PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of August this battalion continued to conduct offensive and defensive operations in the Northern Task Force X-Ray area of responsibility, participating in operation HOUSTON, PHASE IV. Enemy contact was generally confined to small unit night ambushes and enemy probes of friendly positions during hours of darkness. However, there were two incidents of enemy initiated assaults by fire on the Troui River Bridge located at YD 965064 and bridges 1 and 2 located at YD 913117 and YD 920103 defended by elements of Company C and D respectively. Also, Whiskey Battery, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines, located at CAO DOL, was probed, wire breached by sappers and assaulted by approximately 10-50 NVA/VC. Several bunkers were destroyed with friendly casualties classified as moderate.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS1. COMBAT MISSIONS ASSIGNED

- a. Conduct aggressive small unit security patrols, killer ambushes, and occupy and defend road and bridge positions along National Route #1, within the Battalion AO.
- b. Conduct maximum joint operations with RF/PF units located within the Battalion's AO.
- c. Maintain one company BAO BAO FORCES for employment anywhere in the TASK FORCE X-RAY AO.
- d. Be prepared to provide relief/reaction forces for all CAF units and New Life Hamlets located in AO, to include Vin Loc District Headquarters.

2. SIGNIFICANT OPERATIONS CONDUCTED

- a. Throughout the month, maximum small unit patrols, night ambushes and killer ambush teams were employed to interdict NVA/VC movement from the Troui River Mountain Range to the low land farm areas, to gather rice and other food stuffs. Friendly units made contact with enemy forces nightly within the AO. The enemy contacts varied in size from small 3-9 man NVA/VC units, to 30-40 man patrols/food gathering details.
- b. From 1-31 August several platoon/company (-) patrols were utilized to sweep areas of previous enemy sightings and the cover Recon Team inserts to the south and west of the Battalion AO. On 14 August, after a Recon Team had been released, Company A (-) received approximately 15-20 rounds of 60mm mortar fire.
- c. 18 August Whiskey Battery, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines were attacked and overrun by an estimated 40-50 NVA/VC. One platoon from Co A was using the location as a patrol base and providing external security. A reaction force from Company A CP was dispatched to the Battery position, reestablished the defensive positions and assisted in the evacuation of the dead and wounded. The action resulted in 7 KIA and 12 MIA from the Battalion and 6 enemy KIA. Later intelligence from a Hoi Chanh indicated another 10-12 NVA/VC were killed during the attack but were carried from the battle field.
- d. During the month of August eight combined mechanized/infantry patrols of platoon and company size were conducted North and South of the Troui River. Contact was negligible. However, the platoon of tanks and entos in direct support provide excellent refresher training in Tank/Infantry employment and utilization.

5. NEW TECHNIQUES EMPLOYED. Under the direction and control of the operations officer Company B (-) and PF units participated in a operation utilizing heavy PAC-V boats. These boats offered mobility over flooded rice paddys and inlets which this battalion had not previously experienced. The use of these heavy boats should prove increasingly beneficial with the onset of the Monsoon Season.

6. COMMAND RELATIONS. The 3rd Marine Division continued to exercise administrative control throughout this period. The 26th Marines maintained operational control from 1-31 August 1968.

7. EQUIPMENT. The shortage of major items of equipment such as trucks, platform M-27/A2 and Trailer, water, M-107A did not effect the operational capabilities of the battalion during the month of July. Currently the battalion is short 400 Gas Maske and 600 first aid packs. These items are on order and thus far have not adversely influenced operations.

8. LOGISTICS.

(a) Resupply of the subordinate units in the field was scheduled from Camp Hochmuth, Phu Bai, RVN. Both truck and helicopter resupply was utilized during the period.

(b) This battalion's organic vehicles logged a total of 24,167 miles in support of the units operations.

(c) All Marines were provided one hot meal per day prepared in the Battalion Mess Hall, located at Phu Bai and delivered to the field.

(d) During the month of August the general supply situation was adequate.

Normal shortages were experienced. However, no shortage was extensive enough to seriously effect the operations of the battalion.

9. CIVIC ACTION. During this period the battalion conducted extensive civic action programs. All subordinate units were located in or in close proximity to Villages and Hamlets. School supplies were distributed, construction of a dam and repair of a damaged school building were instituted. A minimum of seven MedCaps were conducted per week, with platoon/company Corpsman providing constant medical service for the Vietnamese people in their areas. Generally, friendly relations existed between the people and the Marines. This friendly attitude resulted in excellent intelligence information being passed to the companies and battalion S-2 personnel. This intelligence information resulted in several successful ambushes and secondary explosions resulting from TOT's.

10. ADMINISTRATION. Battalion and company administrative rears continued to support the units of this battalion from Quang Tri. The physical distance between the tactical and administrative elements continues to impose certain understandable hardships on individual Marines of this unit.

