(3) Discussion:

(a) The Supply MOS's are considered critical due to the large number of basics that require OJT. To adequately train these personnel requires much effort on the part of supervisors, of which there is a shortage, and detracts from their overall efficiency. This is especially true with MOS 3071, whereas the actual overall shortage is 19 there exists a shortage of 42 rank E7 and above. This unequitable distribution of rank and experience creates a burden and detracts from overall efficiency by reducing the number of supervisory personnel available for normal efficient operations. The

additional requirement to train and supervise large numbers of basics with a reduced number of supervisors was reflected in the results of a recent FMFPAC Supply/Fiscal maintenance inspection which required a reinspection, scheduled for Feb 65.

(b) MOS 6621. While the overall shortage is 13 there exists an actual shortage of 43 with rank of E-4 and above. This shortage of 68 percent authorized E-4 and above is considered a critical shortage of experienced personnel.
