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PART IIINARRATIVE SUMMARY**UNCLASSIFIED**

1. During the reporting period the Battalion operated in two separate areas, GO NOI Island and DANANG (Operations on GO NOI Island constituted Operation "ALLEN BROOK").

2. The Battalion was in the GO NOI Island area from 1-23 June 1968. The mission from 1-5 June remained the same as reported in the May Command Chronology. The Battalion was directed to search and clear the villages in the GO NOI Island operating area from Grid Line 94 to Grid Line 03 in conjunction with the 1st Battalion, 26th Marines. On 5 June the 1st Battalion, 26th Marines were withdrawn making "ALLEN BROOK" a one-battalion operation. Also on this date the 27th Marines relocated their command post from Liberty Bridge (AT925537) to DUONG SON(2) (AT992676). At this time the Battalion split its Command Group in order to establish positive communications between the operating area and the Regimental Command Post. The rear echelon of the group was established at Liberty Bridge and utilized the existing communications network left by the 27th Marines.

3. The date of 6 June marked the commencement of an entirely new mission for the Battalion. Elements of the 1st Engineer Battalion arrived at Liberty Bridge and were ferried across the SONG THU BON river to link with the Battalion. Their mission was to clear the GO NOI Island operating area of structures, caves, trenches, and spider traps and to uncover caches of enemy arms and supplies. The Battalion was given the missions of providing security for the detachment, overall coordination of the clearing effort, and control/domination of the GO NOI Island area. It was decided that these tasks could best be accomplished by utilizing two companies to provide local and long range protection for the engineer detachment with the remainder (Co "B", 6-13 June; Co "A", and Co "B", 13-15 June; Co "B" and Co "D", 15-23 June) devoted to outlying operations designed to control as much of GO NOI Island as possible. The first clearing project centered in the area of CU BAN(4)(AT947529) and CU BAN(3)(AT952524). These villages had been the scene of several major encounters and were given first priority. With these cleared, the flank of the Battalion and its lines of communication with Liberty Bridge would have greater security and the engineer effort could progress to the island proper. After the clearing of CU BAN(4) and CU BAN(3), the Battalion displaced to the vicinity of AT955524 for engineer work in CU BAN(6), LE NAM(1), and LE NAM(2). By 12 June this had been completed. On the 13th, the engineering base shifted to AT954538 for work in LE BAC(1) and LE BAC(2). Also on this date, Company D returned to the Battalion's operational control and was heli-lifted into GO NOI Island. Its arrival gave the Battalion two companies with which to work for control of the TAOR. Operations to the east were expanded by moving Company B to KY LAM NAM (AT995543).

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4. On the 15th of June preliminary engineering work west of GO NOI proper was completed. The Engineer Detachment, CP Group, and two supporting companies moved to AT965546 and began clearing the PHU DONG(2) and PHU DONG(1) hamlets. Increased sniper activity greeted this move. Earlier on the 15th, the NVA assaulted the B Company position at KY LAM NAM and were repulsed with heavy losses. (Details in paragraph 6.a). After work in PHU DONG(1) was completed on 17 June, the effort concentrated on the heart of the GO NOI area, BAO AN TAY. This village extends approximately 1000 meters west to east and 800 meters north to south in Grid Square AT9753 and AT9853. On the 16th, Companies B and D established a mutual base camp at AT010544. From this position companies B and D conducted extended patrols east of the railroad to the 03 grid line. Company A and Company C conducted patrolling west of the railroad and provided engineer security. The Battalion Command Group remained with the engineer project.

5. The only significant contact during the period when two companies were east of the railroad occurred on 19 June. Bravo X-ray, (consisting of a platoon and a command group from Company B and a platoon from Company D) encountered resistance at BT023550. Reinforcements were sent initially from Company B and D and later on all of Company A and the Battalion Command Group were committed. (Details in paragraph 6.a). A major sweep of the eastern end of the island was directed by Commanding General, 1st Marine Division and commenced 210530H. The principal area involved was the village of CAM LAU NAM (BT040540 - BT053540). The execution consisted of Company A, one platoon of Company C, and the Battalion Command Group departing from BAO AN TAY (AT978537) and linking with companies B and D east of the railroad. From this point, a series of phase lines were established and preparatory fires, both air strikes and artillery "Time on Target" missions, were planned along the axis of advance. No contact was made, but it should be noted that the fire support coordination between the air, artillery, and ground forces was excellent. (Details in paragraph 6.a).

