

NARPATIVE SUMMARY

During September the Battalion's mission remained unchanged. The Battalion continued to defend key terrain, conduct extensive patrolling and night ambushes, and defend assigned sectors of the KHE SANH Combat Base.

Operation ARDMORE continued throughout the month of September. Search and destroy operations, combat patrols, ambushes, and road security operations were conducted in conjunction with Operation ARDMORE.

During the reporting period enemy activity in the KHE SANH operating area continued to be light.

The Battalion conducted two commany size search and destroy operations. The company defensive positions and the Combat Patrol Bases on Hills 881S and 861 continued to be improved.

Company D relieved Company A on Hill 881S on 9 September.

Company C relieved Company B on Hill 861 on 15 September.

Company B relieved Company C and occupied the Battalion's assigned defensive sectors of the KHE SANH Combat Base on 15 September.

On 10 September BGen METZGER visited Company D on Hill 881S.


On 12 September the Division Management Team reviewed the Battalion's warehouse area and Inventory Control Data computation.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. <u>Combat missions assigned</u>. During the period 1 September to 30 September the Battalion's mission was to occupy key terrain features to prevent enemy movement into vital areas; to conduct extensive patrolling to detect and destroy enemy forces and interdict enemy routes of approach to the KHE SANH area; to maintain one Company as Regimental Reserve; to provide forces for local security operations in support of KHE SANH Combat Base; and to provide screening operations in support of reconnaissance insertions.

2. Significant operations conducted.

- a. Participated in Operation ARDMORE during the entire month. Operation ARDMORE continues.
- b. Company D (Rein) concluded the search and destroy operation which commenced on 31 August in an area bounded by XD 770400, XD 770430, XD 800390, XD 800400, 820390 and XD 820405 on 5 September.
- c. 1st Flt (Rein), Company A conducted a two day road clearing operation commencing 10 September along Route 9 from XD 863397 to the bridge site at XD 910403.
- d. Company A (Rein) conducted a seven day search and destroy operation commencing 13 September in an area bounded by XD 760437, XD 823395, XD 823390, and XD 760390. On 19 September, Company D relieved Company A and continued the search and clear operation for an additional two days.
- e. Company A (Rein) conducted a six day search and destroy operation commencing 23 September in an area bounded by XD 760437, XD 823395, XD 823390 and XD 760390.
- 3. Casualties inflicted upon the enemy.
 - a. Personnel: None.
 - b. Weapons Captured: None.
- 4. Casualties sustained. None.
- 5. New techniques employed. None.
- 6. <u>Command relations</u>. The Battalien operated under the operational control of the 26th Marines and the administrative control of the 3rd Marine Division (Rein).





7. Equipment.

- a. <u>Metascopes</u>. The Battalion received thirty-nine Metascopes during late September. Distribution has been delayed awaiting receipt of batteries.
- b. Silicone. The Battalion issued silicone to each man in Company A prior to the start of a company operation for the prevention/retardation of immersion foot. Results to date are not conclusive.

8. Logistics.

- a. During this reporting period the deployed companies were supplied with 56 tons of supplies by CH-34 and CH-53 Aircraft.
- b. Organic vehicles traveled 3,292 miles in support of the Battalion.
- c. The Battalion received rainsuits and waterproof fighting hole covers in partial fulfillment of the Battalion's monsoon requirements.
- d. Developments in the KHE SANH cantonment included the construction of one communications bunker and additional living bunkers. A field laundry unit was installed under Regimental control.

9. Civic Action.

- a. During the month of September visits were made to the Day School at KHE SANH. Food and games were distributed to the children. Liaison was made with the village and district chiefs.
- b. Money was donated by members of the Battalion which was used to buy mooncakes as gifts for the children of KHE SANH during the Autumn Festival on 18 September.
- c. There were seven MEDCAPS conducted at surrounding villages and hamlets during the month. A total of six hundred and twenty three people were treated by the Battalion medical personnel. There were three civilian out-patients treated and one civilian admitted at the Battalion Aid Station.
- d. Personnel joining the Command from CONUS were given civic action lectures as part of the Battalion In-Country Indoctrination Program. Classes included "Why we are here", "Learning about VIETNAM", and the "VIETNAMESE And the Revolutionary Development Program".
- 10. Administration. Company Rears were maintained at the Battalion CP to provide administrative support for the deployed companies.





