PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During this reporting period the Battalion continued the assigned mission in AO. This consisted of providing defense of the Vital DaNang Area and adjacent Military Installations, providing security for assigned Vital Bridges and roads and preventing movement of enemy supplies and munitions into the AO. Extensive daily patrols and night ambushes were maintained to interdict enemy activity in the area.
2. There were four (4) Company-size operations conducted. Three (3) were reconnaissance in force missions and one (1) search and clear mission. One (1) reconnaissance in force mission was conducted in Mortar Valley and along the Charlie Ridge area. The two (2) other Company-size reconnaissance missions were conducted generally in the northwestern sector of the Battalion AO. The search and clear mission was conducted into Rucker Valley (AT 9473). Particular emphasis was placed on the search of a White House located in the vicinity of (AT 985735).
3. Enemy contact throughout these operations was nonexistent. There were no significant enemy sightings. Several bunkers and tunnels were found and destroyed. There was one (1) US M-1 Carbine with magazine recovered, two (2) AK-47s and one (1) SKS rifle with magazines captured.
4. BFS activations increased slightly during this reporting period but no positive results were attained.

- a. Major Operations. The Battalion participated in no major operations during this reporting period.
- b. Command Relations. From 1 November to 30 November 1969 the Battalion was OpCon to CG, 1st MarDiv.
- c. Combat Missions Assigned
  - (1) Occupy and defend all existing positions in assigned AO.
  - (2) Conduct patrols and ambushes with minimum of 2/3 available forces assigned night acts.

  - (9) Provide security and support for installations of line sensors on DaNang Anti-infiltration barrier in AO as required.
  - (10) Employ RF and line sensors in tactical operations and on DaNang Anti-infiltration barrier integrated with fire, night optical devices and reaction forces to deny enemy movement through barrier.
  - (11) Be prepared to conduct operations outside assigned AO on order.
  - (12) Conduct psychological operations within capabilities.
  - (13) Continue participation in combined action program with CAP 217 and 218.

a. 010001H to 012400H November 1969

- (1) 012200H. Company B, Third Platoon, Third Squad spotted three (3) VC/NVA at grid AT 906714. B 3-3 made contact with enemy with small arms and M-79's. Swept area. Results: Negative.

b. 030001H to 032400H November 1969

- (1) 030145H. Company A, First Platoon, Third Squad, Second Fire Team received approximately four (4) grenades, small arms fire, and three (3) incoming RPG rounds at OP grid AT 924734. Fired team mortars and swept area. Results: Two (2) USMC WIA's. Marines were emergency medevaced.

- (2) 031200H. A 6X6 from 1st Bn., 26 Marines received one (1) round sniper fire from grid AT 954690. Results: No casualties.

- (3) 031720H. Company D reported a light aircraft making several passes over CP area. On the third pass the aircraft fired two (2) marking rounds. Results: Negative action taken.

- (1) 052200H. CAP 218 received two (2) incoming explosive devices from grid AT 945652. Fired small arms and M-79's at two (2) fleeing enemy. Results: Negative.
- (2) 052020H. Company B, First Platoon, Third Squad received three (3) incoming grenades and small arms fire from grid AT 917708. Fired M-60s and swept area. Results: Negative.

d. 060001H to 062400H November 1969

- (1) 061300H. A 6X6 from 1st Bn., 26 Marines received one (1) sniper round and six (6) automatic bursts of small arms fire. No casualties resulted. Results: Closed Route 540 to all vehicles without armed guard.
- (2) 062050H. Company B, Second Platoon, Second Squad spotted two (2) VC without weapons moving to the northeast at grid AT 899722. Fired M-79s and small arms fire. Results: Negative.

- (1) 100335H. Company B, Third Platoon at grid AT 945707 saw movement coming up the road from the village, and opened fire with small arms. A sweep of the area was conducted immediately. Results: One (1) ARVN KIA. The ARVN's brother and a VN female were also found in the area. The local police took the VN female. The brother left the scene and the family took the ARVN's body.
- (2) 102130H. Company B, Second Platoon, Second Squad made contact with three (3) VC at grid AT 912716. Received one (1) incoming CHICOM, AK-47 fire and mortars. Swept area. Results: One (1) VC KIA, one (1) CHICOM, CHICOM cartridge belt, sleeping gear, wallet and papers. Also found blood trails and drag marks.

f. 110001H to 112400H November 1969

- (1) 111430H. Company C, Third Platoon while on patrol found reinforced bunkers, trenches, tunnels, one (1) case of long rats (Aug. 69 LOT-120) and fighting holes. Results: Structures were destroyed.
- (2) 112126H. Company D, Third Platoon, First Squad made contact with Company D, Third Platoon, Second Squad. Results: Two (2) USMC

## g. 140001H to 142400H November 1969

- (1) 140355H. Company D, Third Platoon, Second Squad made contact with four (4) VC at grid AT 917709. Swept area. Results: Three (3) VC KIAs, miscellaneous clothing, four (4) M-26 grenades, one (1) bottle of rice wine, one (1) US canteen, two (2) cartridge belts, rain gear and two (2) battle dressings.
- (2) 142145H. CAP 218 made contact with twelve (12) enemy at grid AT 946651. Swept contact area. Results: Negative.

