PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the period 1-14 April 1971, Marine Wing Headquarters Group One and its subordinate units provided administrative and logistical support for the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing Headquarters at Danang Air Base, Republic of Vietnam, and provided command administrative communications for the Tactical Air Direction Center. Tango Sector Alpha was in Defense Condition III every night during the period of 1-14 April 1971.

PART IIISEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- Personnel. On 28 March 1971, MWHG-1 commenced standdown as of 14 April 1971 MWHG-1 at Danang, RVN ceased to exist. Major segments of MWHG-1 were to be redeployed by 15 April 1971 excepting the sea detail and the rear echelon comprised of MWFS-1 personnel.
- Administration. Routine administrative work was performed until 14 April 1971.
- Awards. The following awards were presented during the period of 1-14 April 1971:
 - Three Marine Officers were awarded the Strike/Flight Air Medal
 - Two Marine Officers were awarded the Navy Achievement Medal
 - Two Marine Enlisted were awarded the Navy Achievement Medal
- Casualties. During the period of 1-14 April 1971 there was one non-hostile casualty:

5. Morale and Welfare Programs. During the period of 1-14 April 1971, Wing Special Services had no off-duty activities. Group offered entertaining floor shows and happy hours several times. The China Beach, Freedom Hill and Golden Gate USO's supplemented aforementioned activities. Although liberty remains secured in the Danang area, the China Beach recreation center continued operations for the enjoyment of all hands.
6. Intelligence and Counter-Intelligence. Commencing 1 April 1971, desks and other containers were checked and certified as containing no classified material, also during the period of 1-14 April 1971 G-2 initiated vacated command post inspections.
7. Industrial Relations. Details of the MWHG-1 Industrial Relations Program are outlined in the Industrial Relations Command Chronology.
8. Ground Defense. On 3 April 1971 a combined force consisting of the 1st M. P. Battalion and Ground Defense Reserve Company A/Zulu One held a Sweep in the Bienh Thai Hamlet, results not available as of yet.
9. Training. General Military Subjects Training which is normally conducted at the Group level for all enlisted personnel, was not conducted during the period of 1-14 April 1971 due to redeploying to Japan.
10. Maintenance. During the period of 1-14 April 1971, the Utilities Section received 34 work orders of which all were completed. In addition the Utilities Section received 200 forklift commitments of which all were completed.
11. Logistics. As of 5 April 1971 staging of MWHG-1 property commenced and preparations for movement to Deep Water Pier were finalized.
12. Supply. The Supply Section conducted normal supply operations in support of the Group and the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing. The Marine Corps Property Section processed 10 requisitions and the Navy Property Section processed 28 requisitions with a net effectiveness of 96% and 100% respectively for the period of 1-14 April 1971.
13. Communications. See Part III, Paragraph 5 of Marine Wing Communications Squadron One Command Chronology.
14. Religious Services. See Marine Wing Headquarters Group One Chaplain's Command Chronology.
15. Typhoon and Disaster Control. There were no Typhoon/Storm Conditions set in the Danang area throughout the period of 1-14 April 1971.
