Pursuant to orders and instructions contained in reference (a) through (e), and in accordance with reference (f), VMCF-1 (-) departed MCAS Iwakuni on 16 April 1965, destination Danang AB, South Viet Nam. (References are listed in supporting document number 1). The flight echelon consisting of 5 EF-10B aircraft departed MCAS Iwakuni at 160605Z, proceeding via Naha AB and NAS Cubi Point, and arrived at Danang AB at 170205Z.
