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ENCLOSURE (1)

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During the month of October 1968, 247 Marines were seen and treated at Sick Call. Of these, 4 were wounded in action and 1 required further medical attention. In addition, 95 non-hostile injuries were seen and three required further evacuation. One KIA was brought to the B48 and taken to 1st Medical Battalion. There were 1216 immunizations administered to personnel in the Battalion. There were 26 complete physical examinations given and 75 complete Health Records were constructed on members of the battalion needing Replacement Records.

PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of October this battalion conducted both offensive and defensive operations in the northwestern DaNang TAOZ. Approximately two thirds of all patrols and ambushes were conducted at night. Enemy contact was generally limited to small units being engaged by night killer-ambush teams and patrols. Two search and clear missions were held: (one at Kim Lien Hamlet and the other at Quan Nam Hamlet. In addition to this battalion, CJT teams and RVN National Police took part in both operations. Although both these hamlets are known to be egress points for NVN/VC rice and food gathering details, the results of both sweeps were negative. During the later part of October, Co. 1, 3rd Battalion, 26th Marines was OPCK for a period of three days and was utilized to recon in force the Elephant Valley approach to DaNang and to covertly insert two reconnaissance teams.

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PART III

DETAILED LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. COMBAT MISSION ASSIGNED

a. Emphasis will be placed on small unit activities such as patrols, observation posts, listening posts, dog teams, and killer ambushes. These activities are to be implemented throughout the AO to deny the enemy freedom of movement and to interdict enemy infiltration routes.

b. Deploy forces within assigned AO with particular attention to the Rocket Belt and with one company assigned specific responsibility for Elephant Valley avenue of approach.

c. Conduct high intensity patrols and surveillance activities within the Rocket Belt while providing complete coverage of approach routes, probable rocket/mortar launch sites within AO.

d. Provide security for NamO Bridge (AT 923841) and the Esso Plant (AT 935365).

e. Be prepared to provide and employ a reaction force for immediate employment in AO to destroy enemy rocket forces and to block possible enemy escape routes using best available means for movement.

f. Establish surveillance means astride the Song Cu De. Coordinate with ground authorities and commander, NSOC in establishing surveillance in Vicinity Mouth of Song Cu De.

2. SIGNIFICANT OPERATIONS CONDUCTED

a. 2 Oct 1968

Co. A conducted a Company (-) sweep in the mid-eastern sector of the 1st Battalion, 26th Marines AO, North of Danang. Utilizing one platoon as a blocking force and one platoon search and clearing from East to West. Interrogated indigenous personnel for information with negative results. No contacts were made.

b. 10 Oct 1968

Co. G conducted a cordon and sweep of Kim Lien Hamlet, North of Danang. 1st CIT and 94 National Police searched the hamlet, interrogating all indigenous personnel thoroughly. No enemy contacts were made, results were 5 detainees.

c. 14 Oct 1968

Assumed Operational Control of Co. K 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines extending our northern AO through Hai Van Pass to Lang Co Bridge and modifying our southern boundary to route TL 514.

Chopped Co. K 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines to their parent unit in AN HQ.

Reassignment of the Co. in our western AO for better tactical coverage of our assigned mission of defending the Rocket Belt. Move was generally due to the increased northern AO through the Hai Van Pass area and the effect of the monsoons on resupply.

5. COMMAND RELATIONS

a. The 1st Marine Division exercised administrative control and the 26th Marine Regiment exercised operational control of the battalion during October.

6. EQUIPMENT AND LOGISTICS

a. Shortages of major items of equipment did not effect the operational capabilities of the battalion during October.

d. All resupply for Company A and B are staged at Landing Zone 460 for pick up and delivery by helicopter.

e. During the inclement weather in October, three Otters were attached from 11th Motors and used extensively to resupply Company D.

f. This battalion received one, 100KW generator on 25 October 1968 to replace a 60KW generator which was inadequate for the over all electrical power requirements of this battalion.

7. CIVIC ACTION

a. During this reporting period, 13 Med Caps were held, during which 180 people were treated and 350 lbs of soap were distributed to try and relieve the many skin infections encountered.

b. The Battalion was involved in three major projects during this reporting period: (1) The Nam My Pig Project; the command continues to supply garbage from the local combat base at Hill 190, (2) support of the Nam My Refugee Hamlet, and (3) construction of the Hoa Lac Village Hall which began 21 September and is now 90% complete.

c. A band made up of individuals from the battalion played for an estimated 1000 children during the 6 October Children's Festival.

PsyOps Activities

A total of 13,600 leaflets were distributed by Marine patrols throughout the Battalion TAOR. Thirteen (13) aerial sorties were requested to drop propaganda leaflets throughout the Battalion TAOR. An armed propaganda team was used to disseminate information to the local indigenous personnel of the purpose of the Danang barrier now under construction. This team, using a loudspeaker system mounted on a vehicle, broadcast for a total of 17 hours. There were five M26 hand grenades and two 60mm mortar rounds turned in to Marine Outposts by Vietnamese civilians. There are no indications of any change in the attitude of the civilian population.

Assumed Operational Control of Co. L 3rd Battalion, 26th Marines for a period of three days. Co. L was utilized to search in force the Elephant Valley approach to Quang and to covertly insert two reconnaissance teams.

