THE MARINES EMPLOYED BOTH 60MM AND 82MM MORTARS IN SUPPORT OF THEIR BUNKER-TO-BUNKER ATTACK TO DESTROY THE ENEMY BASE CAMP, ELIMINATING THE LAST ENEMY RESISTANCE

B. OPERATION DRAGON PALACE

THREE MILES NORTHWEST OF HOI AN, ROK MARINES CONTINUED THE DETAILED SEARCH OF CO LUU HAMLETS (1) AND (2), AN AREA FOUND TO BE HONEYCOMBED WITH TUNNELS AND CAVES.