6. 22 June marked the commencement of relief of the Battalion from Operation "ALLEN BROOK". On this date, the 2nd Battalion, 27th Marines chopped two companies to this Battalion and companies B and D chopped to the 2nd Battalion, 27th Marines and returned to the 27th Marines TAOR. Commencing 230730H, the remainder of the 2nd Battalion entered Operation "ALLEN BROOK" and this Battalion returned to the 27th Marines TAOR and assumed responsibility of the entire central and western portions. The two battalion TAOR's were divided into four(4) company areas of operation for ease of patrol planning and to facilitate unit coordination with elements of the 51st and 59th ARVN Regiments (See TAB C, DANANG TAOR). Companies B, C, and D established headquarters at Camp DUONG SON and were assigned the northwestern sector, western sector, and eastern sector respectively. Company A established headquarters at the former 2nd Battalion, 27th Marines CP (BT013630) and was assigned the southwestern sector of the Regimental TAOR. The missions assigned the Battalion are to conduct saturation patrolling

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of the areas defined as the "Rocket Belt" and "Mortar Belt"; provide security for the HA DONG bridge(AT940642); provide security for the dam construction (BT003654); provide security for the bridges at AT999699 and AT995688; and conduct combined patrol activity with ARVN units.

a. Summary of Battalion Level Operations

(1) Operation "ALLEN BROOK"

(a) On 5 June, the Battalion had orders to proceed to Liberty Bridge and link up with the elements of the 1st Engineer Battalion. The route of march to Liberty Bridge was along the northern sector of the operating area. Simultaneously, the 1st Battalion, 26th Marines was to proceed through the southern portion of the operating area to Liberty Bridge and withdraw from the operation. Company B, 1st Battalion, 26th Marines, moved into the vicinity of CU BAN(4)(AT9453) and encountered heavy resistance. Company C was directed to move from their position in the vicinity of AT948553, and link up with Company B. Their mission was to relieve the pressure on Company B, allow them to disengage and clean out the pocket of resistance. Company C moved south until it encountered the northernmost element of Company B, then swung to the west and deployed on line with the 1st platoon on the left, 3rd platoon on the right, and second platoon in reserve. It is of interest that this was the third time that Company C had assaulted this area, to assist other elements that had been pinned down by the enemy, from virtually the same location. The first time was on 28 May when Company C moved to the relief of Company I, 3rd Battalion, 27th Marines and recover 11 casualties from that unit that had been pinned down on the battlefield. The second was 29 May when Company C assaulted the area in support of Company B, 1st Battalion, 26th Marines. During the action of 29 May, Company C with a section of tanks in support had secured the objective with no casualties and inflicted significant losses on the enemy. Now, on 5 June, the same two units were in the same situation as on 29 May. Unfortunately, the results were no where near as favorable as they had been on the earlier occasion. The Company Commander and the lieutenant next in the chain of command were wounded by mortar fire as they approached the battlefield; tanks were not present; a proper base of fire was not established; enemy positions were not accurately reconnoitered. The 3rd Platoon advanced over the open area and came under intense fire from well entrenched enemy at extremely short range. The attack lost momentum, faltered, and stopped. The fierce fighting and the close proximity of the enemy to the friendly troops restricted area fire support weapons and air strikes. Company A, which had proceeded to Liberty Bridge to provide escort for the engineers, was ordered back to assist Company C and a section of tanks that had been at Liberty Bridge was also committed. Upon the arrival of Company A and the armor, an all out drive was

made by Company A and Company C which secured the objective. The Battalion suffered 6 KIA's and 28 WIA's and accounted for a confirmed count of 7 NVA killed and 3 weapons and miscellaneous 782 gear captured.

