic Detectors (USD) Danang Barrier. 285 activators were recorded, resulting in 307 rounds of artillery, mortar, tank, recoilless rifle and M-70 ammunition fired.

e. Enemy Trends

Enemy activity, disposition of enemy forces capabilities and probable courses of action remain the same. Of significance was the failure of the enemy to take advantage of the turn-over of the TAOR during a period when friendly area familiarity was at best sketchy and the lunar illumination was at a low percentage.

f. Weather

During the reporting period, weather conditions had no adverse effects on friendly or enemy operations. The mean high temperature was 87 degrees and the mean low was 72 degrees. The maximum temperature was 93 degrees and the minimum was 69 degrees. The relative humidity was 86 percent and no precipitation was recorded.

g. Administration and Security

All destruction reports were checked and signed off by the Classified Material Control Officer. Liaison was maintained with Division Staff Counterintelligence and arrangements made with 3d Counterintelligence Team to conduct a security sweep of the Shore Party Cantonment spaces occupied by the 26th Marines.

5. AIR SUPPORT

a. Units

During the period of 1-6 March, the bulk of the air support was provided by the First Marine Aircraft Wing. Additional air support was provided by US Army and Air Force units.

b. Mission

- (1) Resupply. Helicopter support consisted of 173 sorties delivering 86,900 pounds of cargo and 3,924 passengers.

Rifle companies were reduced to zero strength; all personnel were transferred to the respective H&S Companies.

8. LOGISTICSa. Supply/Resupply

All outposts were resupplied by helicopter. Supply support was furnished by the Force Logistics Command, and ammunition was obtained from ASP #2. All classes of supplies were obtained through normal requisitioning procedures. Special Requisitions were submitted for standard utilities and boots for the Ceremonial Detail, which left RVN on 19 March 1970. Redistribution of the Regiment's assets commenced on 1 March and continued to 19 March 1970. Approximately 85% of the Regiment's T/E and Operating Stocks were redistributed to Division Units, FLC, 1stMAW and the Vietnamese Marine Corps.

b. Food/Water

A total of 180,000 pounds of food and water were heli-lifted from LZ's 467 and 460 to Regimental outposts 1, 2, 4 and 7 and Battalion outposts 2, 4, 8, Reno and Hill 270.

c. Maintenance

The equipment readiness of the Regimental Headquarters Company was C-2 and the Battalions were in C-1 status at the beginning of the reporting period, but by 19 March all units were in a C-4 status due to the redistribution of Regimental assets. All forward echelon maintenance continued to be performed by FLC.

d. Camp Facilities Development

Construction continued on O.P. Reno and a new heli pad was constructed and work continued to improve wire and fixed positions. Hill 270 was approximately 95% completed. The only remaining project was the construction of 100 meters of wire on the north slope of the hill.

9. TRAINING. No training was conducted in the reporting period other than drill for upcoming ceremonies.

11. Communications

a. During the period 1-19 March 1970, the Communication Platoon made preparations for stand down and deactivation. This included relief in place by 1st Marines, a shift to a stand down CP, and invoicing equipment designated for redistribution within 1st Marine Division.

b. Chronological listing of events.

- (1) 1 March. 3rd Battalion 26th Marines stood down and secured from all regimental radio nets.
- (2) 4 March. Advance party personnel from 1st Marines arrived and began phasing into the communication system.
- (3) 6 March. The 26th Marines Regimental Communications Platoon was relieved by 1st Marines.
- (4) 8 March. All crypto gear turned in to the RPS Custodian. Began burning January and February classified messages.
- (5) 10 March. Closed out the accounts at DX and FSR. Communication account turned into Supply.
- (6) 15 March. The Communication Platoon was disbanded this date.

12. MEDICAL AND DENTAL SUPPORT

a. (RAS) During the period 1-6 March 1970 the Regimental Aid Station was located at Camp Fordue. On 7 March 1970 the Aid Station was re-located to 1st Shore Party CP. The Aid Station was manned by one Medical Officer and two Hospital Corpsmen. On 8 March 1970 the Aid Station began to administer inoculations to personnel in preparation for the re-deployment of the 26th Marines.

b. (1/26) The Battalion Aid Station was located on Hill 10, but was re-located at the Division "Stack Arms" Center. Due to reassignment of the Medical personnel the BAS was closed and medical support was provided by 2/1's BAS.

c. (2/26) The Battalion Aid Station was located at the "Rock Crusher" from 1-15 March 1970. After reassignment of the medical personnel, the Battalion was moved into 1st Shore Party CP and supported by the RAS.

13. RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES

a. Personnel.

One Regimental and three Battalion Chaplains were assigned to the Regiment.

b. Services.

During March the Chaplains conducted a total of 42 worship services with a total attendance of 840; made 9 visits to the hospital; visited 364 patients; handled 12 Red Cross cases.

c. Facilities.

The chapel at Camp Perdue seats fifty and is of semi-permanent construction with a small Chaplain's office in the rear. During the month the 1st Battalion began rebuilding the Battalion Chapel. When completed and dedicated, it will be an air-conditioned chapel, seating forty, with an office and sleeping quarters in the rear. The 2nd Battalion used a small building at the Rear CP for a Chapel. It seats twenty-five and has a small office and sleeping quarters in the rear. Most field services for the 2nd Battalion are held in tents or in the open. The 3rd Battalion shares the use of a chapel with the 7th Engineer Bn. During the period 7-19 March the religious facilities at each of the stand down areas were utilized.

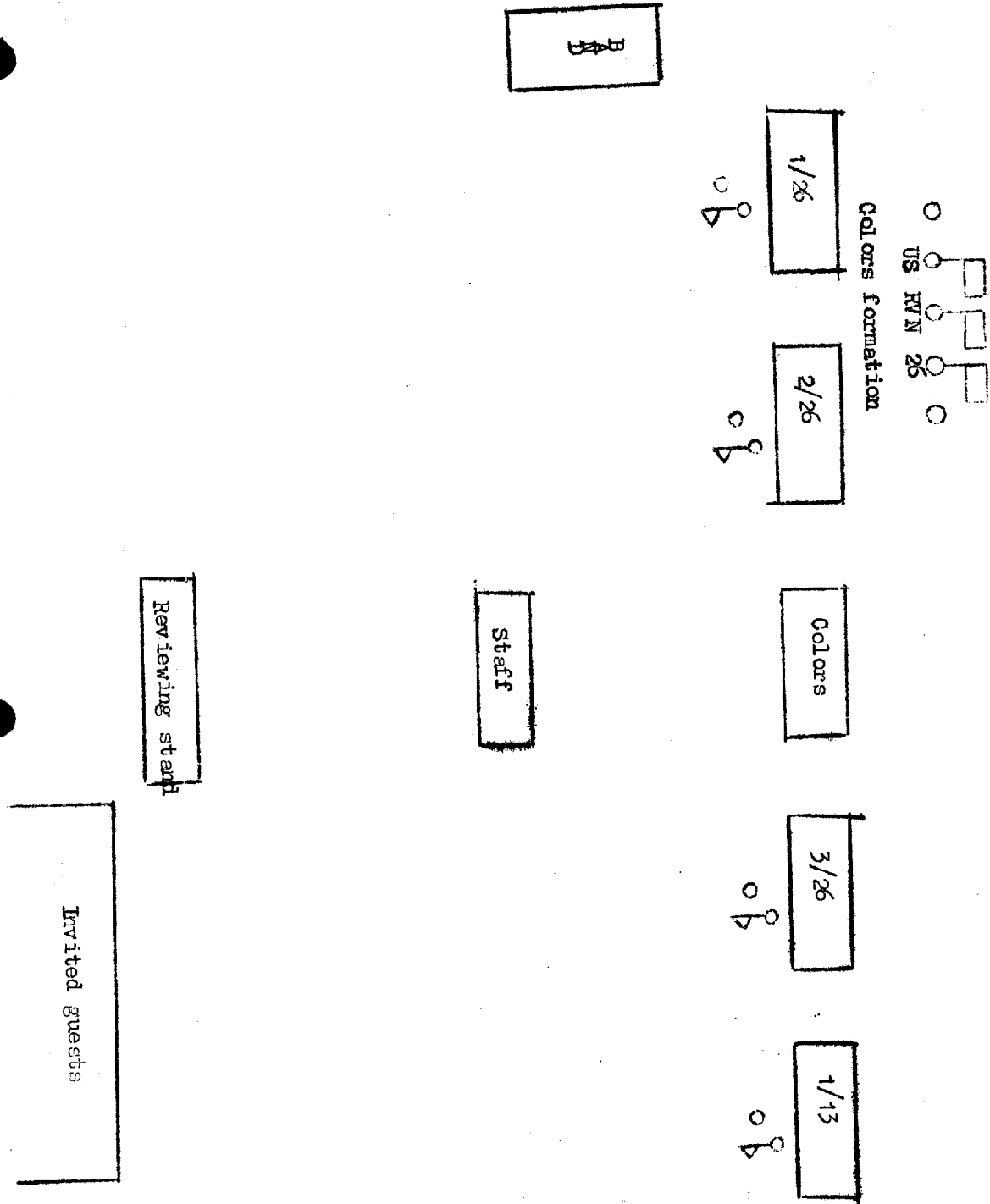

DETAILED SEQUENCE OF EVENTS

The Vietnamese Awards Ceremony will be held at 1st MI Bn industrial area.

1245 All participants in position as shown in enclosure (1) at parade rest.

1300 (1) The commanding officer of troops commands "Attention".

(2) After General Lam is seated the adjutant commands "Parade Rest" (Commanding officer of troops and staff remain at attention).

(3) The adjutant commands "SOUND OFF". Band marches.

(4) Immediately after sound off, the adjutant commands "Regiment Attention".

(5) The adjutant commands "Present Arms".

(6) The adjutant faces the commanding officer of troops, salutes, and reports, "Sir, the parade is formed".

(7) The commanding officer of troops returns the salute and commands, "Take your post, sir".

(8) The commanding officer of troops commands "Order arms".

(9) The commanding officer of troops directs the adjutant "Receive the report, sir".

(10) The adjutant faces the formation and commands "Report".

(11) Battalion representatives report "(Unit Title) all present or accounted for."

(12) After receiving the report, the adjutant faces the commanding officer of troops, salutes, and reports "Sir, all present or accounted for".

(13) The commanding officer of troops returns the salute, and directs the adjutant "Take your post, sir".