## h. 180001H to 182400H November 1969

- (1) 180020H. Company D, Third Platoon, First Squad spotted approximately six (6) indigenous personnel moving east to west at grid 920654. Fired small arms. Enemy fled to the east. Swept area. Results: Negative.
- (2) 180900H. Company C found an enemy cache of two (2) AK-47's, four (4) 82mm rounds, and eight (8) tunnels and caves. Results: Blew 82mm rounds, tunnels and caves.
- (3) 182010H. Company D, Third Platoon, Second Squad made contact with two (2) or three (3) enemy. Results: Negative.

## i. 190001H to 192400H November 1969

- (1) 191630H. Company C, Third Platoon, Second Squad found a freshly dug bunker at grid AT 858698. At grid AT 871694 found a grave thirty (30) days old, corpse had green uniform and sandals. At grid AT 872709 found a bunker with a room. Results: Bunkers were destroyed.
- (2) 191630H. Company C, Third Platoon, Third Squad at grid AT 872709 found one (1) bunker and one (1) M-1 Carbine with a magazine of 20 rounds. At grid AT 874710 found one (1) CHICOM grenade, poncho and bottle. Results: Blew bunkers.
- (3) 191635H. Company D reported air strikes run by jet aircraft believed to be Vietnamese. Results: Contacted DaNang DASC, air strike continued. No friendly casualties.

## j. 220001H to 222400H November 1969

- (1) 221030H. Company D, First Platoon, Second Squad discovered cache of 175 pounds of unpolished rice. Results: Rice was brought to camp and turned over to District Officials.

- (1) 242245H. Company C, First Platoon, Second Squad spotted fourteen (14) NVA carrying weapons and packs. Made contact. Results: Negative.

- (1) 302115H. Company B, First Platoon, Third Squad received eight (8) CHICOM grenades and small arms fire at grid AT 903708. Returned fire and swept area. Results: One (1) VC KIA and four (4) USMC WIA minor.

### 3. INTELLIGENCE

#### a. Enemy Situation

- (1) General situation at the beginning of the period: With the rice harvest nearly over, the enemy on occasion moved down out of the mountains on rice resupply runs. Enemy initiated ground activity was light due to both the offensive actions and defensive capabilities of the 1st Battalion, 26th Marines against the enemy.
- (2) General situation at the end of the period: During the reporting period, enemy activity increased slightly in comparison to the previous reporting period. VC/VCI subversive, espionage, and sabotage activities reported during this period reflected no significant change in intensity. Considerable enemy effort continues to focus on the collection, storage, distribution and transportation of rice.

d. Enemy Trends

(1) There have been no significant trends or changes in tactical methods used by the enemy during this reporting period. The enemy is mainly concerned with the continuation of rice supply runs from their mountain base camps into local villages.

e. Weather Conditions

(1) The monsoon rains hindered both enemy and friendly units for a short period of time this month. A slight increase in enemy movement was noted during the middle of the month as lunar illumination decreased. The maximum temperature for the month of November was 96 degrees, and the minimum was 66 degrees. The total rainfall this month was 10.08 inches in the DaNang Area.

4. FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION

a. "A" Battery, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines

- (1) Types of fire support employed: prep fires, harrassing and interdicting fires, counter-mortar/rocket fires, zone fires, shifting fires, time-on-target fires, and fires on targets of opportunity.
- (2) During the month of November, "A" Battery, 1/13 fired 5196 rounds at 344 targets.

b. 4.2 Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines

e. Significant Events

- (1) On 8 November at 1835 and again at 1850 a total of 13 possible rocket flashes were spotted three (3) of which appeared to be headed for DaNang. Launch grid vicinity 934663. The other ten (10) flashes originated at AT 955694, direction undetermined.
- (2) On 11 November at 0600, Company B and Company C reported one (1) rocket flash at AT 905675. 81mm, 4.2 and 105mm rounds were fired into the area. A sweep uncovered personal gear and food stuffs, and trails leading into the mountains.
- (3) On 22 November at 1419 five (5) VC were spotted at AT 887687. 4.2 mortar mission was called with negative observable results.
- (4) On 25 November at 0340, D2-2 received 15 rounds of incoming air and graze bursts in three (3) valleys. Rounds appeared to be of 105mm size and after checking with 1/13, 1/11, and Division FSCC personnel, it was determined the rounds were fired by "C" Battery, 1/11 in response to BPS activations.
- (5) On 26 November 1969 at 1450 a 4.2 mortar fire mission was called on five (5) indigenous personnel at AT 896722. Political, ground, and air clearance were received through proper channels. Results: Two (2) cows wounded by fragmentation.

