PART IIUNCLASSIFIEDNARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Enemy movement in the Battalion TACR increased slightly. Movement along the Song Tuy Loan, a known avenue of ingress and egress, was the predominant movement by the enemy. Aggressive day patrols, night ambushes and Company - sized operations in this area completely thwarted the enemy's reconnaissance efforts for his planned TET offensive.
2. Throughout the reporting period the Battalion also continued its assigned mission that includes: Providing defense of the DaNang Vital Area and adjacent Military Installations, providing security for assigned top/high priority bridges and roads, and preventing movement of enemy supplies and munitions into the AO. To this end, the installation of an Integrated Observation Device (SID-102) on CP 270 accounted for numerous sightings of enemy forces.
3. One two (2) Company - size operation and four (4) single Company operations conducted along the Song Tuy Loan aided considerably in demoralizing and disorganizing the enemy. Two (2) of the Company - size operations were helicopter - borne Reconnaissance in Force and Strike operations (KINGFISHER). This method of rapid response to existing intelligence kept the enemy off balance and drove his forces back into the mountains to the west. Numerous air and artillery missions on known base areas in the mountain ranges to the west complemented these KINGFISHER operations.
4. On 2 February 1970, Fire Support Base SILENCOTER (AT 924757) was completely dismantled and abandoned. Alpha Battery, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines was relocated to Hill 10 (AT 925690) and "B" Battery (-), 1st Battalion, 11th Marines was relocated to CP 270 (AT 865680).
5. In addition to continuing effective combat operations within the AO, the Battalion has been devoting many daylight hours preparing equipment and personnel for redeployment in compliance with the Phase III Redeployment Schedule.
6. On 3 February 1970, Company A conducted a combined operation with two (2) Regional Force Companies from Hieu Duc District in the general vicinity of Tuy Loan (2) Village (from AT 928697 to AT 907702).

PART IIILISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS1. MISSION/OPERATIONS

a. Major Operations. The Battalion participated in no major operations during this reporting period.

b. Command Relations.

- (1) From 1 February to 28 February 1970, the Battalion was OpCon to CC, 1st Mar. Div.
- (2) Effective 170800H February 1970 until 210800H February 1970, Company F, 2nd Battalion, 26th Marines, was OpCon to 1st Battalion, 26th Marines for the purpose of assuming responsibility for the AO of Company C, 1st Battalion while Company C participated in a two (2) Company operation.

c. Combat Missions Assigned

- (1) Occupy and defend all existing positions in assigned AO.
- (2) Conduct patrols and ambushes with minimum of 2/3 available forces assigned night acts.
- (3) Conduct unilateral and combined offensive operations in AO to locate and destroy enemy forces, material, and installations with primary emphasis on security of important population and economic centers and friendly military installations.
- (4) Deploy forces in AO to provide for defense of the DaNang Vital Area with emphasis on routes of approach to probable mortar and rocket launch positions.
- (5) Support accelerated pacification in AO.
- (6) Be prepared to commit reaction forces in defense of Hieu Duc District, CAPs and resettlement hamlets in AO.
- (7) Deny enemy use of all waterways in AO. Enforce curfews and restrictions on waterway traffic.
- (8) Perform inspections top/high priority bridges in AO.
- (9) Provide security and support for installations of line sensors on DaNang Anti-Infiltration barrier in AO as required.
- (10) Employ RF and line sensors in tactical operations and on DaNang Anti-Infiltration barrier integrated with fire, night optical devices and reaction forces to deny enemy movement through barrier.