(14) The commanding officer of troops commands "Persons to be decorated, and all colors, Center MARCH".

(15) Persons to be decorated, under command of the senior present, form a double rank, in front of the line of platoon commanders, centered on the colors. They form according to the rank of decoration, higher being right, those receiving similar decorations take position by seniority within each decoration group.

(16) All colors and color guards form a single rank behind center of line of persons to be decorated.

(17) The regimental staff, under command of the senior staff officer, executes right face and moves to the right a sufficient distance to allow clearance for colors and persons to be decorated, then halts and executes left face.

(18) The commanding officer of troops assumes a position 5 paces in center front of persons to be decorated and facing reviewing stand.

(19) The commanding officer of troops commands "Forward, MARCH". Guide is center in all ranks.

(20) When he has reached a position 6 paces from Lieutenant General Lam, the commanding officer of troops orders "Detachment HALT". The band stops playing as the detachment halts.

(21) The commanding officer of troops salutes Lieutenant General Lam and reports "Sir, persons to be decorated are present".

(22) Lieutenant General Lam returns the salute and orders "Present the command, Sir".

(23) The commanding officer of troops faces about and commands "Present arms".

(24) The band plays the National Anthems of the Republic of Vietnam and then of the United States. On completion of the anthems, the commanding officer of troops commands "Order arms".

(25) A designated staff officer reads the name of person decorated and award presented.

(26) Immediately after shaking hands, the person decorated salutes Lieutenant General Lam.

(27) Lieutenant General Lam resumes his post. Upon command "Posts, MARCH" by the commanding officer of troops, persons decorated march to the left of the reviewing stand. Colors return to their posts.

(28) When the Colors, staff, and commanding officer of troops have returned to their normal positions, the Band Plays the Marine Corps Hymn.

(29) At the conclusion of the Marine Corps Hymn, the commanding officer of troops does an about face and commands, "Battalion Commanders, take charge and march off the field".

