1. (U) THIS REPORT IS THE NITH IN A SERIES OF MONTHLY ASSESS-  
MENTS F PACIFICATION. IT IS BASED PON FIELDVREPORTING AND ANALYSIS  
DONE IN SAIGON.

2. (C) SUMMARY: PROGRESS CONTINUES TO BE MADE IN IMPEMETING  
AND ADMINSTERING GVN/US PACIFICATION PROGRAMS, ALTHOUGH IN GENERAL  
THY REMAIN BHIND SCHEDULE IN RELATION TO THE 1967 GOALSAND NOT  
LIKELY T CATCH UP BY THE END OF THE YEAR. THERE WERE MODESTGAINS  
IN TERRITORIAL SECURITY BASED UPON THE LATEST RETURNS FROM THE  
HAMLET EVALUATION SYSTEM (HES). THE POPULATION UNER GVN CONTROL  
ROSE FROM 66PCT IN FEBRUARY TO 68PCT AT THE END OF CTOBER. DURING  
THESMAE PERIOD, VC CONROL FELL FROM 19 TO 17.2PCT OF THE POPULATION.  
A. PROGRESS CONTINUED IN THE ICX PROGRAM, WHERE THE US  
MANAGEMENT STRUCTUE IS NOW ESTABLISHED N THE FOUR CORPS AREAS AND  
44 PROVINCES. THE RELUCTANCE OF THE NATIONAL POLICE TO  
SUPPORT THE DOICC CONCEPT IS GRADUALLY BEING OVERCOME. THERE WAS

AN APPRECIABLE RISE IN ICEX-INSPIRED OPERATIONS AND NOTABLE RESULTS WERE OBTAINED. IN THE SIDE PROGRAM THE DECISION WAS MADE TO RAPIDLY DEVELOP A 10,000-MAN CIVIL DETAINEE CAMP ON CON SON ISLAND.

B. A REALLY ENCOURAGING NOTE IN PACIFICATION HAS BEEN THE STEADY IMPROVEMENT IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE RD GROUPS. CADRES ARE WORKING ENTHUSIASTICALLY AND AT A RAPID PACE IN THEIR DRIVE TO COMPLETE THE 1967 PROGRAM BY 31 JANUARY. AT MONTH'S END, 149 PRIMARY RD HAMLETS (AP DOI MOI) HAD BEEN COMPLETED AND RD CADRE PAE 3 RUMSMA 2284 M C O N F I D E N T I A L NOFORN WERE WORKING IN A TOTAL OF 796 HAMLETS OF 1137 PROGRAMMED.

C. THE CHIEU HOI PROGRAM, A ONCE ASCENDANT STAR IN PACIFICATION, CONTINUED ITS DECLINE FOR THE FOURTH STRAIGHT MONTH. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF HOI CHANH, HOWEVER, IS STILL CONSIDERABLY AHEAD OF LAST YEAR.

D. IN OCTOBER, AS IN SEPTEMBER, THE NUMBER OF REFUGEES GENERATED WAS GREATER THAN THOSE RE-ESTABLISHED; THE INCREASE, HOWEVER, WAS CONSIDERABLY SMALLER THAN LAST MONTH'S. THE FORMATION OF THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND REFUGEES WHICH SUPERSEDES THE OLD SPECIAL COMMISSARIAT FOR REFUGEES, IN AN INDICATION OF THE GROWING AWARENESS ON THE PART OF THE GVN OF THE ACUTE PROBLEM OF RELIEF AND RESETTLEMENT OF OVER 700,000 REFUGEES.

E. THE POLICE PROGRAM CENTERED ON REORGANIZATION OF THE NATIONAL POLICE AND INCREASE IN SALARIES. BOTH ARE STEPS FORWARD IN THE PGLUKVVER. IT IS DOUBTFUL THAT THE SMALL PAY RAISE WILL CONTRIBUTE SIGNIFICANTLY TO THE POLICE BUILD-UP.

F. NEW LIFE DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES CONTINUED TO SHOW IMPROVEMENT AS EXPENDITURE OF THE MORD BUDGET INCREASED TO 58 PCT FROM 51 PCT THE PREVIOUS MONTH. NEW CONSTRUCTION UNDER THE RD PROGRAM HAS BEEN ACCELERATED AND THE CURRENT RATE ON CONSTRUCTION OF WAREHOUSES, CLASSROOMS AND MATERNITY DISPENSARIES PROMISES ACHIEVEMENT OF YEAR-END GOALS. MAINTENANCE OF LAND ROUTES OF COMMUNICATION IS RECEIVING PRIORITY ATTENTION IN VIEW OF HEIGHTENED VC INTERDICTION ATTEMPTS DURING OCTOBER. PLANS FINALIZED DURING THE MONTH CALL FOR A 20 PERCENT AUGMENTATION OF THE US PUBLIC WORKS STAFF, DEPLOYMENT OF ADDITIONAL PUBLIC WORKS ADVISORS NOW SERVING IN COUNTRY TO FIELD POSITIONS, A SERVICE CONTACT WITH AN ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING FIRM, AND CONTRACT HIRE OF A SIGNIFICANT NUMBER OF THIRD COUNTRY NATIONAL ENGINEERS, TECHNICIANS, IV