11. Personnel.

a. Losses:

- (1) One Marine Officer transferred for duty and one by Serv-ice Records.
- (2) Nine Marine Enlisted transferred for duty. Fifteen were transferred by Service Records as a result of MedEvac.
 - (3) There were no USN Officers transferred for duty.
- (4) Two USN Enlisted transferred for duty. One was transferred by Service Records as a result of MedEvac.

b. Joinings:


- (1) Six Marine Officers joined for duty.
- (2) Twenty seven Marines and two Navy Enlisted joined for duty.

c. Casualties:

- (1) There were no KIA's during the month.
- (2) One Enlisted Marine died from injuries sustained when a partially completed bunker collapsed during heavy rains at KHE SANH Combat Base on 17 September.
 - (3) There were no DOW's during the month.
 - (4) There were no WIA's during the month.
- d. During the month of September eighty-six men from the Battalion went on R&R and five men were granted emergency leave.
- e. During the month four WEIREPS were obtained from the Red Cross on Marine wives and one WEIREP on the health of a Marine Officer's mother, the latter resulting in emergency leave.

12. <u>Intelligence</u>.

- a. Enemy Activity. Enemy activity for the month of September was light. The following significant incidents occurred:
- (1) At 100715 1st Plt. Co A at XD 853403 found a pressure type explosive device in southwest lane of road. Device was blown in place resulting in a secondary explosion.








- (2) At 131015H. Co B patrol at XD 810458 spotted 5 NVA in the open. Artillery mission was called. Two gunships supporting the patrol searched area out with negative results.
- (3) At 141730H. Co A patrol at XD 765416 found an enemy defensive position consisting of twenty two fighting holes and one command bunker, $3! \times 3!$, made of logs and dirt. Positions appeared to be oriented toward stream bed (XD 765416).
- (4) On 151300H, Co A patrol found five two man fighting holes, 3' x 5' x 2' at XD 775403. Entire area appeared to be a squad size harbor site. Patrol found five "L" shaped bunkers, 5' x 5' x 3', approximately 125 meters from harbor site. Bunkers had a three foot layer of logs on top with two feet of dirt on top of logs. Also found two BA 30 type batteries of foriegn manufacture and a plug from larger size battery.
- (5) At 231400H Co D (-) at XD 760444 found one NVA body covered with 2-3 inches of dirt. The body was clothed with remnants of a black uniform, back and sneakers. It appeared to be two months old.
- (6) Several reports from positions on the defensive perimeter of KHE SANH Combat Base indicated enemy movement forward of the tactical wire on the nights of 26 and 27 September. Scout snipers, aided by a Starlight Scope, fired at two known targets during the night. Subsequent search of the areas were conducted with negative results.


b. Surveillance.

- (1) Amplifier and generator problems reduced the availability of the AN/TPS-21 during the month of September.
- (2) The Starlight Scope and Seismic Intrusion Devices were employed during the month.
- 14. Communications. Nothing significant.

16. Fire support and fire support coordination. During the month of September artillery units in direct/general support of the Battalion provided the normal types of fire support missions. Artillery fired forty-five observed fire missions and eight hundred thirty H&I targets in direct support of the Battalion. Two Simm Mortar Sections were attacked to the deployed rifle companies; two sections remained in the Combat Base in general support. The Simm Mortar Platoon fired one hundred eighty-four observed fire missions and seventeen hundred fourteen H&I targets during the month.

17. Air support.

- a. During this period the Battalion continued to maintain two Forward Air Control teams with the commanies on Hills 861 and 881S for the first three weeks. The Forward Air Control team on Hill 861 was recalled to KHE SANH Combat Base on 22 September. The Forward Air Control teams controlled three fixed wing support missions.
- b. Fifty-six tons of sumplies were lifted by heliconter to the commanies on Hill 861 and 881S and to other deployed units during the reporting period.
- c. Twelve MedEvac missions were coordinated and controlled by the Forward Air Control teams.
- 18. Medical. During the month of September, one thousand one hundred thirty-eight Marines were seen and treated at routine sick call. Significant illnesses included sixty-one cases of dysentery; twenty-three cases of fever of unknown origin, and six malaria cases. Three hundred ninety-six immunizations were administered during the month.
- 19. Chaplin and moral welfare. During the month of September a total of twenty-six worship services were conducted with a total attendance of four hundred eighty-five personnel. Roman Catholic Masses were celebrated for the Battalion by the 3rd Battalion, 26th Marines Chaplain. Additionally, Rosary Services were available during the absense of the Roman Catholic Chaplain. Battalion Chaplain also conducted services at the Regimental Relay Station (Hill 950); Detachment A-101, US Special Forces Camp at LANG VEI; CAC "O" Headquarters and platoon units in the KHE SANH area. Waskly visits to the Battalion Aid Station and frequent visits to the companies forward positions were conducted for both worship services and counselling sessions. One troop indoctrination lecture was given to a total of seventeen men. There were three Memorial services held in the Battalion. The Pattalion Chaplain coordinated and distributed an extensive study on the Brow, a Montagnard tribe in the KHE SANH area.






