PERSONNEL SHORTAGES

1. 2d MAW (-)

a. Shortages existing in the staff non-commissioned officer ranks generally could adversely affect sustained combat operations. MOS's 2532 and 3111 are short in all ranks. MOS 6621 has a critical shortage within the staff NCO ranks. MOS 6443 is short in all ranks and is critical in the rank of sergeant and above. MOS 2761 continues to be critically short of sergeants and above. MOS's 0441 and 6742 are at about 50% of M/L with the shortage predominantly in the ranks of Corporal and Lance Corporal. Personnel requirements to support the summer augmentation program has imposed a serious burden on MOS's 3371 and 3613.

2. MACS-5

a. Squadron is in its second month of reforming. Critical personnel shortages exist in Supply, MT, Utilities, and Admin Fields. Anticipated input of personnel by 30Jun64 will alleviate the shortages in the Supply and MT Fields to some degree.

3. MAG-26

a. Critical MOS: 1341, 3516, 6611, 6631, 6661, 6715 & 5711.