G M IN THE ECONOMIC SPHERE THE VC EFFORT TO INTERDICT LAND COMMUNICATIONS, PARTICULARLY THE ROUTE 4 LIFELINE TO THE DELTA, HAS BURDENED SHIPPERS WITH ABNORMAL DELAYS AND LOSSES OF PERISHABLE COMMODITIES. HOWEVER, NO ATTEMPTS AT INTERDICTION RESULTED IN CLOSURE OF MAJOR HIGHWAYS FOR MORE THAN FIVE DAYS. VC INTERDICTION OF ROUTE 4 WHICH PRESIDENT THIEU CALLS THE "RICE ROAD," WOULD FACILITATE THEIR CONTROL OF THE RICE HARVEST. THE DELTA RICE CROP PROMISES TO EXCEED THAT OF 1966-67, AND WE ARE URGING GVN TO ADOPT A POLICY OF A HIGH PRICE TO FARMERS AND REMOVING OBSTRUCTIONS TO FREE FLOW OF COMMERCIAL TRAFFIC. REPEATED VC MINING AND CRAFTERING, TOGETHER WITH THE WARE AND TEAR OF HEAVY CIVILIAN AND MILITARY TRAFFIC AND PROLONGED HEAVY RAINS, IS SLOWLY REDUCING ROUTE 4 TO A CRITICAL STATE. VC ATTEMPTS TO TAX RICE FARMERS IN KIND IN THE NORTHERN PROVINCES ARE FAILING THIS HARVEST SEASON, IN THE FACE OF EFFECTIVE GVN AND FVMAF SECURITY.

**3. (C) IMPACT OF THE MAIN COMPONENTS OF THE PACIFICATION EFFORT;**

**A. ATTACK ON THE INFRASTRUCTURE;**

(1) INFRASTRUCTURE INTELLIGENCE COORDINATION AND EXPLOITATION (ICEX) ACTIVITIES DURING OCTOBER CENTERED ON ORGANIZATION, PREPARATION OF A DATA BASE, UPGRADING BOTH THE ABILITIES AND UTILIZATION OF THE PROVINCIAL INTERROGATION CENTERS (PID), REVIVING THE MORIBUND PROVINCIAL INTELLIGENCE COORDINATION COMMITTEES (PICCS) AND BRIEFING APPROPRIATE U.S. AND GVN AGENCIES. THERE WAS AN APPRECIABLE RISE IN ICEX GENERATED OPERATIONS; A NOTICEABLE INCREASE IN ICEX OR COMBINED OPERATIONS BY TWO OR MORE AGENCIES OR SERVICES; AND MORE WILLINGNESS TO GENERATE ACTIONS BASED ON INFORMATION FROM OTHER AGENCIES. ALTHOUGH THE PROVINCIAL RECONNAISSANCE UNITS (CORU) APPEARED TO BE THE MOST EFFECTIVE ACTION ARM, THE SPECTRUM OF EXPLOITATION FORCES RANGED FROM ARMED POLICE SPECIAL BRANCH SQUADS TO AIR AND ARTILLERY STRIKES AND PSYOPS LEAFLET DROPS. HOI CHAN RALLIERS WERE WIDELY EMPLOYED AND EXPLOITED. WITH REGIONAL DIFFERENCES IN METHOD AND DETAIL THE US ICEX STRUCTURE HAS BEEN SET UP IN THE FOUR CORPS AREAS AND IN THE 44 PROVINCES. THE NUMBER OF DISTRICT OPERATIONS AND INTELLIGENCE COORDINATING CENTERS (DOICCS) THROUGH WHICH ICEX OPERATED AT DISTRICT LEVEL GREW TO 57 AS OF 31 OCTOBER. TARGET DATE FOR

COMPLETION OF THE 115 DOICCS PROGRAMMED IS 31 DECEMBER 67.

(2) THE LACK OF NATIONAL  
 LEVEL GVN ENDORSEMENT OF ICX STILL HAS A DAMPENING EFFECT IN  
 THE OUTLYING AREAS. BY LATE OCTOBER, HOWEVER, THE RELUCTANCE OF  
 THE NATIONAL POLICE TO SUPPORT THE DOICC CONCEPT WAS PRECEPTIBLY  
 CHANGING. FROM INFORMAL CONVERSATIONS WITH BRIGADIER GENERAL  
 NGUYEN NGOC LOAN, DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE NATIONAL POLICE, AND  
 MAJOR NGUYEN THIEN, CHIEF, POLICE SPECIAL BRANCH (PSB), IT APPEAR-  
 ED THAT THEIR EARLIER MISGIVINGS AND MISUNDERSTANDINGS REGARDING  
 THE DOICCS HAD BEEN GREATLY ALLAYED IF NOT COMPLETELY OVERCOME.  
 THERE HAS BEEN SIGNIFICANT ACCEPTANCE OF THE ICX CONCEPT BY GVN  
 FIELD PERSONNEL EVEN WITHOUT CLEARCUT AND POSITIVE DIRECTION  
 FROM THE GVN. FOR EXAMPLE, IN II CORPS, GENERAL TINH LOC ENDORSED

