

REINFORCED BY THE 341ST DIVISION AND BEING FURTHER REINFORCED BY

DMZ AND ONE ON THE MOVE SOUTH. HE CONES T USE THEE DMZ

E. BY OCTOBER, THE WEATHER IN LASO WILL BE CLEARING AND THE ENEMY MAY BE EBPECTED ONCE AGAIN TO MOVE PERSONNEL AND SUPPORTING MATERIAL IN QUANTITY THROUGH THE AREA, THUS FERMITTING HIM TO ENGAGE OUR FLANK IN QUANG TRI PROVINCE FROM THE WEST. AIR STRIKES ALONG THE COAST IN THIS AREA HAVE PRODUCED NUMEROUS SECONDARY EXPLOSIONS AND SECONDARY FIRES ON A CONSISTENT BASIS. MUCH OF THIS TRUCK MOVEMENT FUNNELS INTO ROUTE 102, AND HAS BEEN PICKED UP BY TALLY HO FORWARD AIR CONTROLLERS (AFACS) INSIDE THE DMZ. INDEED, ALL AVAILABLE EVI-DENCE SUPPORTS A CONCLUSION THAT THE FINAL MOTORABLE PORTION OF TIS ROUTEE IMMEDIATELY NORTH OF THE DEMARKATION LINE CONSTITUTES THE MOST LUCRATIVE SINGLE TARGET IN THE ENEMY'S BUILD-UP COMPLEX.