(b) At approximately 150330H, Company B while in a defensive perimeter at AT997538, received an attack with small arms fire, automatic weapons, and B-40 rockets. The enemy attempted to execute a flank assault and penetrate the perimeter. Primarily because of an excellent defensive plan and aggressive execution, the assault was repulsed, Company B suffered only 3 WIA's and inflicted a toll on the enemy of 21 NVA killed, 14 weapons and miscellaneous 782 gear captured in the action.

(c) On 19 June, a two platoon force, under command of the Executive Officer of Company B, moved to search the area of BAO DONG BAN (BT025554). At approximately 190830H, they encountered heavy resistance from the vicinity of BT023550. The platoon from Company B was pinned down and numerous artillery missions and air strikes were called but failed to soften up the enemy position. Two additional platoons, bringing the total to two from Company B and two from Company D, were committed under the Commanding Officer of Company B. When enemy resistance continued, Company A, one platoon from Company C, and the Battalion Command Group moved from the command post in the vicinity of AT980535, crossed the railroad, and proceeded to close Bravo X-ray. Upon arrival, at approximately 1800, Company A attacked initially to the east and secured an intermediate objective at BT025547. Upon securing this objective, the company immediately pivoted and moved north. As company A was attacking the intermediate objective, Company B and Company D provided a base of fire on the primary objective. Company A assaulted the enemy fortification supported by a continuous and highly coordinated base of fire, which led them completely through the objective area. The Company A assaults were accomplished with only one minor WIA. The totals day's action, however, resulted in 6 USMC KIA, 18 USMC WIA, and 12 heat casualties. The enemy suffered 17 NVA KIA, 5 weapons and miscellaneous 782 gear captured.

(d) On 21 June the Battalion executed its final major operation as part of Operation "ALLEN BROOK". The scheme of maneuver involved Company A and the Battalion Command Group moving from AT978537, linking with Companies B and D at the vicinity of BT017543. The Battalion(-) moved with Company B on the left, Company D on the right. Company C and the Command Group following in traces. A series of phase lines were established. The LOD from BT011540 to BT011548, Phase Line Red from BT016530 to BT017541 to BT020550; Phase Line White from BT028534 to BT025541 to BT026554 to BT023550; Phase Line Blue from BT034537 to BT036545 to BT034547 to BT035552 to BT033556; Phase Line Green from BT036537 to BT040542 to BT040550; Phase Line Black from BT043538 to BT043548 to BT046550; LOA from BT050540 to BT050550. Prep fires were planned ahead of the advancing units and air strikes were scheduled. As the lead elements reached BT White,

and artillery preplanned fire mission was called between PL Blue and PL Green. The was followed by an air strike in the same vicinity. As the companies approached PL Blue, the same process was repeated between PL Green and PL Black. The fire was then shifted to the area between PL Black and the LOA until the companies were at PL Green, at this point supporting arms lifted. The units responded well throughout the entire operation and supporting fires were brought to bear in minimum time.

b. Enemy, Weather and Terrain

(1) GO-NOI Island 1-23 June 1968

a. Summary of Enemy Activity. During this reporting period the Battalion made constant scattered contacts with elements of the 36th and 38th Regiments of the 308th NVA Division. Enemy units made major contact only when it was to his advantage using well concealed trench lines and spider holes in and around villages, treelines etc. The enemy's favorite tactic was to allow lead elements of friendly units to approach within a few feet of these concealed positions prior to opening fire. Enemy units encountered in the GO-NOI area were well armed and equipped and fought with determination withdrawing only when faced with superior firepower or the threat of being overrun. Captured documents revealed that the enemy units had infiltrated into the GO-NOI area, Ashau Valley during April and May. Documents also revealed that some of the enemy controlled over Route 614 "Yellow Brick Road" and had come into the GO-NOI area for re-supply. Captured Enemy Ordnance during this reporting period:

(b) Weather

Average Temperature: Day - 90 to 100 degrees
 Night - 70 to 75 degrees

Overall Weather: Hot and clear during the day with showers and thunderstorms late afternoon and night.

(c) Terrain. Generally flat with gradual swells and recesses in terrain. Many villages which are overgrown with scrub vegetation. All villages have numerous treelines and hedgerows. The southern portion of the island is interspersed with dry river beds and sandy areas which recede into elephant grass and scrub vegetation ranging in height from three to six feet.

