1. THIS SUMMARIZES EVENTS OF 10 MAY 1967, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.

2. HIGHLIGHTS

A. HEAVY CONTACT IN BEAVER CAGE/UNION AREA

AT 1230H, COMPANY C, 1ST BATTALION, 3D MARINES ENGAGED AN ESTIMATED 2 VIET CONG COMPANIES EMPLACED IN PREPARED POSITIONS ON TOP OF HILL 110, 22 MILES SOUTH OF DANANG. BY 1345H, COMPANY C HAD BEEN REINFORCED BY ELEMENTS OF COMPANIES B AND D, AND ELEMENTS OF 1ST BATTALION, 5TH MARINES. THE MARINES MAINTAINED HEAVY CONTACT WITH THE ENEMY THROUGHOUT THE AFTERNOON AND EARLY EVENING. CLOSE AIR SUPPORT WAS EMPLOYED TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT POSSIBLE.

LATE IN THE AFTERNOON, THE MARINES ASSAULTED THE ENEMY POSITIONS, AND AFTER HEAVY FIGHTING IN WHICH 105 OF THE ENEMY WERE KILLED AND 101 PROBABLY KILLED, THE MARINES OCCUPIED HILL 110, MOPPING UP OPERATIONS ARE PRESENTLY BEING CONDUCTED.

B. POSSIBLE SAM LOCATED

AT 1415H, ON 11 MAY, ELEMENTS OF COMPANY A, 1ST BATTALION, 4TH MARINES, LOCATED WHAT IS BELIEVED TO BE THE GUIDANCE SECTION OF A RUSSIAN MANUFACTURED SURFACE TO AIR MISSILE (SAM) AT (YD 103683), 2 MILES SOUTHWEST OF CON THIEU. THE ITEM IS BEING FORWARDED TO DANANG FOR FURTHER STUDY AND IDENTIFICATION.

C. OPERATION MALHEUR INITIATED

MALHEUR, A LARGE UNIT OPERATION, COMMENCED ON 11 MAY AT 0700H IN SOUTHERN QUANG NGAI UNDER CONTROL OF TASK FORCE OREGON. THE AREA OF OPERATIONS IS THE SCENE OF MARINE OPERATION DOUBLE EAGLE I, WHICH BETWEEN 28 JANUARY AND 19 FEBRUARY 1966 ACCOUNTED FOR 312 VIET CONG KILLED AND 19 CAPTURED. FIRE WAS RETURNED. RESULTS OF THIS ENGAGEMENT WERE ONE MARINE KILLED AND 36 WOUNDED. ENEMY LOSSES WERE UNKNOWN.

IN ANOTHER HICKORY ACTION, A USMC COMPANY RECEIVED 10 ROUNDS OF 60-MM MORTAR FIRE. WHILE MOVING CASUALTIES TO AN EVACUATION SITE, THE COMPANY DISCOVERED 16 FRESH GRAVES, EACH CONTAINING TWO BODIES. RESULTS WERE 16 MARINES WOUNDED, 32 ENEMY DEAD. CUMULATIVE RESULTS FOR THE OPERATION AS OF 9:00 AM TODAY WERE TWO USMC KILLED, 99 WOUNDED, AND 59 ENEMY KILLED. ONE ENEMY SUSPECT WAS DETAINED.

OPERATION BEAU CHARGER, THE USMC SPECIAL LANDING FORCE AMPHIBIOUS ASSAULT, UNDERWAY JUST EAST OF HICKORY, IS CONTINUING WITH LIGHT TO MODERATE CONTACT. ALL UNITS ARE MAINTAINING NIGHT DEFENSIVE POSITIONS, CONDUCTING LOCAL PATROLS, AND SETTING UP AMBUSH SITES. CUMULATIVE RESULTS AS OF 9:00 AM EDT THIS MORNING WERE 14 MARINES KILLED, 58 WOUNDED, AND 61 ENEMY KILLED.

ARVN (SOUTH VIETNAMESE ARMY) FORCES FORMERLY PARTICIPATING IN OPERATION HICKORY HAVE STARTED OPERATION LAM SON 54 IN THE HICKORY AREA OF OPERATIONS AND ASTRIDE HIGHWAY 1, EXTENDING NORTH TO THE BEN HAI FREEDOM BRIDGE IN THE DMZ. SIX ARVN BATTALIONS ARE PARTICIPATING IN THE OPERATION. ENEMY FORCES IN THE AREA ARE ESTIMATED TO BE THE 812TH NORTH VIETNAMESE ARMY REGIMENT WITH A STRENGTH OF 2,050.

IN US ARMY OPERATION MALHEUR, ONE COMPANY ENGAGED AN ESTIMATED ENEMY COMPANY SEVEN MILES SOUTHWEST OF DUC PHO AT 2:25 AM EDT ON 18 MAY AND MANEUVERED THROUGHOUT THE DAY TO FORCE THE ENEMY INTO A POCKET. ARTILLERY SUPPORTED AND ILLUMINATION WAS PROVIDED DURING THE NIGHT. ACTIVE CONTACT CEASED AT 8:00 AM EDT YESTERDAY. AN ADDITIONAL US ARMY COMPANY WAS AIRLIFTED TO THE AREA AND A FORWARD AIR CONTROLLER AND TACTICAL AIRCRAFT WERE ON STATION. RESULTS WERE FOUR US KILLED AND 48 WOUNDED; 25 ENEMY WERE KILLED AND 15 INDIVIDUAL WEAPONS WERE CAPTURED.

