SS MAYAGUEZ RECOVERY

15 MAY 1975

THE SAFE RECOVERY OF THE SS MAYAGUEZ AND HER 40 MAN CREW WAS ACCOMPLISHED BY BLT 2/9 AND D/1/4(-) AT KOH TANG ISLAND, GULF OF THAILAND, IN CONJUNCTION WITH USAF AND USN UNITS ON MAY 15 1975, THREE DAYS AFTER THEIR CAPTURE BY CAMBODIAN GUNBOATS. THE MARINES WERE FLOWN FROM THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES AND OKINAWA TO UTAPAO, THAILAND BY MAC AIRCRAFT. FROM THERE, THEY WERE TRANSPORTED BY 11 USAF CH/HH-53 HELOS TO THE KOH TANG AREA AND LANDED SIMULTANEOUSLY ON KOH TANG ISLAND AND USS HOLT AT 142308Z. 240 MARINES OF BLT 2/9 ESTABLISHED THEMSELVES ON THE ISLAND IN THE FACE OF ACTIVE RESISTANCE WHICH RESULTED IN THE LOSS OF 3 OF THE 5 HELOS IN THE FIRST WAVE AND DAMAGED 2 HELOS IN THE SECOND WAVE. A 65 MARINE BOARDING PARTY FROM D/1/4(-) ON USS HOLT REPOSSESSED THE SS MAYAGUEZ AT 150041Z AND FOUND HER DESERTED AND UNDAMAGED. FOLLOWING THE SINKING OF SEVERAL CAMBODIAN GUNBOATS AND THE BOMBING OF KAMPONG SAM, THE ENTIRE CREW OF THE MAYAGUEZ WAS RELEASED UNHARMED BY THE CAMBODIANS AND PICKED UP IN A SMALL BOAT FLYING WHITE FLAGS BY USS WILSON AT 150346Z. THE SS MAYAGUEZ WAS PLACED UNDER TOW AT 150455Z AND SUBSEQUENTLY GOT UNDERWAY UNDER HER OWN POWER. EXTRACTION OF THE MARINES ON KOH TANG WAS ACCOMPLISHED WITH DIFFICULTY UNDER FIRE BY BOATS AND HELOS. THE LAST MARINES WERE EXTRACTED BY HELO AT 151320Z.

SPOT REPORT

Subj: Synopsis of Weekend Operations

- 1. The following synopsis contains information and appropriate message references involving proposed operation plans to recover possible remains from helicopter crashes off KOH TANG island.
- a. CINCPACELT 161727Z requested TG 77.5/COMDESRON 23/HOLT/WILSON to return to the vicinity of KOH TANG at best speed. SEAL/UDT team to recover bodies from two helos down in water off KOH TANG. SAR operations not envisioned on island.
- b. CONSEVENTHELT 161922Z amplified plan stated above.
- c. USS WILSON 162130Z provided information on location and after-action report concerning downed helos.
- d. JCS 162135Z requested CINCPAC to provide conceptual plans for both covert and overt operations to recover possible remains from helos.
- e. CINCPACELT 170037Z outlined plan requested by JCS.
- f. CTF 77 170428Z described survivors report of situation regarding downed helos. In essence, a low probability existed of one recoverable body in one helo and none in the second helo. Furthermore, any bodies on the island, beaches, and helo are probably in enemy hands.
- g. CTF 77 170734Z outlined the conception of recovery plan.
- h. JCS 171748Z directed that all preparations for SAR operations and efforts to recover remains cease. All forces were directed to return to normal operations.