(2) DANANG TAOR 24-30 June 1968

(a) Summary of Enemy Activity. During this reporting period the Battalion has had very limited contact with the enemy. The Battalion had three light engagements, four snipping incidents and encountered four surprise firing devices during the reporting period. All enemy contacts have been characterized by immediate enemy withdrawal. The few enemy encountered in this TAOR have been local force guerrillas probably of the Q-82 Company which has been reported operating in this TAOR.

(b) Weather:

Average Temperature: Day - 90 to 100 degrees
 Night - 70 to 75 degrees

Overall Weather: Hot and clear with occasional showers late afternoon and night.

(c) Terrain: Majority of the terrain in this TAOR is flat with some low rolling hills. This TAOR contains many well populated villages and hamlets. The northeastern portion of the TAOR is interlaced with streams and canals with a depth ranging from one foot to eight feet. All villages and hamlets have numerous treelines, hedgerows and foot paths. Most of the paddyland in this TAOR was wet during the reporting period with a depth of approximately six inches.

c. Training

(1) During participation in Operation "ALLEN BROOK", an extensive training program was not practical. However, weekly instruction in rules of engagement, weapons safety (all weapons included), and personal response was conducted on a priority basis. Upon return to the DANANG TAOR, priority was given to rehabilitation of personnel and equipment. Daily weapons inspection was held; 782 gear, personnel and clothing inspections conducted; M-16A1 weapons Zero/familiarization firing; and maintenance performed.

(2) During the reporting period, continued emphasis was placed on giving personnel the opportunity to attend schools designed for the purpose of increasing professional proficiency. Schools attended are as follow:

d. Logistics, Equipment, and Supply

(1) During the month of June the Battalion was in the field on Operation "ALLEN BROOK". The Battalion was supported by the LSA and battalion supply utilizing LZ 410 at Camp DUONG SON. Battalion supply provided the LSA with logistical and personnel support for the Class II dump.

(2) On 23 June the Battalion returned from Operation "ALLEN BROOK", the rifle companies began an inventory of their equipment.

(5) For fiscal year 1968 \$239,832.43 was obligated.

e. Civic Action. During the reporting period the Battalion participated in Civic Action in the GO-NOI Island area and the DANANG TAOR.

(1) The Battalion conduct Med-Cap activities in the DUONG-SON area. A total of 575 people were treated by the Battalion Medical section.

(2) The village chief of DUONG-SON (2) has appointed two local girls to work with the Battalion Medical Section holding sick call on local villagers. This will enable the girls to learn nursing and take over a portion of these duties in the future.

(3) On physical education kit was given to YEN YE School.

(4) One class was held in DUONG SON (2) subject: "Sanitation", 200 people attended.

(5) 248 refugees were relocated from the GO-NOI Island area via Regimental S-5.

f. Personnel Response. Final SIR's submitted on the HUE area murders. Solatium paid by Task Force X-Ray.

- 6 June Elements of the 1st Engineer Battalion crossed the SONG HAI BOH River and moved to the vicinity of CU BAN (4) (AT947529) and commenced clearing operations. CP establishes AT947529.

