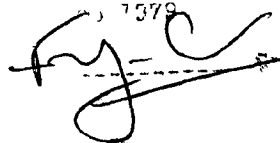

a. The authorized manning level in MOS's 0102 and 0130 is 21. The present on board strength is 11.

2. ENLISTED.

a. The overall enlisted strength of this command is ninety five percent (95 percent). Considering known gains, the following significant shortages exist:

- (1) OF 03 - 10 SGT MOS 0311 volunteers airborne training.
