

PART II: NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the reporting period, the Battalion was responsible for the Eastern sector of the 9th Marines TAOR. This responsibility included the occupation and defense of the assigned sector from enemy attack, execution of offensive operations in the assigned sector, maintaining the Main Supply Route open to traffic, establishment and maintenance of a reconnaissance network in the assigned sector, and the support of pacification programs as directed. Company D remained OpCon to other units the entire month, and Company A chopped platoons OpCon to other units on two occasions as indicated in paragraph 5 (Special Operations). Except for that stated above, enemy activity consisted mainly of sniper action and booby trapping, and friendly activity consisted of daylight combat and reconnaissance patrols and night ambushes. CAP C-1 was visited by Lt. Gen. KRULAK on 9 March 1967, and by Maj. Gen. NICKERSON and Lt. Gen. PALMER, USA, on 20 March 1967. 1st Battalion 26th Marines was visited by Maj. Gen. NICKERSON and Sen. BYRD of Virginia on 26 March 1967.

During the month of March 1966 Military and Civilian vehicles traveled the supply route, with security being furnished from this Battalion. The majority of these vehicles were in route to AN HOA industrial complex.

1. Personnel

a. Losses are as follows:

2. Administrative. Personnel/Administrative inspection conducted 22 - 27 March 1967. Corrective action was taken on the discrepancies noted.

3. Intelligence.

a. Enemy Activity. The enemy activity for the month of March was at a very low level. There were no significant infantry contacts during the month, 1 act of terrorism, 37 small arms incidents, and 32 mine/booby trap incidents. Interviews with civilians and interrogations revealed that the VC were conducting population control and propaganda operations while avoiding contact.

b. Surveillance. Additional 50 foot and 30 foot towers were constructed at five points along the LOC. These towers afford 100% surveillance of the road net and 75% of the southern TAOR.

c. Weather. March weather was typical of the dry season. Crachin conditions persisted during the early portion of the month, deteriorating to thin, early morning haze by mid-month. The spring rice harvest began in late March rather than April because of the hot, dry conditions. Cross country movement for infantry and tracked vehicles was unimpaired. All lines of communication were open to wheeled vehicles. A synopsis of the weather for March follows.

4. TRAINING. On the job training was conducted for all MOS's and the five day indoctrination period for newly arrived personnel was legthened to seven days. In addition, advance training conducted for newly arrived officers and NCO's in supporting arms and demolitions was continued. The newly instigated training program met with encouraging results.

5. SPECIAL OPERATIONS

Co A at 061600H chop one plt (Rein), SPARROW HAWK OpCon to 2nd Battalion 4th Marines.

Co A at 071800H chop one plt (Rein), OpCon to 1st Battalion, 26th Marines.

Co D at 080918H chop OpCon 9th Marines.

Co D at 081000H chop OpCon 2nd Battalion, 26th Marines.

Co A 150605H chop one Plt (Rein) OpCon to 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines for block.

Co A at 171545H chop one plt(Rein) OpCon to 1st Battalion, 26th Marines

Co A(-) from 200630H to 211345H provide block for 51st ARVN Regt. from AT953632 to AT983630.

Co A had one plt(Rein) as block for 51st ARVN Regt. from 290515 to 291545.

This command distributed 32,140 general and special purpose psywar leaflets during March. They were disseminated by patrols in populated areas and along suspected routes of VC movement. One incident involving a child killed by a VC booby trap was exploited through interpreters, Kit Carson Scouts and general loudspeaker broadcasts. Ground loudspeakers from the 244th PsyOps Co, USA were used on several occasions within the TAOR. This command also received extensive support from the 5th ACS, USAF which made aerial leaflet drops and loudspeaker broadcasts on general themes.

The Kit Carson Scouts assigned to this command have been employed daily in support of Battalion operations. They are assigned to rifle companies in the field on a permanent basis and are used as trail guides, in gathering intelligence from civilians, and in psychological operations. They have held classes for Marines in conjunction with interpreters on VC tactics, trail signs and booby trap techniques. Limited progress has been made in mutual language classes in basic phrases for the Marines and Scouts.

6. Nuclear, Biological and Chemical Warfare. Nothing significant.
7. Command and Control. The Battalion was commanded by LtCol D. E. NEWTON throughout the reporting period. Company D was OpCon to Task Force XRAY from 010001H March to 080918H March, at which time Co D chopped from Task Force XRAY to 2nd Battalion, 26th Marines and have remained there throughout the reporting period. 1st Battalion, 26th Marines remain AdCon 3rd Marine Division and OpCon 1st Marine Division.
8. Communications and Electronics. Nothing significant.
9. Close Combat. Nothing significant.
10. Fire Support and Fire Support Coordination. During March, artillery fired on targets of opportunity, fired zone fires on suspected enemy positions, harassment and interdiction fires, and registration missions. Both offensive and defensive on call fires were utilized during the reporting period.

