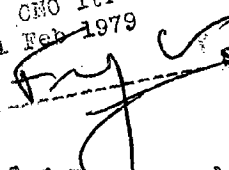

1. COMMANDER'S STATEMENT CONCERNING ANY EXISTING OR ANTICIPATED CRITICAL PERSONNEL SHORTAGE:

A. THE BUPERS ALLOWANCE FOR HOSPITAL CORPSMEN IS TWO ZERO FOUR, PRESENT ON BOARD STRENGTH IS ONE SEVEN ZERO. ANTICIPATED GAINS DURING THE NEXT SIX MONTHS ARE TWENTY ONE AS COMPARED WITH EXPECTED AND KNOWN LOSSES OF THIRTY TWO. THE HOSPITAL CORPSMEN SITUATION IS SERIOUS AND COULD AFFECT THE COMBAT READINESS OF THE BRIGADE.

1. Commander's Statement:

a. -VMFA-531 reforms on 1 Jul 1965 and accepts 15 F4B aircraft that date. VMA(AW)-533 transitions to A6A aircraft on 1 Jul 1965 and VMA(AW)-225 reforms with A6A aircraft on 1 Oct 1965. School quotas have been secured to meet the training requirements for cadres but this program cannot be supported from local resources without depleting the key personnel in one or more units to the point that safety or capability to carry out assigned responsibilities will be seriously degraded. Cancellation of quotas will preclude necessary school training until CY 1966.
