PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of July the battalion continued to employ counter-guerrilla techniques against an elusive enemy. The battalion operated from its base camp at CAU BA (1) (BT 070656) from 1-16 July and on 31 July 1968. In the intervening period from 16 July to 31 July, the battalion was deployed to GO NOI Island, DIEN BEN District to provide security for land clearing operations and to conduct offensive operations against the enemy. A complete narrative summary of the GO NOI deployment is contained in Tab B to enclosure (1) 3rd Battalion, 27th Marines After Action Report.

3. TRAINING

a. All personnel assigned to the battalion, who were recent arrivals from CONUS, received a four day indoctrination/training period prior to assignment to field duty. Subjects covered included the M-16 rifle, PsyOps/Civic Action, intelligence gathering, personal response, safety procedures, and administrative processing.

b. Headquarters and Service Company conducted a daily training schedule for personnel in garrison. The rifle company in reserve also conducted daily training to further enhance troop proficiency in the field.

c. The following listing delineates, by school, the number of personnel attending formal schools during the month.

4. OPERATIONS

a. 3rd Battalion, 27th Marines TAOR (See Tab A to Enclosure (1)).

b. Enemy. The enemy made extensive use of mines, boobytraps, and harassing fire in the conduct of his guerrilla war. During the period the battalion was at its base camp a total of 16 mines or surprise firing devices were discovered and destroyed in place. 10 mines or surprise firing devices were activated by the members of this battalion causing the majority of the battalion's casualties.

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15 contacts involved light sniper fire (1-50 rounds); 1 contact moderate fire (50-100 rounds) and 4 contacts heavy fire (in excess to 100 rounds). At no time during this period did the enemy show a willingness to engage with friendly forces. The enemy's hit and run tactics with small groups of foot troops who could blend in with the local population made physical pursuit an extremely difficult task. In the majority of occasions the enemy choose to harass friendly troops from treelines surrounding patrol base sites or from long range ambushes on the point or flanks of a platoon or company column.

c. Major Operations

See Tab B to enclosure (1).

d. Small Unit Operations. During the period of operations in the battalion TAOR the rifle companies spent ten days in each ACR; the RIVIERA, DESERT, and TV CAU areas. Extensive squad combat and ambush patrols were employed at night to deny the enemy rocket and mortar firing sites within the TAOR. 48 platoon size offensive sweeps and 4 company size operations were conducted during the reporting period to deny the enemy freedom of movement, food, and a sanctuary from which to conduct his operations. On the 4th and 5th of July Company M provided a platoon size blocking force in the vicinity of (BT 075633) for a KMC operation. On 11 July Company L provided a platoon size blocking force for a short operation conducted by 3rd LVT Battalion, vicinity (JT 090670).

e. Air Support. The resupply of CROW'S NEST and TA-6 OP's was again conducted by CH-46D helicopters utilizing both internal and external lifts. MedEvacs were completed using a variety of rotary wing aircraft. Aerial observation aircraft were utilized on numerous occasions to seek out enemy movement, rocket and mortar sites.

f. Artillery Support. The majority of the battalion's direct artillery support continued to be provided by the cannoners of F Btry, 2nd Bn, 13th Marines. An average of twenty H & I fires per night were conducted during the reporting period. A close liaison and personal working relationships with F Battery has resulted in excellent timely artillery support.

5. CIVIC ACTION/PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS

a. The Civic Action area continued to be extremely active during the month of July. Several field trips were made by S-5 personnel for the purpose of promulgating information about the command's rewards program. On three separate occasions during the month children from nearby villages came to the main gate with information concerning the location of Surprise Firing Devices. On all these occasions, a squad was dispatched, the device was located and destroyed and the children were rewarded.

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b. A comprehensive MEDCAP program was carried out during the month. Repairs were made to the MEDCAP station at the Camp's main gate and construction of a permanent MEDCAP station at the TU CAU Bridge is underway. Several MEDCAP field visits to nearby villages were carried out with positive results. The benefits of an active MEDCAP program are beginning to become physically evident by the decrease in illnesses and local diseases caught by the villagers. Dental hygiene was also stressed this month and quantities of tooth brushes and tooth paste were distributed.

c. A concession for laundry and trash at the TU CAU Bridge was authorized to provide needed services for the troops.

