1. MACS-6

a. The general personnel situation is satisfactory with several exceptions as noted below.

b. Officer. MACS-6 is presently short an administrative officer (0130), a radar Officer (2710), and seven 6709/6704 Controllers.

c. Enlisted. The major enlisted shortages are found within the Communications Field (2511/2529/2531/2541/2543). This squadron presently has on hand only three (3) communicators out of twenty-six (26) authorized by the T/O.

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
