

## PART II

## NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of September this Battalion conducted offensive and defensive operations from 1-2 Sept in Northern Task Force X-Ray area of responsibility and from 3-30 Sept in the Northwestern Danang TAOR. Enemy contact was generally confined to small night killer ambush teams and patrols. However there was one incident of 27 Sept involving an enemy NVA platoon and a friendly ambush from Bravo Company located at AT 923843; the enemy took heavy casualties and friendly casualties were extremely light with no friendly KIA.

## PART III

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS1. COMBAT MISSION ASSIGNED

a. Conduct aggressive small unit security patrols, killer ambushes, and saturation patrolling of the rocket belt; Guard the Elephant Valley approach into the Danang Vital Area; and provide security for the NAMO Bridge and Esso Plant. Emphasis is placed on small unit activities such as patrols, observation posts, listening posts, and killer ambush teams. Also surveillance astride the Song Cu De River and vicinity of its mouth.

b. Maintain one Bald Eagle Company for employment anywhere in the Regimental TAOR.

c. Be prepared to provide relief/reaction forces for all friendly units positions in AO.

2. SIGNIFICANT OPERATIONS CONDUCTED

a. Throughout the month, maximum small unit patrols, night ambushes and killer ambush teams were employed to interdict NVA/VC infiltration in the Danang AO.

b. Friendly units made contact with enemy forces almost nightly within the AO. The enemy contact varied in size from 3-10 men NVA/VC units to 30-40 man patrols, food gathering details.

c. From 3-30 Sept several squad sized patrols were utilized to sweep areas of previous enemy sighting and to intradict enemy supply lines.

d. Prime rocket belt area is covered by a company which operates in the field continually.

e. Elephant Valley area is covered by a platoon sized patrol which stays in the field for a period of one week, operating from Company Combat Base located at mouth of Elephant Valley.

f. Operation Denial - objective is forming of killer ambush teams to deny the enemy entrance to and egress from rice harvest areas.

g. Maximum coordination, and joint operations with CAP units, PF and RF units have resulted in highly successful denial of rice to the enemy.

h. Also close coordination with US Army units and Force Logistic Command adjacent to our AO has resulted in mutual defensive benefits.

i. On 27 Sept, at 2030, a killer ambush team, KAT1-1, from Bravo Company made contact with an unknown size enemy unit, killer ambush team, KAT 1-4, was dispatched as a reactionary force and KAT 1-3 moved into blocking positions. The Battalion reaction force, one platoon from Company C, was committed and joined with Company B forces to cordon off the area until first light when the area was searched

This action resulted in 13 enemy KIA and an unknown number of wounded. Friendly casualties were 3 WIA; also retrieved from the battle field were 6 AK-47's, 1 US pistol cal. 45 Model 1911, 15 Chicoms, and numerous cartridge belts and packs and documents, indicating enemy was from the NVA 31st Regiment.

j. During the month of September, combined LVT operations of squad and platoon sized patrols were conducted on the Song Cu De River. Contact was negligible.

5. NEW TECHNIQUES EMPLOYED

Companies A and C used OTTERS for mobility over flooded rice paddies and inlets. The use of OTTERS should prove increasingly beneficial with the onset of the Monsoon Season.

6. COMMAND RELATIONS

The 3rd Marine Division exercised administrative control 1-12 Sept. On 12 Sept the 1st Marine Division assumed administration control, from 1-3 Sept 1st Battalion, 26th Marines was OPCON to 26th Marines, 3-12 Sept OPCON to 7th Marines, 12-30 Sept OPCON to 26th Marine Regiment.

7. EQUIPMENT

The shortage of major items of equipment such as truck platform M274A2 did not effect the operational capabilities of the battalion during the month of September.

8. LOGISTICS

a. Resupply of the subordinate units in the field was scheduled from Camp Hochmuth, Phu Bai RVN 1-2 Sept and from 3-30 Sept from helicopter landing zone 460 Danang RVN. Both truck and helicopter resupply was utilize during this period.

b. This battalions' organic vehicles logged a total of 32,527 miles in support of the Battalion.

c. All Marines at Bn CP, Companies A and B positions were provided three hot meals a day. Companies C and D rotate every ten days one company being in Bn CP area at all times, the other company receives C rations for a 10 day period while operating in the outer AO.

d. During the month of Sept the general supply situation was adequate. Although some shortages were experienced, none was extensive enough to seriously effect the operations of the battalion.

9. CIVIC ACTION

During this period the battalion conducted extensive civic action program. There were 13 MED CAPS held during this period. Four hundred and fifty-five people were treated. The biggest problem encountered was an absence of antibiotics available for this endeavor. Projects in which the battalion was involved during this period were the Nam My Pig project, a continuing project. Nam My Refugee Hamlet; supplies were approved by GVN in May for 150 hours. It is now 75% completed, and Hoa Lac Village Hall; construction began 21 September. Our main source of help for civic action was the Naval Support Activity, Danang.

PsyOps Activities

A total of 12,885 leaflets were distributed throughout the Battalion TAOR. Themes of leaflets were coalition, weapons reward, rice harvest, Chieu Hoi, and Marines are friends. An armed propaganda team was used. Their main purpose was to follow the construction of the Danang barrier through the Battalion TAOR. There was a total of 6 hrs. broadcasting. Themes were Danang barrier, rice harvest, weapons rewards, and Chieu Hoi. Two Chieu Hoi's were picked up during the reporting period. There have been no noted indications of a change in attitude of the civilian population.

Battalion and company administrative rears were moved from Quang Tri RVN 18 Sept. This move has improved the administrative capabilities of this Battalion and relieved certain hardships on individual Marines of this unit.