6. MEDICAL

a. Personnel. During the month of July the Medical platoon added six enlisted replacements and dropped three personnel. An extensive training program was conducted during the first two weeks of the month to prepare the new corpsmen for their field duties in a combat situation.

b. Supply. In order to prepare for the battalion's proposed redeployment to CONUS, the IOL was brought up to 99% of required stock with minor items on order but not yet received. All mount out boxes were packed and correctly marked. A total of \$1084.91 worth of medical supplies was expended by the medical platoon in support of Operation ALLENBROOK. A supply inspection by representatives of the Division Surgeon's office received a "satisfactory with minor discrepancies" rating.

c. Sanitation. The appearance and cleanliness of the battalion camp and its sanitary facilities was again kept at the usual high standards.

7. LOGISTICS AND SUPPLY

a. Logistics. During the month logistic support remained stable with no significant problems encountered. Company A, 11th Motor Transport Bn, was relieved of support responsibilities for 3/27 and replaced by Company C of the same battalion. Ammunition stocks remained at the required levels with few exceptions due to non-availability of munitions at the A.S.P.

b. Supply. Normal supply operations were carried out during the month with no major difficulties encountered. Recurring shortages of individual equipment, jungle utilities and jungle boots were given priority attention.

c. Motor Transport. During the month of July 18,905 miles and 807 hours were accumulated by battalion vehicles. A sharp rise in the hours of operation for the M274A2 vehicles was noted due to the two week field operation.

d. Mess Hall. The mess hall continued to serve an average of 2400 meals daily during the month.

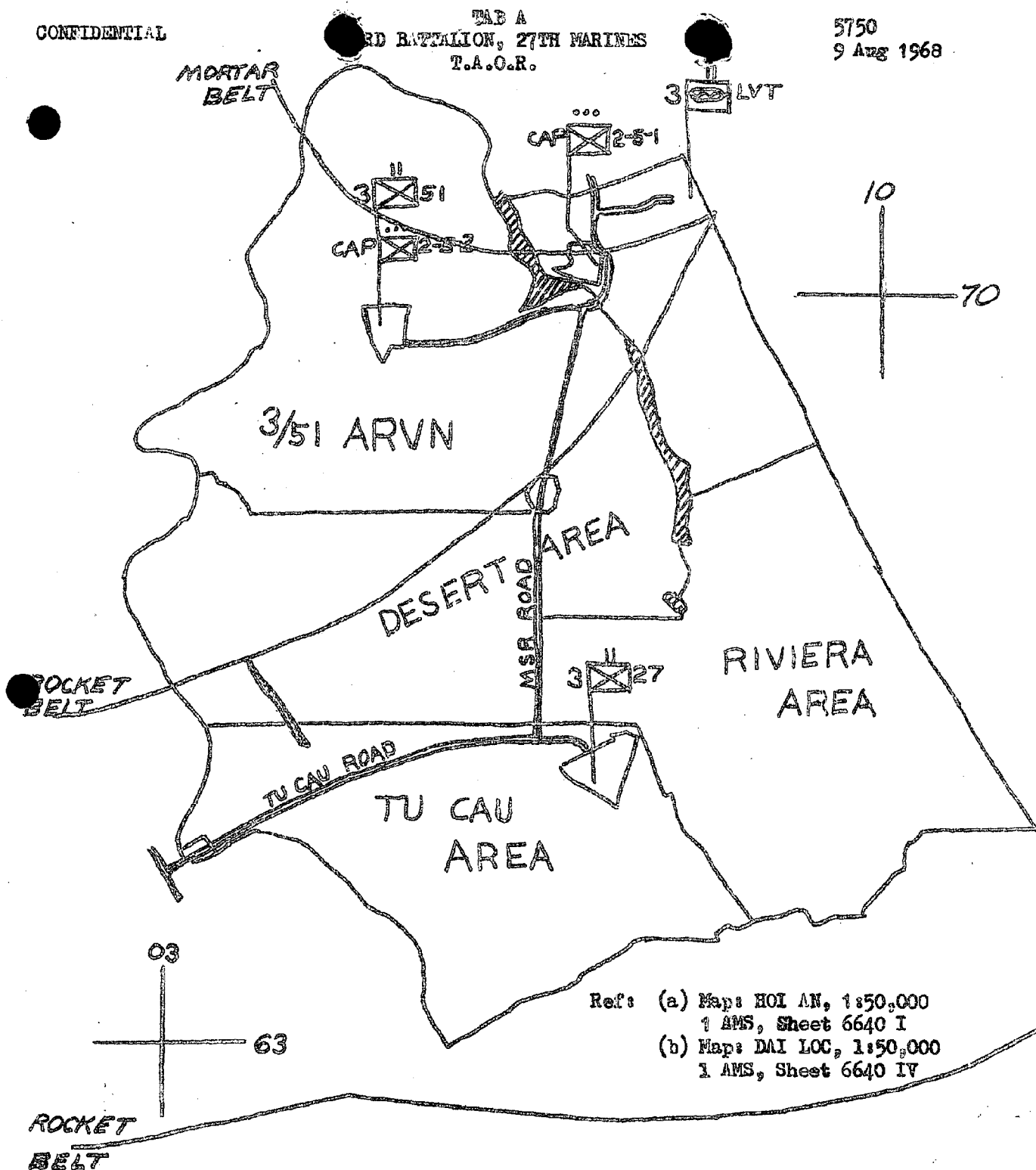

Task Organisation: Annex B (Task Organization).