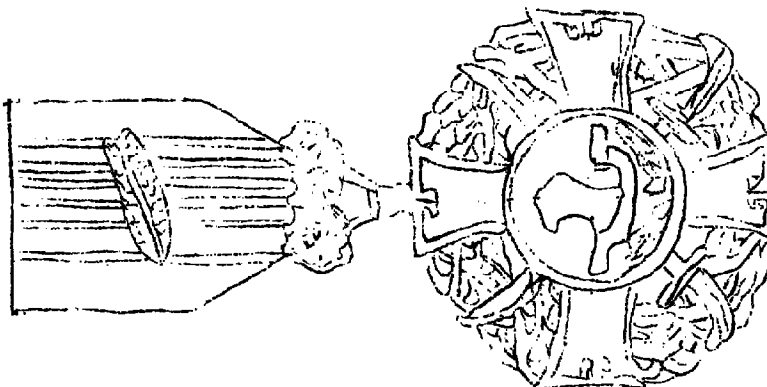

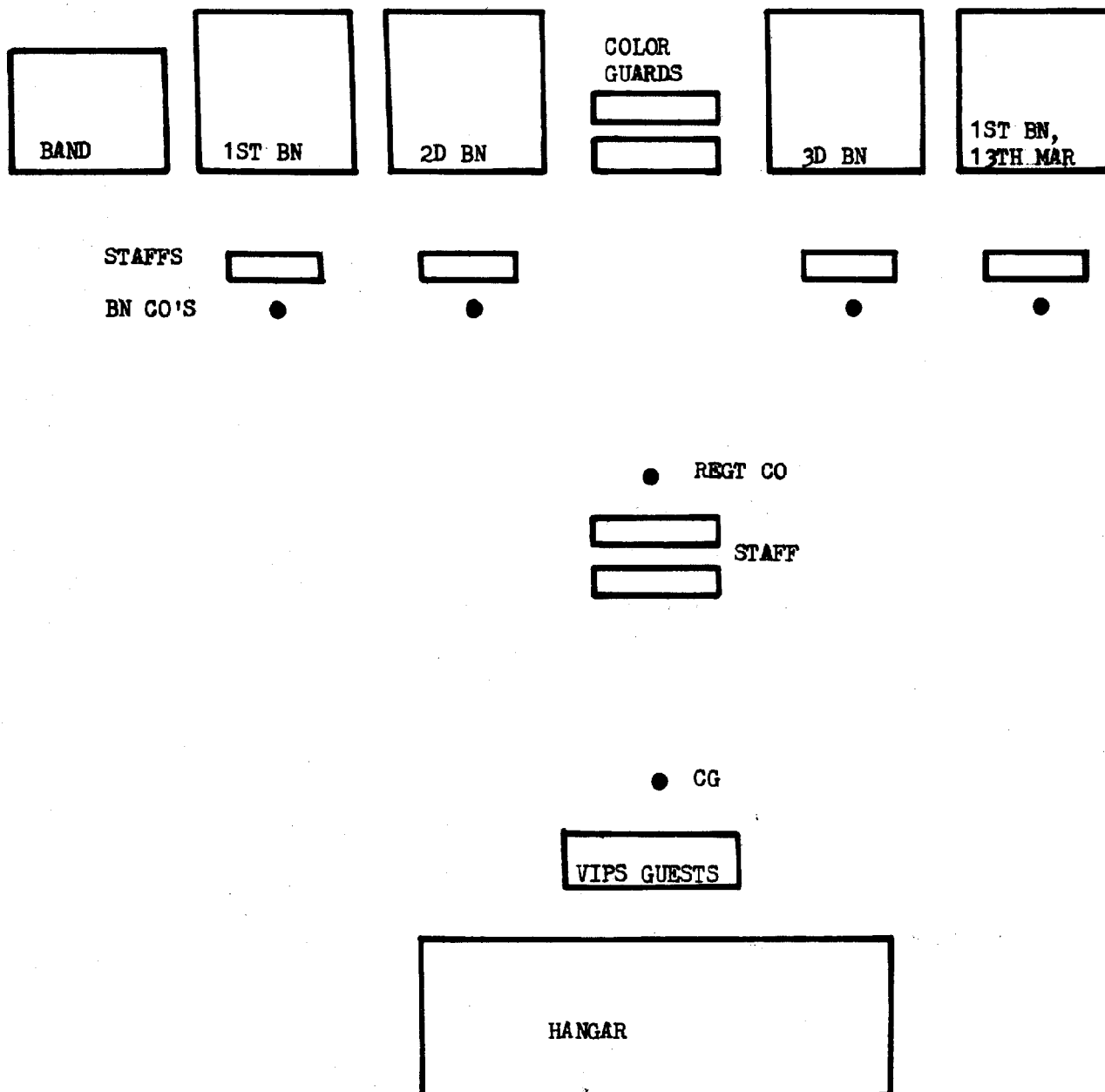

- (11) Adjutant commands "Attention to orders". Narrator then reads pertinent extracts from orders directing 26th Marines to return to U.S.
- (12) After completion of orders, adjutant returns to position in staff. Commanding General escorts high ranking guests to position to receive honors.
- (13) Regimental Commander boxes staff, commands "Present the Colors". Color guards move forward.
- (14) Regimental Commander, commands "Present Arms". Executes about face, salutes the CG.
- (15) As the Regimental Commander executes hand salute, the band plays honors for distinguished guests.
- (16) On completion of musical honors, the regimental commander terminates his salute, faces about. The Commanding General escorts guests receiving honors to seats.
- (17) Regimental Commander commands "Persons to be decorated center, March". At the command march, all persons receiving decorations will move to position center of command, five paces in front of color guards and five paces behind the commander of troops.
- (18) After all colors and persons to be decorated are in place, the regimental commander salutes the Commanding General and reports, "Sir, the persons to be decorated are present". The Commanding General returns the salute and orders, "Present the command, Sir".
- (19) The Regimental Commander moves to position behind the organizational colors by the most direct route around the right flank of the persons to be decorated.
- (20) On reaching his position, he commands "Present Arms", faces about and salutes. The band plays Vietnamese and U.S. National Anthems.

- (21) On completion of the music, the regimental commander brings the command to order arms. The persons to be decorated begin and end their salutes on the order of the commander.
- (22) LtGen LAM moves to the person to be decorated with the highest award. He attaches the decoration to the uniform over the left breast and shakes the hand of each person. Immediately after shaking hands, the person decorated salutes the reviewing officer. He returns it before proceeding to the next person to be decorated. The narrator reads the appropriate portions of citations during the presentations.
- (23) After presentations, LtGen LAM returns to his seat. The regimental commander, faces about, commands, "Parade Rest", returns to position in front of persons decorated.