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- (11) Be prepared to conduct operations outside assigned AO on order.
- (12) Conduct psychological operations within capabilities.
- (13) Continue participation in combined action program with CAP 218.
- (14) Continue rice denial operation in accordance with 26 Marines Frag Order 37-69. (Reference 26 Marines Frag Order 39-69.)
- (15) Establish a permanent CP at Hill 270 at grid AT 865680.

d. Command Control

- (1) The Battalion Command Post was located at Hill 10 (AT 924690) during the entire reporting period. The Battalion Aid Station, Company A, and Company B, were colocated with the Battalion CP at Hill 10. From 17 February to 21 February a Battalion "Jump CP" was located on CP 270 for the purpose of control of a two (2) Company operation.
- (2) Company C and Alpha Battery, 1/13 were located at Fire Support Base SIENHOCHE (AT 924737) from 1 - 7 February 1970. When dismantling of SIENHOCHE was complete on 7 February, both CPs were moved to Hill 10 (AT 924690) for the remainder of the reporting period.
- (3) Company D's CP was located at Hill A1 (AT 934663) throughout the entire reporting period.
- (4) "W" Battery 1/11 was located on CP 270 (AT 865680) throughout the reporting period.
- (5) Command groups of all attached units were located at Hill 10.
- (6) There were no major control problems encountered.

f. NBC Warfare. There were no NBC type devices or warfare employed by either enemy or friendly units during this reporting period.

2. HOSTILITIES

a. Enemy Situation

- (1) General situation at the beginning of the period: Throughout the reporting period there was a steady influx of agent/intelligence reports which gave troop strengths and missions of various VC/NVA units known to be operating in our TAOR. As the Tet New Year passed there was a sharp decline in these same reports. The Tet/Winter Spring Offensive failed to materialize in any significant form. Enemy initiated ground activity remained light due to both the offensive and the defensive capabilities of the 1st Battalion, 26th Marines.
- (2) General situation at the end of the period: During the reporting period there was a slight increase in enemy activity throughout the AO. This activity continued to be primarily reconnaissance/counter-reconnaissance and procuring movements. However, there were three (3) enemy initiated attacks by fire.

b. Enemy Initiated Incidents/Actions

- (1) 130045H-D Co - 8912675 - The Company D position at Mike Tower received two (2) incoming BOB bombs. One (1) impacted inside the defensive wire, partially destroying one (1) sleeping quarters, and one (1) impacted outside of wire.
- (2) 192350H-HAS Co - 914694 - HAS reported nine (9) HE rounds impacted at approximately 400 meters North of Hill 10. Muzzle flashes were reported vicinity AT 905705. There were negative friendly artillery or mortar fire in area. The craters were checked in the A.M. but no tail fins or fragments were found due to water around craters. Rounds were suspected to have been fired by a light indirect fire artillery weapon.
- (3) 251910H-A Co - 892708 - While sitting in ambush site at above grid, Company A took 8-10 rounds incoming HE, type undetermined, but suspected to be small mortars or 60-79 rounds. Fire resulted in one (1) friendly MIA. Marine was medevaced.

d. Enemy Trends. According to agent/intelligence reports received during this reporting period, the enemy has continued to build up his forces in the B. C. Ba Na mountain area. The VC/NVA seem to be concentrating on continuous logistical procurement, reconnaissance and counter-reconnaissance with occasional attacks by fire upon small and/or isolated units.

e. Weather Conditions. The overall weather conditions this month failed to hinder or effect friendly or enemy units in any major way. However, heavily overcast days hampered some supporting air activity and allowed the VC/NVA to move undetected during these periods. The maximum temperature for this reporting period was 87° and the minimum was 61°. The total precipitation for the Da Nang area was .80 inches.

3. SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

a. 030001H to 032400H February 1970

- (1) 030535H Second Platoon Company C at grid AT 934713 suffered one (1) Marine killed when they opened fire on two (2) VC at above grid. A sweep of the area revealed one (1) VC KIA and blood trails leading into a hamlet at grid AT 932714. Results: One (1) VC KIA, one (1) VC KIA, one (1) 9mm CHICOM pistol w/holster, two (2) M-26 grenades, 10,120\$VN, wallet containing papers and ID card were captured.

b. 050001H to 052400H February 1970

- (1) 050215H First Platoon Company C sprung ambush on five (5) VC/NVA at grid AT 901710. A sweep was conducted of the contact area. Results: Negative.

c. 060001H to 062400H February 1970

- (1) 061845H Company C sighted 16 indigenous personnel with head gear, packs, and rifles moving across rice paddies at grid AT 934734. Company C moved a unit to make contact but the enemy had by this time entered a village at grid AT 945730. The only action taken was to notify Hueu Duc District Headquarters and friendly units in the area.

d. 070001H to 072400H February 1970

- (1) 071130H Company C at grid AT 927737 received four (4) rounds of sniper fire from grid AT 934742. Five indigenous personnel were sighted at the same grid. Company C fired 60mm and checked area out. Results: Negative.