1. SITUATION

- a. Enemy Forces. One battalion of VC/MVA is believed to be operating in the GO NOI Island area. See current INTSUMS.
- b. Friendly Forces. 7th Marines continues operation north of Sang Tam Ben river and GO NOI AO.

2. MISSION

Conduct extensive operations to find, fix, and destroy enemy forces in AO. Provide security for land clearing operations.

3. EXECUTION

- a. Concept of operations. On D-Day, at H-Hour, Three reinforced rifle companies and H&S Co (det) move by helolift from LZ 413 to 2/27 CP via (BT 005528). Relieve in place three rifle companies of 2/27. At such time that three rifle companies are in place the Battalion Compound Group (forward) and one reinforced rifle company move by helolift from LZ 413 to 2/27 CP. Also on D-Day Battalion Command Group (rear) move by vehicle to Liberty Bridge via (AT 925538) and establish BNFSOG (rear).
- b. Co I (Rein)
 - (1) On D-Day at H-Hour helolift from LZ 413 to 2/27 CP via (BT 005528).
 - (2) Chop OpCon to 2/27 on order.
 - (3) Revert to OpCon 3/27 on order.

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c. Co K (Rein)

- (1) On D-Day at H-Hour helolift from LZ 413 to 2/27 CP via (BT 005528).
- (2) Chop OpCon to 2/27 on order.
- (3) Revert to OpCon 3/27 on order.

d. Co L (Rein)

- (1) On D-Day at H-Hour helolift from LZ 413 to 2/27 CP via (BT 005528).
- (2) Chop OpCon to 2/27 on order.
- (3) Revert to OpCon 3/27 on order.

e. Co M (Rein)

- (1) On D-Day or when directed helolift from LZ 413 to 3/27 CP via (BT 005528).

f. H&S Co (det)

- (1) On D-Day helolift from LZ 413 to 2/27 CP via (BT 005528).
- (2) Establish liaison with 2/27 and prepare for arrival of 3/27 (-) on D-1.

g. Forward Command Group

- (1) On D-Day or when directed helolift from LZ 413 to 2/27 CP via (BT 005528).
- (2) Relieve 2/27 CP in place and assume command of operation area.

h. Rear Command Group

- (1) On D-Day move by vehicle from Bn CP to Liberty Bridge and establish FSCC (rear) for battalion operations.

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i. 81mm Mortar Plt

- (1) Provide 2 sections, an FDC, and 2 mechanical mules to HAS Co (det) for D-Day helolift.
- (2) Provide 1 section and an FDC to Rear Command Group for vehicular transportation on D-Day to Liberty Bridge.

j. 105 RR Plt

- (1) Provide 1 section and 2 mechanical mules to HAS Co (det) for D-Day helolift.
- (2) Provide 1 section to Rear Command Group for vehicular transportation on D-Day to Liberty Bridge.

k. Det Shore Party

- (1) Attach 1 team per rifle company upon arrival in field CP area.
- (2) Provide liaison and support for helicopter medevac and resupply.
- (3) Det Shore Party Hq will move with forward command group after attachment at old 2/27 CP.

l. Coordinating Instructions

- (1) D-Day 16 July 1968
- (2) H-Hour 0700
- (3) All supporting arms will be coordinated through the forward Command Group FSCC.
- (4) Code Name ALLENBROOK
- (5) Numerical Code ROUNDTABLE
- (6) Order for Helolift will be Co I, Co K, HAS (det), Co L, forward command group, Co M.
- (7) Order for D-Day Rear Command Group motor march to be designated.