- (24) After LtGen LAM returns to position, remarks by the Commanding General, 1st Marine Division, and designated guests are given.
- (25) After remarks, the Division Chaplain conducts prayer.
- (26) After the prayer, the Commanding General commands, "Retire the Colors". Upon General's command, the regimental commander salutes, faces about and commands "Regiment Attention". After attention he commands "Colors and Persons decorated, Post". The persons decorated return to their posts by the most direct route, and colors return to original position.
- (27) After colors and persons decorated are in position, the Commanding General commands "March the regiment in review and embark them for the United States, Sir". The regimental commander faces about, and commands, "Pass in Review". On that command the band changes direction to that of the line of march and halts.
- (28) When the band has halted, the 1st Battalion Commander commands "Column of companies from the right, column right, ~~forward~~, March". The band also moves out upon his command of execution.
- (29) Each battalion commander gives the command to put his troops in motion along the line of march. Commanders move into position at the heads of their units after the first change of direction in the line of march. The regimental commander moves into position at the head of the column after the second change of direction.
- (30) The regimental commander and each battalion commander, with their staffs, salute and execute eyes right when **six paces from** the nearest member of the reviewing party. They hold their

salutes and eyes right positions until 6 paces beyond the reviewing party. Each company commander will also command "eyes right" when six paces from the nearest member of the reviewing party.

- (31) The band will execute column left when it has passed the reviewing stand. It then executes a second and third column left so it will end up in front of and facing the Commanding General. It continues to play until the last company has passed. It then follows the last unit from the parade.
- (32) After saluting the reviewing officer while marching in review, the regimental commander, followed by his staff, turns out of the column and takes position on line with and to the right of the reviewing officer. When the rear element of his command has passed, the regimental commander faces the Commanding General and renders a hand salute. When the salute has been returned, he and the staff follow their command from the ceremony area.
