**ENCLOSURE (1)**

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. GENERAL. During the period 1 to 31 October 1965, Marine Wing Headquarters Group One continued providing the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing support with respect to air control and air defense agencies, administration and maintenance of Wing Headquarters camp facilities.
2. PERSONNEL. The month of October saw the completion of the redistribution of personnel between 1st and 2d LAAM Battalions. The purpose of this redistribution was to offset the excess number of personnel rotating simultaneously from each Battalion. Total personnel involved - 130.
3. ADMINISTRATION. Normal administration, no significant events during the month of October 1965.
4. MORALE/WELFARE. MWHG-1 continued to provide recreational activities through Special Services. In addition, the American Red Cross initiated a recreational program for all MWHG-1 units.
5. CASUALTIES. No battle or non-battle casualties sustained during the month of October 1965.
6. INTELLIGENCE/COUNTERINTELLIGENCE. During the month of October 1965 MWHG-1 issued 12 final top secret, 1 interim top secret, 7 final secret and 5 interim secret clearances to attached personnel.
7. AIR DEFENSE. 2d LAAM Battalion completed all equipment installations and are now fully operational at Chu Lai.
8. GROUND DEFENSE. MWHG-1 held three practice and one actual ground defense alert during the month of October. Spontaneous reaction and constant ground defense readiness by all MWHG-1 elements was displayed throughout the evening of 27 October.
9. SPECIAL OPERATIONS. MWHG-1 provided air control facilities for Operation RED SNAPPER held in October 1965.
10. TRAINING. Command Information training lectures presented in all units of MWHG-1 throughout October 1965.
11. NBC WARFARE. NBC Radiac instruments from all MWHG-1 units in process of being calibrated by Group NBC.
12. LOGISTICS. Routine logistic and supply support was provided during the month of October 1965.
13. SPECIAL ACTIVITIES. Divine services for Roman Catholic, Protestant and Jewish personnel were conducted throughout October by the MWHG-1 and other Wing/Division Chaplains for attached personnel. The MWHG-1 Chaplain made six visits to various orphanages/missionaries in the DaNang area delivering pastry and two loads of scrap wood.