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4c. ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS

a. Resupply

- (1) Each rifle company and the forward command group will have an EBT attached. The EBT team will provide the resupply capabilities for the unit to which attached.
- (2) Helicopter resupply is on an "On-Call" basis. For a morning resupply have request in prior to 1500 the preceding day. For evening resupply have request in prior to 1800 on that same day. Changes may be made at anytime after initial request.

b. Individual Equipment

- (1) Light Marching Pack
- (2) Entrenching Tool.
- (3) Three canteens
- (4) Three Meals C-Rations
- (5) Normal arms and helmet. Flak jacket and gas mask optional by Company.
- (6) Basic allowance of ammunition for each weapon.
- (7) Salt and iodine tablets.

c. Medical

- (1) Compsman will have a complete Unit One
- (2) Casualties evacuated to LSA will be treated at the 27th Marines Regimental Aid Station.

d. Personnel

- (1) Strength All units will deploy with effective on-board strength less those personnel awaiting reassignment out of VIETNAM.
- (2) Replacements Incoming replacements will be held at the En rear (LZ 413) and will be deployed to the field upon completion of indoctrination training.
- (3) Prisoners of War
 - (a) Battalion Security Platoon will maintain and operate POW

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- (b) Companies will evacuate POW's and suspects to LZ nearest Battalion CP by most expeditious means of transportation.
- (c) Location of POW Collection Point will be published upon establishment of Battalion CP.

(4) Morale and Personnel Services**(a) Mail**

- 1. Battalion S-1 will maintain a mail orderly at the LSA.
- 2. Letter mail will be delivered to the LSA daily by the Battalion Rear.
- 3. Mail will be forwarded to deployed companies by the re-supply helicopter.
- 4. Outgoing and return mail will be delivered to the LSA by return resupply helicopter to the Battalion CP.
- 5. No packages will be delivered to the field.

- (b) Religious Activities. Battalion Chaplain will be located at LSA.

(5) Personnel Procedures**(a) Casualty Reporting**

- 1. Companies will make casualty reports directly to Battalion Rear via Battalion Admin Radio Net.
- 2. If possible companies will complete "Statement of Recognition" in duplicate on deceased personnel in the field. Statements must accompany deceased personnel upon evacuation in order to be valid.
- 3. Casualty reporting will be made directly to the Battalion CP in the field via the Battalion Tact Net if radio communications to Battalion rear cannot be established.

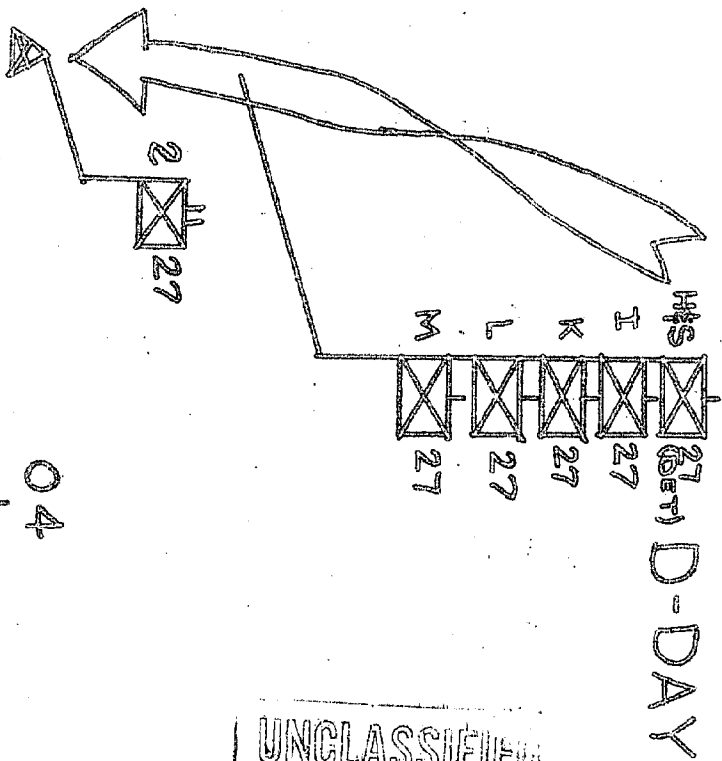
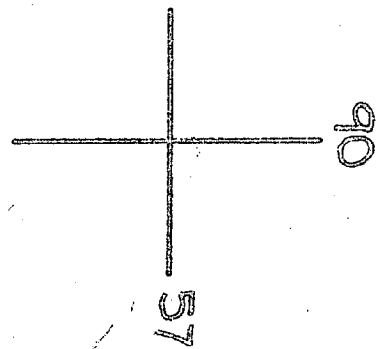

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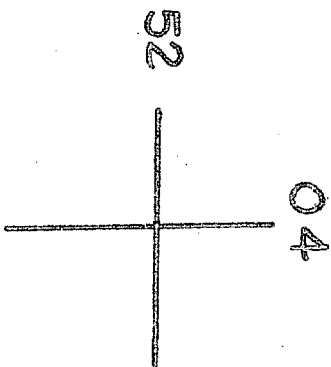
