2. HIGHLIGHTS

A. GROUND ATTACK AT LANG VEI

INITIAL FRAGMENTARY REPORTS STATE THAT THE LANG VEI CIVIL INDIGENOUS DEFENSE GROUP CAMP, EAST OF KHE SANH COMBAT BASE, WAS ATTACKED AT 0045 ON 7 FEBRUARY, BY AN UNKNOWN SIZE ENEMY GROUND FORCE SUPPORTED BY SEVEN ENEMY TANKS. MARINE ARTILLERY UNITS AT KHE SANH COMBAT BASE FIRED 105MM ARTILLERY FIRES IN SUPPORT OF FRIENDLY FORCES. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES REPORTED. ONE ENEMY TANK WAS REPORTED KNOCKED OUT.

B. LARGE UNIT OPERATIONS

III MAF LARGE UNIT OPERATIONS IN QUANG TRI PROVINCE HAVE BEEN RELATIVELY QUIET SINCE THE ENEMY LOST 109 KILLED IN AN UNSUCCESSFUL ATTEMPT TO OVERRUN A MARINE POSITION ON HILL NORTH OF KHE SANH. (SEE MY REPORT OF 4 FEB.) THE ENEMY HAS LIMITED HIS ACTIVITY AGAINST III MAF FORCES TO HARASSING ROCK, MORTAR AND ARTILLERY FIRE, WHILE AVOIDING MAJOR GROUND CONTACTS. HOWEVER, FRIENDLY MORTAR AND ARTILLERY FIRES AND AIR STRIKES ARE CONTINUALLY HITTING KNOWN OR SUSPECTED ENEMY POSITIONS.

IN OPERATION HUE CITY CONTACT WAS LIMITED TO SCATTERED SHIPBOARD CONTACTS. FURTHER SOUTH IN THUA THIEN PROVINCE, ELEMENTS OF THE 5TH MARINES CONDUCTING SEARCH OPERATIONS ONE KILOMETER EAST OF PHU LOC, ENGAGED AN UNKNOWN SIZE ENEMY FORCE AT 0800 ON 5 FEBRUARY. ARTILLERY WAS USED IN SUPPORT OF THE MARINE ATTACK RESULTING IN ENEMY KILLED. MARINE LOSSES WERE TWO KIA AND THREE WOUNDED AND EVACUATED.

LARGE UNIT OPERATIONS IN THE DANANG AREA AND SOUTHERN I CTZ WERE ALSO LIMITED TO LIGHT CONTACTS. AT