10. INTELLIGENCE

The C Company TAOR proved to be a lucrative area for killer-ambush teams in the month of October. Company B and C accounted for 8 VC/NVA kills by body count in ambushes keyed in the Kim Lien and Thuy Tu Hamlet area, between the hours of 1930 and 2400. During October there were 10 contacts, 6 booty trap incidents, 10 enemy sightings, and 22 detainees turned over to GIE for questioning. On 10 October 1968 a search and clear operation on Kim Lien Hamlet was conducted by elements of this Battalion, CIT, and National Police, resulting in 5 detainees. On 26 October 1968, a search and clear operation on Quan Nam (5) was conducted by elements of this Battalion, 150 National Police, and CIT with negative results. Throughout the month of October, this Battalion captured 5 weapons, 11 grenades, 900lbs of food items, 10 lbs of miscellaneous clothing and documents.

Enemy Estimate

From the 8 bodies confirmed by B and C Company, it was determined that elements of the 31st NVA Regiment have been gathering rice and other food supplies from Kim Lien. The enemy seems to be well organized, traveling in small well-dispersed units and in some cases one or two man points were employed by the enemy. It is believed that our kill ratio is higher than the actual confirmed count due to the numerous blood trails found from this months contacts. On 11 October 1968, Co. A initiated an ambush near Quan Nam Hamlet, killing one NVA. The ambush then relocated itself covering the area of the body. The NVA returned within two hours, swept the area by fire and proceeded to move into the area. Co A's ambush then opened fire, resulting in another KIA. The enemy fled and did not return. Also on 12 October C Company had a similar incident at Kim Lien. The enemy again returned and reconnoitered by fire. On 24 October D Company established an ambush site near Quan Nam (5) Village. The enemy, hiding in houses, came out, surrounded the ambush site and threw grenades and fired small arms at the ambush before retreating under superior fire. The increase in activity in Quan Nam (5) is believed due to the flooding monsoon rains that made the area generally inaccessible for friendly operations. The enemy was able to move in this area more readily with the assistance of locally obtained boats.

TERRAIN

Surveillance of the TAOR is conducted from four major points, hill 190, hill 60, hill 124, and Ksso Plant, which overlooks most of the valley in our TAOR. The foothills and mountains are covered by Recon inserts and patrols. The valley floor is made up of small islands around the Cu De River with numerous villages and rice paddies reaching far into the foothills. The area is almost always flooded and vehicle type traffic is restricted to the roads. The foothills are rough and rolling with small shrubs and tall grass, it is passable by foot troops, but movement is very slow. The mountains are steep and rough with thick canopies and movement is usually restricted to column formations. The area around Hai Van is steep and rocky and is covered by shrubs and heavy trees with thick canopies, movement is again generally restricted to column formations.

WEATHER

Heavy rains prevailed during the first part of the month due to a tropical storm, which resulted in extensive flooding. The latter part of the month was hot and dry with scattered light showers. Total rainfall was 39.09 inches during October.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

a. Nineteen (19) radio sets AN/PRC-25, on special allowance, were turned into FLC. This loss has not seriously curtailed the day and night activities, but has reduced flexibility in communications. The issue of squad radio sets AN/PRC-88 will alleviate the situation.

b. There has been a problem with override on the battalion tac net and some on the company tac nets. This is to be expected because of the density of units in the Danang area, and also because of the high location of our antennas. Atmospheric conditions change rapidly in this area and this influences the amount of override on the radio nets. Frequencies have been changed and antennas moved, but this problem requires continual close supervision to provide the best possible communications.

c. An advance CP group was established at hill 190 to control the operation involving Co. L 3rd Battalion, 26th Marines moving up Elephant Valley. Communications equipment used to support this advance CP included: A MRC-109 vehicle with a KY-8 installed, two (2) AN/PRC-25 radio sets, one (1) RC-202 antenna, one (1) AN/GRA-39 remote set, two hundred feet of coax cable, and two (2) radio operators. All equipment, including the MRC-109 were helo-lifted into position.

d. Waterproofing school was held at all rifle companies and basic communication classes were given to all new arrivals.

WIRE COMMUNICATION

a. Problems in wire were mostly created by the heavy rainfall and electrical storms during the month.

b. All remote sets required grounding to prevent electrical storm damage.

MAINTENANCE

a. Technical support from the Battalion Tech Shop consisted of repairing all types of radio and telephone sets held by the battalion plus crypto equipment KW-7 and KY-8.

12. FIRE SUPPORT AND FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION

During October, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines changed to a centralized Fire Direction Center. The battalion FSOC is no longer responsible for requesting Saw-a-Planes for Artillery Fire Missions. However, the FSOC does retain control of ground clearance in the 1st Battalion, 26th Marines AO. Missions were mainly fired on enemy contact and enemy routes of egress from friendly ambush sites. Rocket suppression, harassing and interdicting missions and illumination missions were fired throughout the month of October in support of 1st Battalion, 26th Marines.

13. AIR SUPPORT

During October, the battalion utilized fixed-wing aircraft, flareships, helicopter gunships, "Spooky" aircraft, helicopter resupply and medivacs, and airborne observers in support of operating units. Extreme caution was used when employing air support near populated areas.