- (2) 072030H CAP 218 at grid AT 953653 sighted unknown size enemy force at grid AT 953651 and opened fire with small arms, enemy fled to the south. A sweep was conducted. Results: Negative.

e. 100001H to 102400H February 1970

- (1) 10015H Company D suffered one (1) Marine shot while standing perimeter watch at grid AT 904663. Marine returned fire and illumination and tank spotlight was used to search area. Results: Negative.

f. 110001H to 112400H February 1970

- (1) 110655H First Platoon Company A opened fire on five (5) VC/NVA at grid AT 887715. Results: Two (2) VC/NVA KIA and two (2) AK-47s w/magazines, four (4) CHICOMs, two (2) cartridge belts, four (4) packs, rice, various personal gear, a first aid pack and marijuana and cocaine was captured.

g. 120001H to 122400H February 1970

- (1) 121150H First Platoon Company A found one (1) NVA body lying on a trail at grid AT 880707. The body was clothed in black pajamas. A search of the body revealed two (2) CHICOMs, one (1) NVA cartridge belt, wallet w/papers. Results: One (1) NVA KIA.

- (2) 121500H First Platoon Company A found three (3) VC/NVA bodies at grid AT 884720 that appeared to have been dead one (1) month from fragmentation wounds. Results: Three (3) VC/NVA KIA.

h. 130001H to 132400H February 1970

- (1) 130001H US Company sighted two (2) enemy at grid AT 820648 about 250 meters from the perimeter. The area was illuminated with a searchlight and M-79s were fired. Area was swept. Results: Negative.

i. 140001H to 142400H February 1970

- (1) 141135H Company B from OP 270 at grid AT 865680 sighted 15 VC/NVA in open at grid AT 870715. Artillery was fired and the FO saw two (2) enemy fall. The area was not swept due to inability to obtain air transportation and the relative inaccessibility by foot. Results: Two (2) VC/NVA KIA.
- (2) 141245H Company B from OP 270 at grid AT 865680 sighted six (6) VC/NVA at grid 877706 wearing green utilities w/packs and rifles. Artillery was fired. The area was not swept due to relative inaccessibility by foot.

- (3) 141725H Company B from OP 270 at grid AT 865680 sighted 15 VC/NVA at grid 874706 wearing green utilities, packs, bush hats and carrying rifles. Fired artillery and 107mm mortar HE. Results: Nine (9) VC/NVA KIA.
- (4) 141825H Company B from OP 270 at grid AT 865680 sighted three (3) VC/NVA at grid 86708 wearing green utilities. Artillery was fired. Results: Two (2) VC/NVA KIA.

j. 150001H to 152400H February 1970

- (1) 151515H Third Platoon Company A tripped a CHICOM booby trap at grid AT 872702. A careful search of the area revealed four (4) more booby traps of the same type. Results: One (1) USMC KIA (minor), the booby traps were blown in place.

k. 160001H to 172400H February 1970

- (1) 160810H First Platoon Company D sighted two (2) to three (3) enemy at grid AT 921679. Company D opened fire with small arms. Results: Negative.

l. 210001H to 212400H February 1970

- (1) 210900H Company B reported from OP 270 at grid AT 865680 that a CM-53 while attempting to land a small bulldozer on the OP dropped it and the dozer rolled down the hill to the NE about 300 meters. Recovery operations are in progress.

