NARRATIVE SUMMARY

As part of President Nixon's Vietnamization Plan, U.S. Marine Corps and Air Force fighter-bomber squadrons deployed from Danang AB in mid June 1972 to bases in Thailand. In preparation for this redeployment, additional supporting forces deployed to Nam Phong, Thailand. The only facilities at the site were a 10,000 foot runway that had been built in 1967, and seven permanent buildings on the flight line.
