(A) THE FIFTH MARINES WITH ONE INFANTRY BATTALION TERMINATED SEARCH AND DESTROY OPERATIONS IN QUANG NAM PROVINCE WITH LIGHT CONTACT. AT 1915H, COMPANY D (BT 112547) KILLED ONE VC (CONF) WITH SMALL ARMS FIRE.

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(AIR MOBILE) WITH 3 SQUADRONS (FIRST SQUADRON, SEVENTH CAVALRY; SECOND SQUADRON, TWELFTH CAVALRY; FIFTH SQUADRON, SEVENTH CAVALRY; B TROOP, FIRST SQUADRON, NINTH CAVALRY; B TROOP FIRST SQUADRON, FIRST ARMORED CAVALRY AND A TROOP, SECOND SQUADRON SEVENTEETH CAVALRY) CONTINUED SEARCH AND DESTROY OPERATIONS IN THE HIEP DUC - QUE SON VALLEY WITH LIGHT CONTACT REPORTED. (LATE ENTRY) AT 161100H, A SECOND SQUADRON, 12TH CAVALRY AIRCRAFT WAS SHOT DOWN IN THE VICINITY OF (AT 973328). THE USA WERE WIA AND EVACUATED. AT 161345H THE AIRCRAFT WAS EXTRACTED. IN SIX OTHER UNRELATED CONTACTS WITH THE ENEMY, FOUR VC WERE KIA (CONF), TWO VC WERE KIA (PROB), AND ONE WEAPON WAS CAPTURED. ONE USA WAS WIA AND EVACUATED.