m. 220001H to 222400H February 1970

- (1) 221925H Second Platoon Company D sighted one (1) enemy at grid AT 923653. The enemy soldier threw a CHICOM grenade at the point man and fled. Marines opened fire with small arms. Results: Negative.
- (2) 222000H First Platoon Company A sighted eight (8) VC/NVA carrying weapons at grid AT 898705. The Platoon opened fire and swept area. Results: Negative.
- (3) 222130H Second Platoon Company D sighted one (1) enemy at grid AT 928672. The Platoon opened fire with small arms and swept area. Results: Negative.

n. 250001H to 252400H February 1970

- (1) 251326H Company B from OP 270 at grid AT 865680 sighted 23 VC/NVA at grid AT 874706. A total of 162 rounds of 105mm HE and 54 rounds of 107mm HE was fired on this target. Results: Five (5) VC/NVA KIA.

- (2) 252202H Second Platoon Company C sighted approximately 30 enemy with packs and rifles at grid AT 933714. The platoon opened fire with small arms and M-60s. Company C's Platoon was reinforced by CAP 212 and 217. A sweep was conducted of the contact area. Results: Eleven (11) VC/LVA KIA and indication of several WIA. The area was swept again in the AM. Results: One (1) VC/LVA female body was found. Also a pack, poncho, three (3) LVA canteens, an AK-47 magazine with ammo, a CHICOM grenade, five (5) lbs of polished rice and various bandages and medical supplies. Total VC/LVA KIA was determined to be eleven (11).

Significant Events:

(1) During the month of February, Battery A, 1st Battalion, 13th Marines, 4.2 inch Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines, and 81mm Mortar Platoon fired a total of 97 rounds in reaction to the Hoang Anti-Infiltration System activations.

(2) In support of CACO 2-1 the following number of missions and rounds fired was recorded: 81mm Mortar Platoon fired 80 rounds on 16 missions and 54 rounds of illumination, 105mm mortar fired 24 illumination rounds on three (3) missions.

(4) On 16 February, the Senator on OP 270 spotted 40-50 enemy moving along a trail, called in a fire mission utilizing 105mm firecracker, 105mm VT, and 155mm HE. Results: 16 probable enemy killed.

(5) On 17 February, the Senator again spotted approximately 40 heavily armed enemy. Called in artillery fire mission. Results: 21 probable enemy dead.

(6) Throughout the month of February numerous sighting of small groups have resulted in 47 probable enemy killed with artillery.

(7) Several Time-on Target fire missions and numerous grid saturations have been used throughout the 1st Battalion's TACOP on high priority intelligence targets.

(8) During the month several strings of miniside and magids have been planted on heavily used infiltration routes. In reaction to these activations a total of 22 missions were fired, using 448 rounds of 105mm firecracker and VT, as well as 223 107mm VT rounds. Results are unknown.

- (9) Great improvements in the fire support received by 1st Battalion are largely due to the high morale within each supporting unit. Reaction to sensor activations as well as routine fire missions has been cut to an extremely fast four (4) minutes. The **SENATOR** has proved quite effective in obtaining immediate and accurate artillery fire on target in a minimum of time.

d. Significant Events. No significant events transpired other than those mentioned above.8. LOGISTICSa. Supply/Resupply. During the month of February the policy of force feeding was continued. This enabled the letter companies to maintain a basic allowance and a three (3) day reserve of Class I, III, and V items, while Hill 10 maintained a twelve (12) day reserve of the same. While on operations letter companies carried with them a sufficient amount of long range rations for three (3) days and a three (3) day supply of ammunition. This command's outpost at Hill 270 is resupplied by air three (3) times each week. Outpost 270 has been supplied with wire, culvert material, ammunition, and engineer equipment by air, amounting to approximately 75,000 pounds per week.b. Food/Water. The Battalion messhalls on Hill 41 and Hill 10 were utilized by letter companies when applicable. While on operations companies were issued long range rations, SP packs, MCI's and juice.

This was supplemented with cigarettes, candy and books supplied by the USO's in the area. At the Hill 41 cantonment the company is presently existing with the water provided by the Regimental water tanker. However, a well has been constructed and will shortly be in operation. Outpost 270 is resupplied by air utilizing water trailers amounting to 2,400 gallons per week.

