Re: Minimum goal of the 1969 PD plan, phase I.

Following circular 102/P.T.H.T./1000/02/69 dated 19 Feb 69, we are hereby sending to you lists of minimum goals to be achieved during the 1st Phase of 1969 PD Plan:

- Number of hamlets to be occupied and population to be under our control (Sheet I).
- Number of villages and hamlets to organize elections (Sheet III).
- VCI to be destroyed (Sheet IV).
- Number of Hoi Chanh (Sheet V).
- Number of PDBF members to be organized and weapons to be issued (Sheet VI).
- Number of anti-communist refugees to be resettled and returned to home villages (Sheet VII).

The lists determine goals for each CTZ only, and it is the appropriate ministries that will determine goals for the provinces, except for:

- Sheet I that has already had its details enclosed with Circular #142 of 19 Feb 69.

The goal for Hoi Chanh is increased from 20,000 to 25,000 in accord with the President's Directive with the agreement of the Open-Arms Ministry.

Regarding people who are living in exile due to the war, if any, they will be termed as "Evacuees" instead of "Anti-Communist Refugees".
