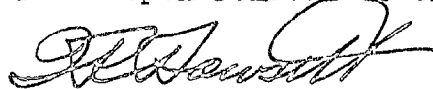

PERSONNEL SHORTAGES1. 2d MAW (-)

a. MOS 6742 -

(1) The personnel situation in MOS 6742 has deteriorated to a critical state. The basic problem is a complete lack of input in MOS 6742.

(2) This command presently has on hand 58% of the authorized M/L in MOS 6742. Following is a breakdown of anticipated strength within this MOS for the next three months:

(3) The Marines in MOS 6742 are the backbone of the LAAM Battalion. The steadily decreasing strength level within MOS 6742 is affecting the combat readiness of the LAAM Battalion, which has an O/H strength of 58% of M/L in this occupational specialty.

(4) In view of the foregoing and to preclude reaching a point where the readiness posture will become critical, it is necessary, and urgently requested that sufficient basic 6700 Marines be assigned to bring this command to manning level strength. These Marines could be trained to an acceptable state in MOS 6742 in six to eight weeks.

2. MAG-26

a. Critical shortage in officer personnel in OF 13 and OF 35 will exist in immediate future.
