PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of August 1970, Marine Wing Headquarters Group One and its subordinate units provided administrative and logistical support for the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing Headquarters at Danang Airbase, Republic of Vietnam and provided command administrative communications for the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing Headquarters and air control communications for the Tactical Air Direction Center. Tango Sector Alpha was in defense condition #3 every night during the month of August 1970.

PART IIISEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Personnel. The Group continues to be over the approved T/O, but well below the provisional T/O. Because of the size of the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing, the accompanying workload in the Wing Headquarters requires the additional Wing Staff personnel. The lack of the recommended number of personnel is not considered to have a deleterious effect on the ability of this Group to carry out all assigned missions and tasks.

2. Administration. Routine Administrative work was performed during August 1970.
3. Awards. The following awards were presented during the month of August 1970.

4. Casualties. There were three Marines MedEvaced during the month of August 1970. There were no hostile or non-hostile casualties.

5. Morale and Welfare Programs. Wing Special Services provided the Headquarters Group Compound with many off-duty activities including handball, volleyball, tennis, horseshoes, basketball and weightlifting. The Group as well as Wing offered entertaining floor shows and happy hours several times throughout the month of August. The China Beach, Freedom Hill and Golden Gate USOs supplemented the aforementioned activities. Although liberty remains secured in the Danang area, the China Beach recreation center continued operations for the enjoyment of all hands. Also, R&R seat allocations and RON flights enabled personnel to relax out of country for several days.

6. Civic Action. MWHG-1 Civic Action Program was transferred to Marine Aircraft Group 11 on 23 August 1970.

7. Intelligence and Counter-Intelligence. The Intelligence Section performed routine administrative support during the month of August 1970. There were 40 clearances processed to Group personnel. The Intelligence Section processed 9 war trophies and turned in 33 unauthorized war trophies to the Group Armory. The Intelligence Section also held Intelligence Briefs for the Command Indoctrination Presentation and obtained daily G-2 briefing on significant events in I Corps.

8. Industrial Relations. Details of the MWHG-1 Industrial Relations Program are outlined in the Industrial Relations Command Chronology.

9. Ground Defense. The Ground Defense Reserve Company A/Zulu One, was deployed on a sweep of the Phuc Ean Area in support of the 1st MP Battalion on 21 August 1970. The results were 5 VCS, and 38 detainees. The Ground Defense Reserve Company A/Zulu One was again deployed on 29 August 1970 for a sweep of the Khu Pho Tan Thai Area in support of the 1st MP Battalion. The results were 3 ARVN deserters, 13 VCS, and 23 Vietnamese detained for illegal residence.

10. Training. General Military Subjects for all enlisted Marines is held at the Group level each Wednesday morning and Thursday afternoon. A total of 467 personnel attended General Military Subjects Training during the month of August. A total of 93 officers and enlisted attended the Command Indoctrination Presentation and FAM Fire Exercise. Drug Abuse Indoctrinations were attended by 91 officers and enlisted during the month of August.

11. Maintenance. The Utilities Section received 139 trouble calls, completed 137, and referred 2 to Public Works. They also received 230 work orders, completed 172 and 58 were left pending. Their additional endeavors included installing a print washer in the dark room of Special Services, a covered working area for 11th Dental Company, repaired various air conditioners, replaced faucets in the BOQ as needed, and repaired or replaced valves and shower heads required on the 1st MAW compound. They also painted various signs and made numerous embarkation boxes for various sections. A water heater was repaired at the CG Mess and 10 scoop loads of gravel were delivered to the MWCS-1 Generator Shop.

12. Logistics. The Logistics Sections carried out routine administrative support for the Group.

13. Supply. The Supply Section conducted normal supply operations in support of the Group and the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing. The Marine Corps Property Section processed 2,031 requisitions with a net effectiveness of 99%.

14. Communications. See Part III, Paragraph 5 of Marine Wing Communications Squadron One Command Chronology.

15. Religious Services. See Marine Wing Headquarters Group One Chaplain's Command Chronology.