- 7 June Provided security for engineer effort and conducted search of LE BAC (1) (AT953538), LE BAC (2) (AT958533), CU BAN (1) (AT938533), CU BAN (3) (AT954525), and CU BAN (4) (AT947535).
- 8 June Continued to provide engineer security. Conducted sweep of PHU TAY (1) (AT955547), PHU DONG (2) (AT967544), LE NAM (1) (AT957523), and LE NAM (2) (AT965520).
- 9 June Continued to provide security for engineer elements. Company A conducted patrol activity from PPB located AT936527. Company B conducted 2 platoon sweep of PHU DONG (2) (AT965545), CP established AT955523.
- 10 June Continued to provide security for engineer elements at LE NAM (1) (AT957523). Company A swept CU BAN (6) (AT948524); Company C THON BON (1) (AT975517). Company B swept both banks of the SONG BA REN River to GL 98.
- 11 June Company B and 81's displaced from LE BAC (1) to vicinity of AT972553. Continued to provide security for engineer project. Company A conducted a two (2) platoon sweep of CU BAN (3) (AT953525) and CU BAN (6) (AT950523). Company B conducted a one (1) platoon sweep of PHU TAY (1) (AT955546) and AN QUYEN (2) (AT967553). Company C conducted a platoon sweep of LE NAM (2) (AT966520) and then south to AT955512. Swept AN TAM (1) (AT965516).
- 12 June Company A conducted a platoon sweep of CU BAN (6) (AT928524) CU BAN (5) (AT936524), CU BAN (2) (AT937527), and CU BAN (1) (AT938533). PPB established AT957547 to screen SONG THU BON in support of operation being conducted in the north. Company B conducted two (2) platoon sweep of PHU DONG (1) (AT975545), and AN QUYEN (2) (AT967554). Company C conducted platoon sweep of LE NAM (2) (AT966521), and THON BON (1) (AT975517). Remainder of Company A and Company C provided security for the engineer operation.
- 13 June Relocated engineer effort to LE BAC (1) (AT953538), Company A and B providing screen for 1st Bn, 26th Marines operating north of the SONG THU BON River. Companies C and D providing security for engineers, CP establishes AT953538. Company B to KY LAM NAM (AT997538). Company A to position originally occupied by Company B and 81's vicinity AT972553. Company D chopped to Battalion and helilifted into LE BAC (1) position.