- c. Maintenance. Due to the continued inability to obtain sufficient motor transport parts at our echelon, motor vehicles have been dead-lined on a NORS basis. This command has had an excessive number of deadlined mules. This situation is rectifiable and is in the process of being corrected. This command has five (5) M151 Code H letters. Because these letters were not honored by Force Logistics Command due to the depletion at their rolling stock this command procured three (3) vehicles from our sister battalions. This command remains in a C-1 state of readiness.

- d. Embarkation. The MEDS portion of embarkation is up to date and the data is correct. Mount-out boxes are marked properly to coincide with the Unit Cargo List. This command is in the process of invoicing the majority of its equipment back to FLC and other units in line with the pending redeployment/deactivation. This command is embarkation ready both materially and administratively.

- e. Camp Facilities Development. The cantonment at Hill 10 is in the process of being renovated by 1st Engineer Battalion. SEA huts have been constructed and rebuilt. Fire Support Base Six-Shooter was disbanded and all salvagable material has been returned to Hill 10 for reuse. Wire has been layed around this command's positions on Hill 10, Hill 41, Cobb Bridge, and Outpost 270 in order to tactically improve these positions. Outpost 270 has been resupplied with engineer equipment and materials by air. This outpost is considered as an artillery spotting position and is equipped with a SENATOR device. The road leading to Hill 10 has been oiled and graveled in order to cut down the amount of dust. One (1) burn-out type wooden head has been constructed at Cobb Bridge, along with a field expedient shower. Perimeter lights have been installed at Cobb Bridge and Hill 41, and the Hill 10 cantonment is presently being equipped. H&S COC has been made into a tactical COC and B Company's command bunker has been relocated. The east tower at Hill 10 has been moved to a better location. Work has continued with heavy equipment at Hill 41, Cobb Bridge and at Hill 10. The messhall drainage system has been repaired by engineers from 1st Engineer Battalion.

- f. Significant Events. None.

9. NEW TECHNIQUES. There were no significantly new techniques employed during this reporting period.

used by this battalion 27 February 1970. During this time they conducted a joint US/Vietnamese MedCap in Huong Son Hamlet (AT 940674) and a Vietnamese MedCap in Phu Son Hamlet (AT 957662). Propaganda broadcasts were made during both Medcaps.

12. COMMUNICATIONS

a. Radio

- (1) At 090800H frequencies and call signs were changed. No significant frequency problems were experienced during the change.
- (2) An additional even-numbered frequency was needed to run a KINGFISHER Operation. This was accomplished by exchanging the Alpha Company TAC frequency with the Battalion TAC secondary.
- (3) On 16 February the Command Group split up with one portion moving to Hill 270 and the other remaining on Hill 10. Considerable frequency interference developed and was finally solved by using an additional frequency from Regimental assets.

Radio Relay: Regimental Headquarters continued to support 1/26 with a Radio Relay team. Two (2) common user lines, as well as a COG & WSOC to COG & WSOC hot line were operated from the Battalion to Regiment. Occasional alignment and wire difficulties were encountered but swiftly corrected. On 26 February the shot had to be secured for about four (4) hours while the east tower was moved by a helicopter. This precaution was taken in order to protect the antenna from breakage due to rotor wash.

- c. Wire. The Hill 10 line remained intact the entire month. Each night a trouble-shooter wire man remained on watch in the HAS COG bunker and was utilized to repair any bunker line outage. This resulted in most favorable up time on all compound and bunker lines.

d. Maintenance/Supply

- (1) The increased requirement for PA-306s caused considerable drain on existing stocks. It was necessary to fill two (2) separate work orders/requisitions in order to meet our battery needs.

- (2) Previous requisition supplies are starting to drift in, however large items requested are cancelled out.

- e. Significant Events. This month was dedicated to preparing all equipment for turnover. All repair items in EIR had to be drawn out and packed. By 28 February 25 percent of all Communication equipment was boxed and turned over to Supply for disposition.