12. INTELLIGENCE

a. Summary of known enemy activity

(1) During the month of August there were 27 enemy initiated actions. The largest contact was a sapper and mortar attack on a fire support base.

(2) No significant enemy bunker complexes were discovered during this reporting period. The local villages are fortified with

bunkers, irrigation ditches and fighting holes. These positions are used by the local populace in the event of enemy attacks.

(3) enemy mortar fire during this period was light. The enemy has 82mm and 60mm mortar fire capability. Only three instances of enemy mortar attacks occurred during the reporting period.

(4) The enemy units operating in this AO are as follows: K5 Bn, K4B Bn, K4A Bn, K118 Bn, K10 Bn, K32 Bn, and the K15 Bn. The above mentioned units are subordinate to the 4th and 5th NVA Regiments. The local force VC units in our area are of Company strength and usually reinforced by additional unidentified units. The main force local units are the C116, C117, and the C118 companies.

(5) Terrain Analysis. The bulk of our AO consist of rice paddies and gently rolling hills. Far to the south the terrain becomes more rugged and the double tier canopy begins. The main terrain feature is the Troui Mountain Range which is a confirmed haven for enemy base camps. The rivers in our AO are easily navigable and provide outstanding avenues of approach for the enemy. The AO is abundant with prominent hills which our battalion uses as outposts to detect enemy movement and mortar fire.

13. INFORMATIONAL SERVICES. A total of 204 individual Fleet hometown news releases were forwarded during the month.

14. COMMUNICATIONS

a. Radio Communications

(1) A high standard of radio communications continued to prevail through out the past month. Operator training, brevity of transmission and communication security have been heavily stressed during this period.

(2) No enemy jamming or imitative deception was confirmed during this period. Some frequency changes were necessitated due to friendly interference and these were made smoothly.

(3) Ground to air communications were used in the tactical control of aircraft with no apparent problems.

(4) During this period 17 AN/PRC-25 radios were received from the supply channel. The arrival of these radio alleviated a shortage of AN/PRC-25 radios, and thus strengthened the communication capabilities of this unit, two RC-292 antennas were also received and utilized.

b. Wire Communications

(1) Wire communications were used extensively at Hill 18 with the GP group and along Route #1 with the Line Companies. A total of 5 SE-22 switchboards and 82 telephones (a combination of TA-312's and TA-1's) were utilized. One SE-22 switchboard was received during this period.

(2) Wiremen at the GP position received training with the multiple switchboard.

c. Message Center Communications

(1) A teletype circuit is operating between this unit and the 26th Marines (at Phu Bai) using AN/TGC-14A (V) equipment. The primary purpose of this circuit is to pass tactical/operational messages. Moreover, this unit picks up messages from 3rd MarDiv at Quang Tri. The messages are delivered to Phu Bai by courier.

d. Supply

(1) The supply of combat essential communications equipment and repair parts has greatly improved during this period.

(2) Accessories and modules for the radio set AN/PRC-25 are no

longer in critical shortage.

(3) Critical communication equipment presently on requisition: four (4) AN/PRC-258s; fifty-eight (58) TA-1's; one (1) TA-221; and one (1) SB-22.

e. Maintenance

(1) Technical support from the Battalion Tech Shop consisted of repairing radio sets AN/PRC-25, telephone sets TA-312 and TA-1.

(2) During this period a training program of 2nd echelon preventive maintenance was stressed.

(3) Radar Technicians gave classes to contain members of each line company on the FPS-6 radar set.

f. Additional

(1) Communication personnel received detailed instruction on how to perform preventive maintenance on communication equipment.

15. WEATHER. The month of August was very hot and dry with temperatures consistently in the 100 degree range. Rain was very infrequent with scattered showers. At no time during the month did weather seriously restrict the operational capability of the battalion.

16. FIRE SUPPORT AND FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION

During the month of August the artillery units in direct and general support provided excellent target coverage. The control of organic, direct and general support weapons was difficult. Throughout the battalion AO, villages and hamlets were located extremely close to all subordinate unit CP's. The rules of engagement applied and were strictly enforced. All unit commanders and the FSCC Officer displayed commendable restraint when using supporting arms fire to suppress, restrict or repel probes of their position.

17. AIR SUPPORT

During August the battalion utilized fixed wing aircraft, Helicopter, Gunships and Spooky in support of the operating units. Restraint was used in all cases when operating in support of contact in close proximity to populated areas.

18. MEDICAL

In August, 532 Marines were treated at Sick Call. Of these 6 Marines were wounded by hostile action with 3 requiring medical Evacuation. There were 29 non-battle injuries. Immunizations were administered to 345 Marines.

19. PERSONNEL SERVICES

a. Postal. Mail for members of this command was received daily during the month of August. A total of 221 bags of mail was received and distributed.