20. Personnel and morale services.

- a. Postal. Battalion mail personnel handled approximately eight bags of mail per day. This included packages, letters, newspapers and magazines for members of this command. Inclement weather precluded regular delivery of mail to KHE SANH.
- b. Special Services. Division Special Services provided, at no cost, twenty-five cases of beer and twelve cases of soda to returning from extended operations in the field.
- c. Decorations and Awards. The following decorations and awards were awarded to personnel of the Battalion during the month of September.
- (1) One Marine Staff Non-Commissioned Officer was awarded the Silver Star.
 - (2) One Marine enlisted was awarded the Bronze Star.
 - Two Marine enlisted were awarded the Purple Heart Medal.


d. Education.







Appendix 1 (Ehemy Situation Overlay) to Annex A (Intelligence) to Operation Order 12-67



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




#### 1. SUMMARY OF ENEMY SITUATION.

- a. Recent enemy activity within the AO has been limited to what appears to be a redonnaisance effort, with the sightings of up to squad size elements. There have been no recent significant contacts. However, in the past, the enemy has used Hill 689 as an observation post and a position from which to mortar and rocket KHE SANH Combat Base. There are numerous harbor sites and fortified positions throughtout the AO. (See Appendix (1)).
- b. The enemy has the capability of taking the offensive or defending with up to a battalion in the AO.
- o. There have been reports that a VC/NVA unit of 300 men, with head-quarters located in the vicinity of XD 531468, has started movement to effect liaison and carry supplies to NVA units in the northwestern portion of the 26th Marines TAOR. Rendezvous is scheduled for 15-17 September 1967, in the vicinity of LANG HOAN TAP (XD 765418). Following delivery of supplies, the supply unit will return to LAOS. It is reported that this activity occurs monthly, about the same date eachmonth. Route of movement from LAOS into SVN is from XD 531468 to XD 610330 to XD 665289 to XD 695314 to XD 715350 to XD 724365 to XD 736418. Mines and antihelicopter bamboo stakes are located at XD 690306, XD 698292, XD 702282, and XD 741315.

However, in the past, the enemy has used Hill 689 as an observation post and a position from which to morter and rocket KHE SANH Combat Base. There are numerous harbor sites and portified positions throughtout the AO. (See Appendix (3) (Enemy Sightings and Positions Overlay)).
- b. The enemy has the capability of taking the offensive or defending with up to a battalion in the AO.
- c. There have been reports that a VC/NVA unit of 300 men, with headquarters located in the vicinity of XD 531468, has searted movement to effect liaison and carry supplies to NVA units in the northwestern portion of the 26th Marines TAOR. Rendezwous was scheduled for 15-17 September 1967, in the vicinity of LANG HOAN TAP (XD 765418). Following delivery of supplies, the supply units will return to LAOS. It is reported that this activity occurs monthly, about the same date each month. Route of nevernest from LAOS into SVN is from XD 531468 to XD 610330 to XD 665233 to XD 695314 to XD 695314 to XD 715350 to XD 726418.
- d. We have been receiving continuous information that strongly indicates an enemy attack on the Special Forces camp at LANG VEI, probably sometime from the 25th to 50th of September. If this attack does occur, we should expect a diversionary attack on the KHE SANH Combat Base. There have been increasing enemy resonnaises and a cafforts to the north of KHE SANH. A reported NVA Company operating in the vicinity of ND 874367 may have the mission of mortaring HUONG HOA District Headquestors and the CAC Compound at KHE SANH, and interdicting the road between NHE SANH Combat Base and KHE SANH village. An interrogation report revealed the following information concerning the LANG VEI attack:
  - (1) VC to assemble at ND 804373 within 24 hours of attack.
  - (2) At 2400 hours many sapper tooms would begin outling defensive wires.
  - (3) Supporting fine to begin at 0000 hours.

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

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
