FMFPAC Daily Situation Report

1. Special Landing Force "A" commenced Operation Beacon Guide this morning only three days after being withdrawn from the Con Thien Area, where it participated in Operations Buffalo and Hickory 11. The Marine Landing Forces conducted helicopter and waterborne assaults into an area 22 KM northwest of the Hai Van Pass. After the landing, search and destroy operations were commenced in conjunction with ARVN Units which were blocking to the east of the Beacon Guide Area. There have been no reports of contact or casualties as yet.
2. Elsewhere in I Corps, relative quiet prevailed yesterday with only light contact reported. At Gio Linh, the Composite Artillery Battalion received 20 rounds of incoming artillery during the morning, and another 37 rounds of sporadic artillery during the afternoon. No casualties or damage were reported. Counter-battery fire was directed on the enemy, but the results are not known. A review of the past ten days of damage assessments from artillery fires and air strikes against enemy artillery and mortar positions in the DMZ Area reveal that 14 enemy artillery pieces have been destroyed and one damaged. Also, 60 counter-battery missions have resulted in secondary explosions.
3. Small unit counter-guerrilla operations within the tactical areas gained contact with the enemy 29 times yesterday, resulting in 25 enemy killed and 6 weapons captured.
4. Throughout I Corps, a total of 37 enemy were killed by Free World Military Forces yesterday.
