Subj: Command Chronology for December 1968

1. Divine Services

a. Roman Catholic Mass was said in the Wing Chapel in the month of December by Wing Chaplain P.J. Ferreri. Sunday Masses (0800 and 1730) had a total attendance of 1034. Daily Mass at 1145 totaled 608.

b. Protestant Services were held at 1000 Sundays and 1830 weekdays. Sunday attendance totals were 296 and weekday totals were 291.

c. Episcopal Services were conducted each Sunday at 1600.

d. Orthodox Services were conducted the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month.

e. Jewish Services are held Saturday mornings at III MAF.

2. Personnel

a. Chaplain P.J. Ferreri, CDR, the wing chaplain, serves as the Roman Catholic Chaplain for MWHG-1.

b. Chaplain C.D. Harper Jr., Lt, served as the Protestant Chaplain and Wing Administration Assistant.

3. Civic Action

a. Chaplain Ferreri donated: \$25 worth of Christmas decorations to ARVN, \$50 worth of Christmas decorations to Seminary at Danang, 750 gifts to ARVN troops, \$100 worth of gifts to 5th ARVN Regiment, 5900 piasters and 5 boxes of toys to Sacred Heart School, 10,500 piasters and 3 boxes of toys to Father Loi's School, 3 boxes of candy to Thanh Duc School, and 3 boxes of toys to John XXIII School.

b. Chaplain Harper donated: 750 gifts to Buddhists, \$100 worth of gifts to 5th ARVN Regiment, and \$25 to Vietnamese cleaning woman.

4. Lectures

a. Chaplain Harper gave two Indoctrination Lectures to newly joined personnel. Chaplain Ferreri gave two lectures to newly joined personnel also. Total attendance was 106.

5. Other Items

a. Chaplain Harper has assumed the responsibility of director and regular host on the I Corps Chapel of the AIR, T.V. show sponsored by the 1st MAW Chaplains