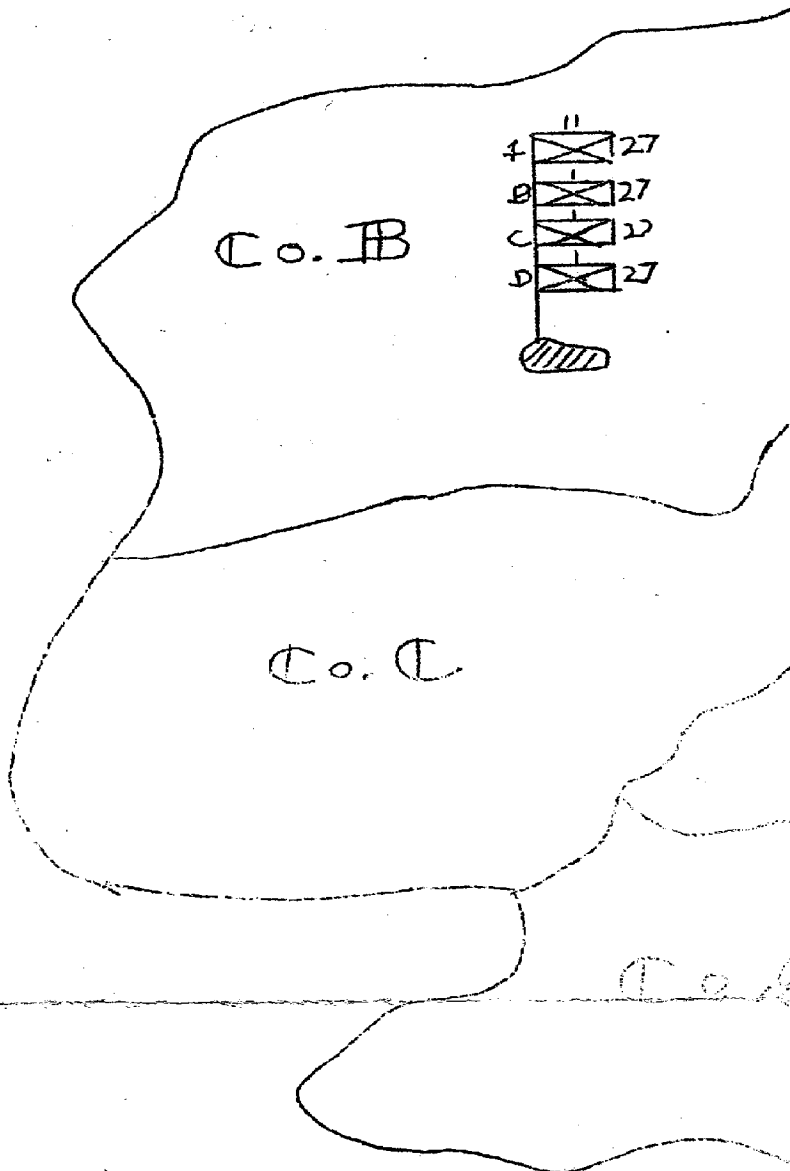

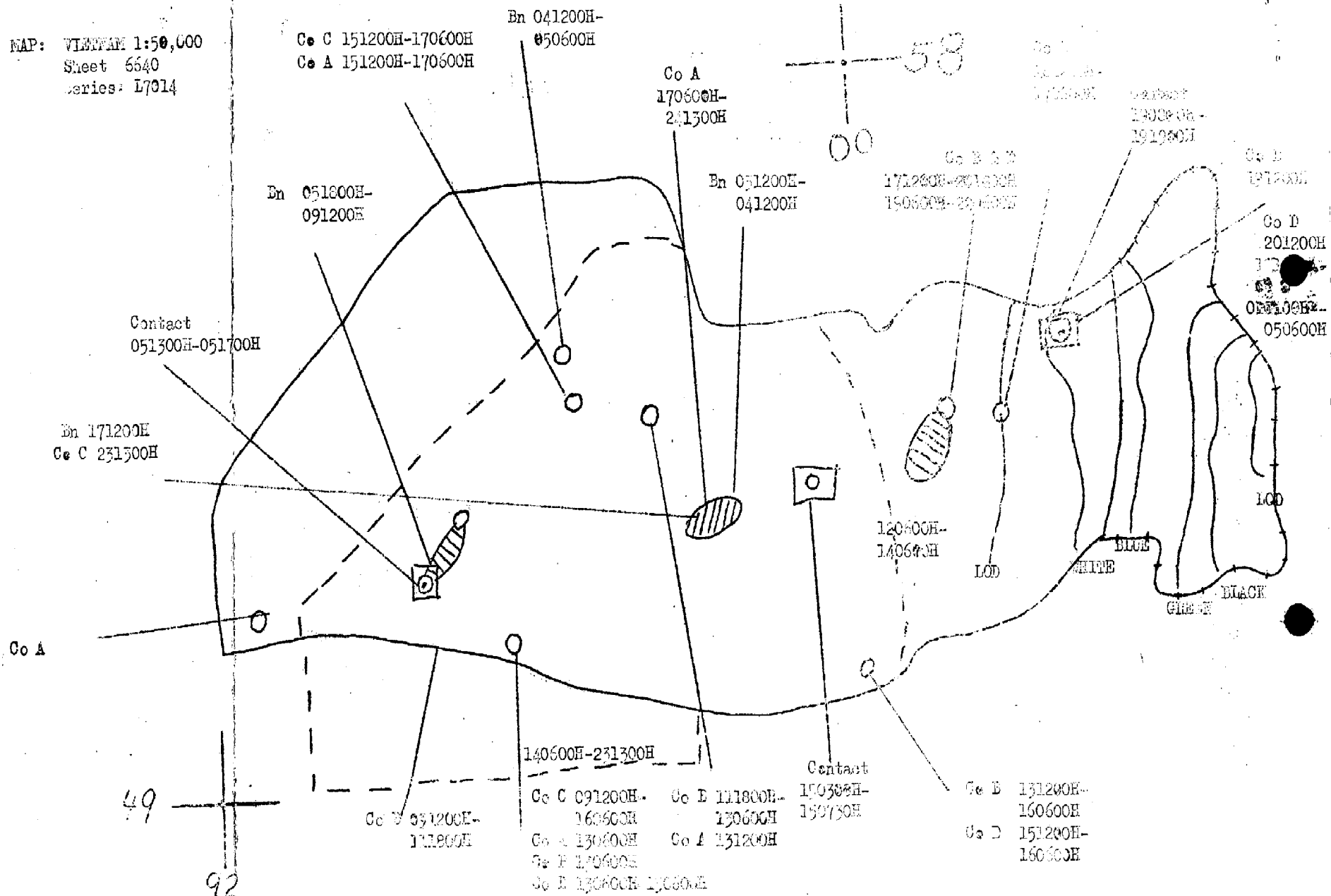

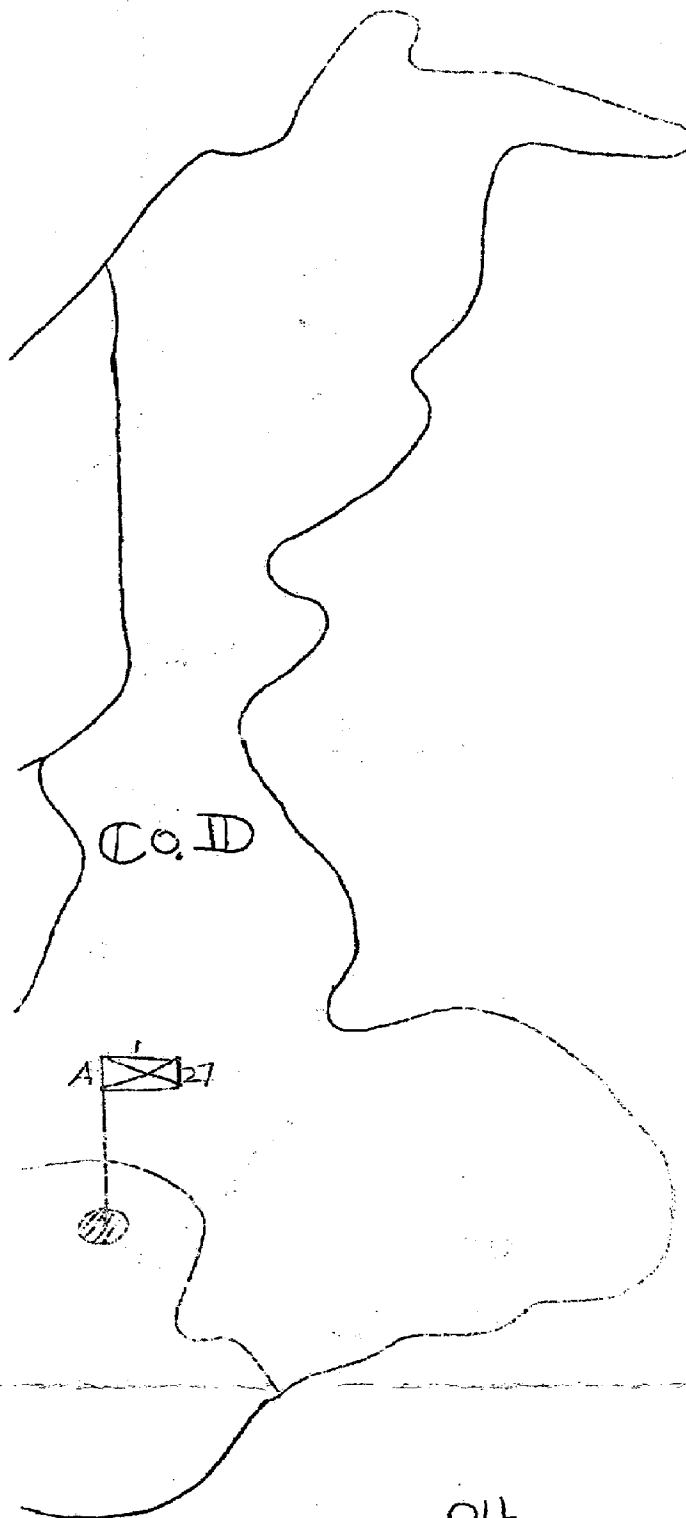
MAP: VIETNAM 1:50,000

 - d. Serial number: Number each item consecutively.
 - e. Date Time Group: Enter if available, if not, enter time signed.
 - f. Incidents, messages, orders, etc:
 - (1) First line, enter the addressee if outgoing and the originator if incoming.
 - (2) Entries are recorded in order of occurrence.
 - (3) For written messages or orders, write a brief synopsis which will indicate the substance of the message or order.
 - (4) Oral messages should be recorded in detail or reduced to writing and handled like written messages.
 - (5) Incorrect entries should not be altered but marked "VOID" and corrected with a new entry.
 - g. Action taken: Enter a brief description of the action taken on each message, incident or order received. In the case of outgoing messages, indicate information addressees.
2. Keep a journal file: number all items(messages, transcriptions, etc) consecutively; enter them in the journal; and then file them in numerical order.