Artillery fired 75 missions against a known enemy during March. Casualties resulting from artillery were reported to be 13 KIA (Conf), and 75 KIA (Prob). Confirmed figures might have been higher, but conditions in many cases precluded an immediate search of the target area. Surveillance by FO's indicated that artillery was both effective and accurate. There were 12 missions of a registration type carried out.

Two 81mm Mortar sections were attached to outlying rifle companies while the other two sections were kept on Hill 55, one on Hill 55 proper and the other on Hill 55, Finger 1, in a general support role. Mortar H&I's, observed and unobserved fire missions were fired during March.

11. Logistics. During this reporting period the companies were supplied 178,000 pounds of supplies. In addition to these supplies two hot meals and cartoned milk were supplied to each company each day. Battalion vehicles traveled 25,500 miles in support of the Battalion. Supporting M54 Trucks from 9th MT Bn, traveled 1,874 miles in resupplying the companies.

The most significant development during the reporting period was the introduction of the XM16E1 Rifle. Cantonment developments include three 50 feet Sniper/Observation Towers, one 35 Feet Sniper/Observation Tower, three bunkers, and one tent deck.

The use of M52 Tractor/Trailers substantially increased the transportation support of the Battalion.

The most critical problem area continues to be the lack of Motor Transport parts and the lack of 8X8 timbers for bunkers.

12. Air Defense. Nothing Significant.

13. Combat Air Support. The air liason section conducted classes for small unit leaders on helicopter control and coordination. Emphasis was placed upon planning and conduct of helicopter resupply and medical evacuations in the field under combat conditions. This is a continuous program conducted by the Battalion FAC in the field on a personnel available basis. The

command successfully coordinated and controlled 39 Med Evac flights and one preplanned air strike during the month.

14. Medical and Dental. During the month of March, 2 corpsmen were transferred, 3 corpsmen received on board for duty. There were 29 enlisted promotions during the month. During the month 3 corpsmen were WIA with 2 being treated and returned to full duty, and 1 being evacuated out of country. At present medical personnel census stands at 2 officers and 52 enlisted personnel. The last of March HQ 9th Marine's BAS was combined with 1/26 BAS on a local level giving us 3 additional enlisted personnel and full use of 9th Marines ambulance, and in turn giving the Battalion full medical responsibility for an additional 200-250 Marines. Military and medical in-service training has improved compared to past months, with classes being conducted on an average of 5 classes per week.

During the month 976 Marines were treated at routine sick call. 48 Marine WIA's, 30 of whom were released for duty; no Marine KIA's were handled through the Battalion Aid Station. Average in-patient census for the month was 8.

63 Vietnamese civilians were treated at the Battalion Aid Station and another 1213 were treated through field MEDCAP facilities. The BICH BAC MEDCAP moved to Finger #1, Hill 55 Complex.

The Dental Facility treated 181 Marines from this command.

15. Chaplain and Moral Welfare. Protestant coverage given by Battalion Chaplain. Protestant services held in Battalion CP Sunday mornings, Sunday evenings, and Wednesday evenings; in other line companies on weekdays. No services held for D Co by Battalion Chaplain this month while they operated in CHUI LAI. Battalion Chaplain normally remained with B Co, D Co and C Co one night weekly. Total protestant services held were 32, attended by 872 Marines. Six Bible Classes held in Battalion CP, attended by 53 Marines. Battalion Chaplain gave lecture on Religious Customs in Viet Nam to 87 replacements troops, counseled with 57 Marines, visited with patients in BAS daily, made visits to 45 patients in 1st Med Bn and NSA Hospital, visited one Marine in the III MAF Brig, wrote four pastoral letters to NOK of deceased Marines, handled 7 cases with AmCross, and distributed over 3,000 New Testaments and religious booklets. Battalion Chaplain has continued liaison with American Protestant missionaries in DANANG. Battalion Chaplain planned and conducted a four day Easter Bible Conference for Protestant personnel, using China Beach R&R facilities, attended by 69 Marines (41 from 1/26 and 28 from other units).

Roman Catholic coverage was provided by Regimental Chaplain, 9th Marines, with Mass in Battalion CP Sunday mornings and in forward line companies on weekdays when possible.

Battalion Chaplain provided Protestant coverage to 2/12 CP and B/1/11, conducting five services for 74 men.

16. Civic Action. During the month of March the Civil Affairs Office initiated an English Class, an Agricultural Assistance Program and a local Public Health Worker Program.

A resettlement village for people from the refugee center in DAI LOC was begun. Some 75 people within the C.A.A.O.R. have agreed to participate in the G.V.N. fertilizer sale which will take place in the month of April. A public shower facility was completed in the hamlet of BICH BAC as part of the health program for this area.

The over all attitude of the local population toward these programs and projects has greatly improved and with this improvement has come a corresponding increase in their desire to participate. This further change in the attitude of the people has been demonstrated by a decrease in the number of fraudulent claims for supposed damage to property.