12. INTELLIGENCE

The Bravo Company TAOR proved to be a lucrative area for killer ambush teams in the month of September. Combined Action Platoon 275 and Bravo Company combined to account for 25 NVA kills in ambushes keyed in the Kim Lien AP Thoy TU ville area between the hours of 1930 and 2300. These contacts began to appear midway through the month, along with 5 different incidents of booby trapping in this TAOR. The Esso Plant was hit by a small sapper group which escaped their pursuers on 21 September. A platoon size outpost, C-2, was attacked from the NE by a platoon of NVA using 60mm mortars and the area was probed by S/A. In the last 10 days of the month Company A has had numerous sighting of small unit NVA movement, usually taking them under fire with artillery and mortar fire. On 30 Sept. an engineer truck hit a 30 pound mine on the road south of Phuoc Son.

Enemy Estimate

From the 13 bodies confirmed by Company B killer ambush team 1-2 on 271010H it was determined that elements of the 31st NVA Regiment have moved into the Quan Hoa Wong district from the Quan Hieu Duc district. The enemy has generally been armed with AK-47's, possessing either green utilities or indigenous clothing and traveling at night from the hills west of the 90 grid line to the local villes for resupply. The enemy is well organized traveling in small well dispersed units as evidenced in the contact with Company B killer ambush team 1-2, in which whistle and arm signals were used by the enemy. If confirmed body kills are not taken away immediately upon contact, the bodies are taken away by the rest of the enemy element members. The Esso Plant incident shows the enemy capabilities to move undetected into a reasonably secure area to hit fixed positions and base camps. Numerous booby traps demonstrate that we are hurting the enemy in his attempts to secure food from the local villes and more of the same can be expected. Infiltration to hit DaNang via the valley paralleling the Song Cu De river area and sapper attacks on stationery targets are expected in a concentrated effort to obtain a major pshchological victory.

Terrain

Surveillance of the TAOR is conducted from four major points; Hill 190, Hill 60, Esso Plant and Hill 180 which over looks most of the valley in our TAOR. The foothills and mountains are covered by recon inserts and patrols. The valley floor is made up of small islands around the Cu De River with numerous villages and rice paddies reaching far into the foothills. The area is almost always wet and vehicular traffic is restricted to the roads. The foothills are rough and rolling with small shrubs and tall grass, it is passable but slow with foot troops and very little area can be traveled by vehicle. The mountains are steep and rough with tall thick canopies and movement is usually restricted to column formations.

Weather

The weather is hot and ~~st~~ with some heavy rainfall occurring during this past month which resulted in flooding of the rice paddie areas and local rivers. Typhoon Bess curtailed operations for threedays; but the weather did not effect operations otherwise.

13. Informational Services

No hometown individual news releases were forwarded for the month of September.

14. Communicationsa. Radio Communications

1. A high standard of radio communication prevailed throughout the past month
2. With the influx of ten (10) new radio men it has been necessary to stress very heavily, operator training.
3. During this period four (4) radio sets An/PRC-25 were destroyed, due to combat losses.

b. Wire Communication

1. Command post wiring has been very extensive and very successful.
2. At present there are over 120 telephones installed within the Battalion.
3. Supply of telephone sets TA-1 was increased by 40 due to a special allowance authorized for this AO.

c. Supply

1. Supply of combat essential communication equipment continues to improve. At present there are no parts in critical short supply.
2. Critical communication equipment presently on requisition: 3-PSR-1's.

d. Maintenance

1. Technical support from the Battalion Tech Shop consisted of repairing radio sets AN/PRC-47 and AN/PRC-25, Telephone sets TA-312 and TA-1, radar sets AN/PPS-6, and Teletype equipment AN/TGC-14A, and AN/TGC-14.
2. For the first time since departing Khe Sanh during April 68 the Battalion Tech Shop is in full operation.

15. FIRE SUPPORT AND FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION

September was a period of transition for the FSOC, both in its move into the Danang area, and because of the change in Artillery Liaison Officers. Due to the heavy volume of air traffic, close coordination with the Air Liaison Officer was necessary. The control of both direct and general support artillery was much improved since now all of these weapons are easily contacted at the Northern Artillery Contonement. The bulk of the artillery fired during September was for rocket suppression and harassing and interdiction purposes. Illumination was most frequently employed in the Battalion Area of Operation. Also, because of the many pacified areas in the AO, unit leaders used necessary discretion toward the employment of artillery.

16. AIR SUPPORT

During September, the battalion utilized fixed-wing aircraft, flare-ships, helicopter gunships, "Spooky" aircraft, helicopter resupply and medivacs, and airborne observers in support of operating units. Extreme caution was used when employing air support near populated areas.

17. MEDICAL

During the month of September 606 Marines were treated at sick-call. Of these 12 were wounded by hostile action and 5 required medevacuation. There were 40 Non-battle injuries, 1 of which required medical evacuation. Total immunciations administered: 540.

SUMMARY OF PERIODS ACTION: Company B while moving in a column at grid YD 958067 sighted 14 NVA/VC. Company B2-3 opened up on the VC with M-79's, and M-16, and also M-26 grenades were used. B2-3 saw 2 VC fall under their fire power. Therefore B2-3 is credited with 2 En/KIA's. Company D at their ambush site saw movement and received rounds from 3 AK-47's. This resulted in 1 Fr/WIA. WIA was serious and also he was med-evaced. D3 called in 81mm Mortar mission on enemy and were able to force the enemy back. They brought back 4 enemy detainees that were captured and interrogated them. Also in this action we had a total of 4 Fr/WIA's.