- a. Supply/Resupply. During the month of November the policy of force feeding was continued. This enabled the letter companies to maintain at least a three (3) day reserve of class I, III, and V items, while

Hill 10 maintained a twelve (12) day reserve of the same. Company C, on two (2) company - sized operations, carried a sufficient amount of Long Range Rations and ammunition for three (3) days, and was then resupplied by air.

- b. Food/Water. The Battalion messhalls on Hill 41, Fire Support Base SIXSHOOTER, and Hill 10 were utilized by letter companies when applicable. Charlie Company on both operations was issued Long Range Rations, SP Packs, MCI's, and juice. On November 10th and Thanksgiving all troops except those on operations were served the Holiday Menu. Water resupply was the most difficult problem encountered during November. We were hampered by the inability of higher Command to support Hill 41 with the water necessary for messing needs and troop use. For a period of two (2) weeks Hill 41 was resupplied with water from Hill 10, which barely has sufficient to maintain it's own requirements.
- c. Maintenance. Due to the inability to obtain sufficient Motor Transport spare parts, a number of vehicles were needlessly deadlined on a NORS basis. This has been rectified and C-1 readiness exists. The Battalion has at the present time five (5) 2 1/2 ton trucks, this is an insufficient number for daily housekeeping needs. The Battalion has a request for additional vehicles to alleviate this problem.
- d. Camp Facilities Development. The Battalion Messhall has been renovated and is operating under sanitary conditions. This Battalion has engineer requests submitted for eight (8) SEA huts to be constructed at Hill 10, six (6) at Hill 41, and five (5) for Fire Support Base SIXSHOOTER. There are also requests for 23 bunkers and external improvements of the drainage system at the Hill 10 messhall. Because the present shower unit is not large enough, a requisition has been submitted for an additional 18 head shower unit at Hill 10. And, as a result of an increasing need for potable water, the Battalion has requested the construction of a 10,000 gallon water tank which would effectively supply all water needs for Hill 10.

(2) The above is in addition to the weekly training schedule which is being conducted on company level. A total of 15 handouts were distributed to the companies.

(3) On 13 November 1969 the ALO and FAC Team conducted classes on Air Strikes and MED-EVACS. Thirty five (35) personnel attended.

#### 11. COMMUNICATIONS

- a. Radio. Radio Communications was maintained from Hill 10 COC to the line companies. A covered voice radio net was continued between 1st Battalion, 26th Marines and 26th Marines Regiment Headquarters and Company A was permitted to enter the net.
- b. Radio Relay. Regimental Headquarters continued to support 1/26 with a Radio Relay Team. Two (2) common user lines were operated through the Battalion switchboard to Regiment.
- c. Wire. The entire month was dedicated toward Hill 10 wire systems improvement and consolidation. Obsolete unused cable and numerous poles were eliminated by relocating cables and terminals. The lines to Hill 10 perimeter bunkers were overheaded and cables laid to replace loose wire. On 25 November a project was started to install a reliable line from Hill 10 to Hill 41. A total of 18 metal poles were placed to augment those in existence. This project is expected to be completed in early December.
- d. Message Center. Scheduled message runs twice daily between Hill 10 and 1st Marines Comm Center were continued. Comm/Crypto guard remained with 26 Marines. A Comm Tac Pub Library was started and internal Message Center corrections were made.

- e. Maintenance and Supply. 1st and 2nd echelon maintenance is being performed at Hill 10. A definite Logistics/Supply problem was uncovered after tracing all outdated incompletd requisitions. Communication supply continued to improve through tightened control and greater supervision.
- f. Electrical. A 60KW generator continues to supply lighting for Hill 10. This has been proven an insufficient source for Hill 10 requirements and a 100KW has been requested and approved through III MAF. A 100KW generator is expected to be installed during December. Hill 41 was powered by 60KW generator until 13 November. This was in excess of existing requirements and moved to Hill 10 as backup to the working generator there. A 36KW generator was repaired and placed into operation on Hill 41. Rewiring and load balancing on Hill 10 continued throughout the month as electrical parts become available.
- g. Significant Events. On 28 November a Regimental Communication Inspection was conducted on Hill 10. The two (2) weeks prior were spent in preparation for the inspection as well as the continuation of improvement of the communication system for the Battalion. The inspection pointed out that, although definite improvement was obvious, numerous areas still need to be worked on to bring the communications equipment up to 1st Marine Division garrison standards.
