

THOR, a massed US air, artillery, and naval gunfire operation against the enemy artillery stronghold in Cap Mui Lay sector, terminated on 7 July after 8 days of operation. During the operation artillery expended 24,243 rounds (all calibers); 6 destroyers and 3 cruisers expended 17,922 rounds; and Air Force, Navy, and Marine aircraft flew a total of 1,616 air sorties. US B 52s flew a total of 216 sorties in support of the operation.

THERE WERE 153 TACTICAL AIR SORTIES FLOWN. 91 FOR THE 3RD MARINE DIVISION, 33 FOR THE 1ST AIR CAVALRY DIVISION AND 15 FOR THE 101ST AIR CAVALRY DIVISION. THE REMAINING 14 SCRTIES WERE FLOWN AGAINST TARGETS IN THE A SHAU VALLEY.

ARTILLERY: 12,954 ROUNDS WERE FIRED; 9,269 FOR THE 3RD MARINE DIVISION, 2,570 FOR THE 1ST AIR CAVALRY DIVISION AND 1,375 FOR THE 181ST AIR CAVALRY DIVISION. TWELVE FIRECRACKER MISSIONS WERE FIRED EMPENDING 167 ROUNDS OF 105 MM AMMUNITION AND 74 ROUNDS OF 155MM AMMUNITION. RESULTS: TWO 130MM ARTILLERY PIECES, FOUR MORTARS AND ONE AA WEAPON SILENCED, TWENTY ENEMY UILLED AND FOUR SECONDARY EXPLOSIONS.

DAMAGE ASSESSMENT FOR OPERATION THOR INCLUDED 63 AA WEAPONS DESTROYED, 15 ARTILLERY WEAPONS DESTROYED AND 6 DAMA GED, TWO SAM LAUNCHERS, FOUR MISSILES AND THREE SITES DESTROYED, 125 ENEMY KILLED, 332 SEC CHEARY EMPLOSIONS AND 29% SEC ONDARY FIRES. NUMEROUS AA WEAPON ERY AND ARTILLY POSITIONS WERE DESTROYED AS WELL AS 502 STRUCTURES AND ENNKERS. DURING THE OPERATION, THE EMEMY FIRED A TOTAL OF 278
APTILLERY MOUNDS, ALMOST EXCLUSIVELY AGAINST FRIENDLY TROOPS.