IN THE NORTHWEST OUTSKIRTS OF SAIGON AT 9:02 PM EDT LAST NIGHT, A LOCOMOTIVE AND FOUR RAIL CARS WERE DERAILED BY A COMMAND DETONATED MINE. THE CARS WERE LOADED WITH METAL LANDING STRIP MATTING SHEETS. THERE WERE NO FRIENDLY CASUALTIES. TWO ENEMY SUSPECTS WERE DETAINED.

THIS MORNING AT 1:27 AM EDT, SIX US AIR FORCE B-52S (HOTEL 88) STRUCK THE 5TH NORTH VIETNAMESE ARMY DIVISION HEADQUARTERS AREA, 34 MILES SOUTHWEST OF QUI NHON. LATER, AT 8:49 AM EDT, SIX AIR FORCE B-52S (INDIA 26) STRUCK SUSPECTED ENEMY BASE CAMPS 28 MILES SOUTH-SOUTHWEST OF HUE. AT 8:51 AM EDT TODAY THREE AIR FORCE B-52S HIT TROOP CONCENTRATIONS 33 MILES WEST-SOUTHWEST OF PLEIKU. A TOTAL OF 245 TONS OF BOMBS WERE DROPPED ON THESE THREE MISSIONS.

TWELVE USAF F-105S STRUCK THE KEP ARMY BARRACKS (ABOUT 37 MILES NORTHEAST OF HANOI) AT 4:45 AM EDT THIS MORNING. PILOTS REPORT THAT 71 BOMBS WERE DROPPED IN THE TARGET AREA. ONE FLIGHT REPORTED THAT PART OF THE TARGET AREA WAS AFIRE, AND ANOTHER FLIGHT OBSERVED ITS BOMBS "WALKING" THROUGH A ROW OF BUILDINGS IN THE TARGET AREA. FOUR OTHER F-105S ATTACKED FLAK SITES IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA OF THE TARGET: FOUR MIG-17S WERE SIGHTED BUT THERE WERE NO ENGAGEMENTS. ANTI-AIRCRAFT FIRE WAS HEAVY IN THE AREA. AN ANTI SURFACE-TO-AIR MISSILE (SAM) FLIGHT (FOUR F-105S) REPORTED ELECTRONIC INDICATIONS OF SAM ACTIVITY BUT NO INFLIGHT SAMs WERE OBSERVED. ALL US AIRCRAFT CONNECTED WITH THIS STRIKE RETURNED TO FRIENDLY BASES.

THIS MORNING'S 5:30 AM SITUATION REPORT INDICATED THAT TWO US NAVY A-4 AIRCRAFT FROM THE CARRIER BON HOMME RICHARD ATTACKED THE HANOI THERMAL POWER PLANT. THESE TWO A-4ES (NOT A-4CS) RELEASED ONE WALLEYE MISSILE PER AIRCRAFT. THE APPROACH TO THE RUN-IN AND DIVE ENTRY FOR BOTH AIRCRAFT WAS DISRUPTED BY INTENSE ANTI-AIRCRAFT FIRE AND HEAVY SURFACE-TO-AIR MISSILE ACTIVITY. CLOUD COVER WAS GENERALLY THREE-TENTHS SCATTERED IN THE AREA AND PILOTS PASSED THROUGH CLOUDS DURING THE "POP-UP" (A QUICK CLIMB FROM LOW LEVEL JUST PRIOR TO RUN-IN ON THE TARGET) AND IN THE DIVE ENTRY. THE COCKPIT MISSILE INDICATORS FOR BOTH AIRCRAFT SHOWED A PROPER ORIENTATION ON THE GENERATOR HALL, THE AIMING POINT, AT THE TIME OF WALLEYE RELEASE. PILOTS ESTIMATE THAT AT LEAST 22 SURFACE-TO-AIR MISSILES WERE FIRED WHILE THEY WERE IN THE AREA. PILOTS OF SUPPORT AIRCRAFT REPORT FOUR MIGs WERE SHOT DOWN. THERE WERE NO US FLAK SUPPRESSION AIRCRAFT IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA OF THE TARGET - - ONLY WERE KEPT NEAR THE ROLL-IN POINT AT THE APPROACH TO THE TARGET. ALSO, THERE WAS NO IRON HAND (ANTI SAM) MISSION IN SUPPORT OF THIS STRIKE. THREE US NAVY SUPPORT AIRCRAFT, 2 F-3E AND A PHOTO-RECONNAISSANCE RA-5C, WERE SHOT DOWN. ONE F-3E IS BELIEVED TO HAVE BEEN HIT BY A SAM. THE CAUSE OF LOSS FOR THE OTHER TWO AIRCRAFT IS NOT KNOWN YET. THE PILOTS ARE CARRIED AS MISSING. A PHOTO-RECONNAISSANCE MISSION IS BEING RESCHEDULED ON A PRIORITY BASIS TO OBTAIN A MORE PRECISE DAMAGE ASSESSMENT FOR THIS FIRST STRIKE ON THE HANOI THERMAL POWER
