1. The information described in enclosure (1) has not been received.

2. In order to complete a priority classified project required by the Department of Defense, the following information is needed:

a. U. S. Marine advisory organization and activities from August 1954 through 31 December 1963, providing more detailed coverage for the period January 1962 through 31 December 1963.

b. Organization and activities of the Vietnamese Marine Corps from 13 October 1954 through 31 December 1963, with the same detailed coverage noted in subparagraph 2.a., above.

3. An original writing by you is not intended or required. The submitted information should, whenever possible, consist of documents or copies of documents. If some original writing is necessary to provide information appropriate but not available for loan or permanent retention by this Headquarters, it should be documented. For this purpose, a footnoting system--fully identifying the maker of a statement, observation, or experience, and the date of such utterance; or fully identifying the title of a book, pamphlet, letter, order, etc., its author or originator, the page number, place and date of publication or issuance, and present location of the instrument--is helpful.

4. The information requested in paragraph 2 above should reach this Headquarters (Code A03D) no later than 1 March 1964.

a. Semi-annually as of 30 June and 31 December, to reach this Headquarters no later than 45 days after the end of the period.