THE ICEX CONCEPT AS HIS OWN AND WAS DRAFTING A JOINT DIRECTIVE IN SUPPORT OF THE DOICCS. IN III CORPS, A PRECEDENT WAS SET IN THE APPOINTMENT OF A PSB OFFICER AS THE DOTCCCHIEF IN DUC HUE DISTRICT OF HAU NGHIA PROVINCE. IN IV CORPS, THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR OF THE NATIONAL POLICE IS EMERGING AS A STAUNCH SUPPORTER OF THE PROGRAM. HE PLANS UNILATERALLY, WITHOUT SAIGON DIRECTION, TO REORGANIZE POLICE INTELLIGENCE OPERATIONS IN ALL IV CORPS AREAS IN SUPPORT OF THE ICEX PROGRAM. HE HAS DESIGNATED THE

DEPUTY REGIONAL DIRECTOR AND THE REGIONAL PSB CHIEF TO OBSERVE THE 1 T US CAVALRY DIVISION NEXT MONTH IN THEIR CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATIONS SO THAT WHEN SUCH OPERATIONS ARE MOUNTED IN THE DELTA, THE POLICE WILL BE PREPARED TO PLAY A SIGNIFICANT ROLE.

(3) ONE MAJOR HURDLE WAS OVERCOME IN THE ICEX SCREENING, INTERROGATION AND DETENTION (SIDE) PROGRAM IN OCTOBER. THE CHIEF OF STATE SIGNED AN ICEX SPONSORED DECREE WHICH DOUBLED THE MILITARY FIELD COURTS FROM FOUR TO EIGHT. WHICH THE TWO MOBILE MILITARY FIELD COURTS IN EACH CRPS, SOME REDUCTION IN THE BACKLOG OF CASES TO BE TRIED SHOULD BE FORTHCOMING.

(4) A NUMBER OF VISITS WERE MADE TO EACH REGION TO INSPECT AREAS FOR POSSIBLE PRISON OR DETENTION SITES. THE DECISION WAS MADE THAT CON SON ISLAND REPRESENTS THE BEST LOCATION FOR PRIORITY DE-; ELOPMENT OF A CIVIL DETAINEE CAMP. IN ADDITION TO ITS REMOTENESS FROM THE MAINLAND, AVAILABLE AREA FOR DEVELOPMENT AND CONVENIENCE TO SAIGON AS COMPARED WITH OTHER POSSIBLE SITES, THE MAJOR FACTOR IN THE SELECTION OF CON SON ISLAND WAS THE EXISTENCE OF AN OPERATING PRISON ON WHICH A CAMP COULD BE CONVENIENTLY SATELLITED WITHOUT THE NEED FOR DUPLICATION OF MANY FACILITIES.

(5) DECISIONS WERE FORMALIZED ON THE ACTUAL LOCATION IN WHICH DETENTION CAMPS WERE TO BE BUILT IN III AND IV CORPS, AND THE LOCATION OF TWO MAJOR PRISON ADDITIONS. II CORPS INDICATED THAT THEY HAD SUFFICIENT FACILITIES ALREADY UNDER CONSTRUCTION TO TAKE CARE OF THEIR EXPECTED PRISONER/DETAINEES. HOWEVER, CG, III MAF, INDICATED THAT NO NEW FACILITIES SHOULD BE DEVELOPED FOR PRISONERS OR DETAINEES IN I CORPS UNTIL THE SECURITY SITUATION IMPROVED TO THE POINT WHERE THE THREAT OF BREACHING BY VC ATTACKS WAS REDUCED TO AN ACCEPTABLE RISK. PRELIMINARY ARRANGEMENTS WERE MADE, THEREFORE, FOR THE REMOVAL OF APPROXIMATELY 1,000 SENTENCED CIVILIAN

(6) ALTHOUGH THE ICEX CONSOLIDATED PROGRES REPORT WAS NOT USED FOR REPORTING ON ICEX ACTIVITIES IN OCTOBER, REPORTS CLEARLY INDICATE THAT THE ICEX PROGRAM, ONLY FOUR MONTHS AFTER ITS ESTABLISHMENT, IS PRODUCING RESULTS. AT LEAST 53 IDENTIFIED VC INFRASTRUCTURE MEMBERS HAVE BEEN KILLED AND 221 APPREHENDED IN OCTOBER. THESE INDIVIDUALS HELD POSITIONS IN THE VC HIERARCHY FROM PROVINCE TO HAWAII.
